TOPIC: THE GOODNESS OF GOD

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the <u>Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN)</u> which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in

Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put

regarding anything He might want you to add.

THE GOODNESS OF GOD

The goodness of God is woven throughout Scripture, revealing a Father whose nature is overflowing with love, mercy, and faithful care. The psalmist declares, "The Lord is good to all; He has compassion on all He has made" (Psalm 145:9), reminding us that God's goodness is not selective but extended to all creation. His generosity is evident in every good gift, for "every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights" (James 1:17).

Even in times of hardship, God's goodness becomes our refuge, as Nahum testifies: "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; He knows those who trust in Him" (Nahum 1:7). Ultimately, His goodness is most vividly displayed in His steadfast love—"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever" (Psalm 136:1)—a love that never wavers and continues to pursue us with grace and faithfulness.

Blessing Declarations for December 13: THE GOODNESS OF GOD

Believers should declare the goodness of God because Scripture teaches that spoken praise strengthens faith, shifts focus to God's character and testifies of His works to others. Psalm 107:2 urges, "Let the redeemed of the Lord say so," reminding us that those who have experienced His goodness should proclaim it openly. Declaring God's goodness also aligns our hearts with truth, for "death and life are in the power of the tongue". You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

- 1. We bless the people of Colorado with the Truth that God's creation throughout Colorado is "very good" as written in Gen 1:31 "And God saw all that He had made, and it was very good,"
- 2. We declare that the people of Colorado are now blessed by the beauty and order that God's goodness established in Colorado as written in Psalm 19:1 "The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament shows His Handiwork."
- 3. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to know more deeply how God's goodness is intertwined with His everlasting mercy and love as written in Psalm 100:5 "For the Lord is good; His mercy is everlasting."
- 4. We bless believers statewide with the assurance of God's goodness as written in Psalm 145:9 which tells us that "The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works,"
- 5. We bless the people of Colorado to recognize and acknowledge God's gifts as promised in James 1:17 "Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and comes down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning."
- 6. We bless every member of the Colorado Ecclesia to have the faith and boldness to share God's goodness and mercy to those who need encouragement as it is written in Psalm 27:13 "I would have lost heart, unless I had believed that I would see the goodness of the Lord in the land of the living."
- 7. We bless Colorado Believers to stand strong in their faith loving God above all else as written in Romans 8:28 "And we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose."
- 8. We bless Believers statewide to seek the goodness of God and His laws, as it is written in Psalms 119:68 "You are good, and do good; teach me Your statutes."
- 9. As it is written Philippians 1:6, we decree over every person in, and from, Colorado, "Being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of Jeus."
- 10. We bless every member of the Colorado Ecclesia to be partakers of God's goodness and His promises which flow generously from His heart at it is written in 2 Peter 1:4 "By which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust."
- 11. On behalf of the people of Colorado, we agree with what is written in Psalm 145:13, that God's Kingdom "...is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations. The Lord is faithful to all His Promises and loving toward all He has made."
- 12. We bless Colorado Believers with the fortitude to glorify God in all that they do as it is written in Matthew 5: 16; "Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven."
- 13. We decree blessings to Colorado as it is written in Jer 33:11 "There will be heard once more the voice of joy, the voice of gladness, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride in declaring, 'Praise the Lord of hosts for the Lord is good, for His mercy endures forever.'"
- 14. As its written in Psalm 31:19-20 we bless Believers across Colorado with God's great goodness which has been laid up for those who fear Him, and has been prepared for those who trust in Him and worked out for those who take refuge in Him.

- 15. We bless and encourage Colorado Believers as written in Psalm 107: 8-9; "Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul and fills the hungry soul with goodness."
- 16. We decree the blessings of God's covenant to be good to the people of Colorado as written in Jeremiah 32:40 which tells us that "Yahweh says (He) will make an everlasting covenant with them that (He) will do them good."
- 17. We declare, in faith, that every Colorado community is now full of the goodness of the Lord as presented in Psalm 33:5 (NASB 2020)
