Blessing Declarations

TOPIC: **For Yours is the Kingdom....**

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth in Colorado as it is in Heaven. It also entails shifting the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak the blessings of God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's input regarding anything He might want you to add.

For Yours is The Kingdom

We continue to release Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6. This month, we will speak blessing declarations addressing Matthew 6:13b (KJV) "For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen." This statement is much more than an ending to a beautiful prayer. After praying for God's name to be hallowed, His kingdom to come, His will to be done, daily provision to be reality, His forgiveness of our sins, His protection to abound, and His deliverance to be evident, The prayer concludes by directing our eyes away from ourselves and back to God alone. As Believers in Jesus, it is our final declaration of complete surrender to God as well as our request that He invade our lives with such intensity that we choose His desires above ours, and His life to become our life. From that perspective, when we declare "Yours is the kingdom", we confess that 'My life belongs to You Lord God. My plans are subject to Your plans. My opinions now yield to Your wisdom, and my ambitions now bow before Your purposes. As Luke shared in Chapter 22:42 the ending to the Lord's Prayer is our declaration that "Nevertheless, not My will, but Yours, be done."

Blessing Declarations July 25: For Yours is the Kingdom....

1. As one with the Godhead, we bless Believers statewide with the fruit of God's power and glory as described in Matthew 6:13b, "For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."
2. As written in Psalm 22:28, we bless Colorado "For the kingdom is the LORD's, and He rules over the nations."
3. We bless the people of Colorado with the joy found in Revelation 11:15 which tells us that "The kingdoms of this world have become the kingdoms of our Lord and of His Christ."
4. As it is written in Daniel 7:14, the Colorado Ekklesia is now blessed to serve God as His people because "Then to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed."
5. As written in 1 Peter 1:16, we invite Colorado believers to receive His glory and "Be holy, because I am holy."
6. We bless the people of Colorado with the words of 2 Peter 1:2-3 "Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue..."
7. We bless every person in our state to now turn and seek God's Kingdom as written in Matthew 6:31-33 "Therefore do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' For after all these things the Gentiles seek. For your heavenly Father knows that you need all these things. But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." Thank You Jesus for adding all that we need in this season.
8. We bless Colorado Believers to fervently seek God as it is written in the Passion version of Psalm 63:1 "O God of my life, I'm lovesick for you in this weary wilderness. I thirst with the deepest longings to love you more, with cravings in my heart that can't be described. Such yearning grips my soul for you, my God!"
9. As David did in Psalms 63:2, we bless every Colorado Believer to passionately seek God; "So I have looked for You in the sanctuary, to see Your power and Your glory."
10. Based on Exodus 33: 17-18, we bless every Colorado Believer with a desperate desire to Know God more and to find grace in His sight, that God knows them by name, and they can ask, as Moses did, "Show me Your Glory." Let more people see and experience Your Goodness Lord God.
11. As the Ekklesia, we proclaim the blessings of Psalm 103:19 over Colorado; "The LORD has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all."
12. We declare the hope-filled blessings of Daniel 4:34-35 to the people of Colorado "God's dominion is everlasting, and no one can stay His hand."

13. We bless the people of God to understand God's power as it is written in 1 Chronicles 29:11-12 which tells us that "All authority and ability belong to God."
14. Let every Colorado Believer now experience the peace and confidence found in Jeremiah 32:17 which acknowledges that "In Your hand is power and might."
15. We bless Colorado Believers with the Truth and comfort found in Ephesians 1:15-23 "Therefore I also, after I heard of your faith in the Lord Jesus and your love for all the saints, do not cease to give thanks for you, making mention of you in my prayers: that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward us who believe, according to the working of His mighty power which He worked in Christ when He raised Him from the dead and seated Him at His right hand in the heavenly places, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come. And He put all things under His feet and gave Him to be head over all things to the church, which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all."
16. We bless believers across Colorado with the Truth presented in Jude 24-25: "Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling, and to present you faultless before the Presence of His glory with exceeding joy, to God our Savior, Who alone is wise, be glory and majesty, Dominion and Power, both now and forever. Amen."
17. We bless the Colorado Ekklesia with the "Amen" of the Lord's Prayer as written in the words of Revelation 4:14 which tells us that Jesus is "the Amen, the faithful and true witness." Let every Believer now bask in that Truth of Jesus as savior.

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
