**Overview.** This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

**Source & Tone.** Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

**What to Pray.** Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. **Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest.** Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

## PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

## 1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

## 2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. *He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.*

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

### **3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed**

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

### **4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY**

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

### **5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH**

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

### **6. PRAYER POINTS**

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God’s will according to Job 22:28: *“You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways.”* (NKJ)

Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6) Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society.

## Colorado Prays **Ministry PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We thank God for the 55+ participating churches and groups statewide that are covering every day of the year in non-stop prayer (except for the 5<sup>th</sup> Mondays)! We praise You Holy Spirit for helping to build this Colorado wall of prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20)!!!
2. We pray for favor with church and ministry leaders as we seek to add 35+ churches in each of the 64 counties across all of Colorado (over 2200 churches statewide). We call in churches of every denomination, ethnicity and generation to engage in a Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch.
3. We ask Lord for an Advocate in each county who will help engage the pastors in their area.
4. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch so that there are no gaps in the Prayer Wall.
5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need an Advocate in each city/county to recruit pastors, an administrator, a Wix web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
8. We pray for favor and discernment as Colorado Prays rolls out Cover The County which hosts a regularly scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado County while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer (8 counties are currently covered).

## Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado– that God’s love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God’s love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women now choose life for their babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God’s love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of “taking offense” to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

## **COVID-19 PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We thank You, Jesus, that the death rate from COVID-19 is so very low nationwide – 2.66% (220K deaths out of 8.26M cases). Nearly 98% of people fully recover from COVID-19.
2. We ask, Lord God, that herd immunity kick in now considering the increasing number of people who have contracted COVID-19.
3. We declare that fear, panic, chaos and distortion of truth regarding COVID-19 now cease in Colorado as we receive and exude the peace of God which surpasses all understanding because our God is not a God of disorder but of peace. (Phil 4:7, 1 Cor 14:33)
4. We declare that people of Colorado now choose to get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice regarding different opinions of how to prevent the spread of COVID-19. (Eph 4:31)
5. We declare that people across Colorado now set their mind, will and emotions to focus on whatsoever is pure, whatsoever is lovely, whatsoever is of good report, whatsoever is of virtue and everything that can be praised to show the perfect love of Jesus which casts out all fear. (Phil 4:8, 1 John 4:18)
6. We declare that God's people across Colorado now listen carefully to the Lord and do what is right in His eyes, paying attention to His commands and keeping all His decrees so that He will not bring on them any disease, including COVID-19, because He is the Lord who heals them. (Exo 15:26)
7. We declare Psalm 91 over the people of Colorado, our family and our friends worldwide to see each one saved from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence of COVID-19.
8. We declare that our God is able to make all grace abound to us, so that in all things, at all times, we have all that we need (food, medication and supplies) and that there is now coming an economic resurgence as God meets all our needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. (2 Cor 9:8, Phil 4:19)
9. We declare that the evil which has been intended to harm us will now be used by our God for His good will and purpose in our lives and in the life of THE CHURCH of Colorado. (Gen 50:20)
10. We declare spiritual protection, supernatural stamina and perfect health over every healthcare worker throughout Colorado...let the full armor of God surround each worker to fully repel the COVID-19 virus or any other communicable disease. (Acts 10:38, Mark 16:18, 1 John 1:9, Jas 5:16, 3)
11. We pray for divine revelation and wisdom for treatments and cures for the COVID-19 virus and other serious diseases. (2 Kings 20:7, Is. 38:21, Jer. 8:22)

## **Prayer Point Spheres**

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

## **GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We declare that the people of every Colorado community stand together AS ONE with local police against any and all violent rioters to peacefully diffuse emotions and ungodly intentions during the finalization of the elections.
2. We declare that the governing body of Colorado now stands in, and for, righteousness including the Governor, the House of Representatives, the Senate and the Colorado Supreme Court.
3. In the name of Jesus, we declare that any and all fraud in our government is now revealed based on Matt 10:26 “So, do not be afraid of them, for nothing is hidden that will not be revealed and nothing is secret that will not be made known.”
4. We declare that any and all election fraud perpetrated by Dominion Voting Systems (Office in Denver – Headquarters in Canada) is now exposed and brought to justice according to Psalms 9:15: “For the godless nations get trapped in the very snares they set for others; the trap they set for the weak has snapped shut on themselves.”
5. We pray that vote tallies will be audited and verified for every candidate and ballot issue in Colorado counties that used the Dominion Voting Systems technology or software, that true tallies will be revealed and approved based on Matt 10:26: “Do not be afraid of them, for nothing is hidden that will not be revealed, and nothing is secret that will not be made known.”
6. We declare that our God reigns and that His blueprint (the Word of God) has authority over, and now completely replaces, the so called 'Colorado Blueprint' of the Gang of Four that has affected our state.
7. We declare an awakening of the body of Christ to stand in our governmental authority as the Ekklesia of the living God based on Isa 60: 1-2: “Arise, shine, for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee. For behold the darkness shall cover the earth, and gross darkness the people; but the Lord shall arise upon thee, and his glory shall be seen upon thee.”
8. In the Name of Jesus, we declare that the bondage of lockdowns, which are not in alignment with our constitution, is now removed. We call the citizens of Colorado into freedom - freedom to choose where to go, when to stay home. And, we declare that churches are now opened. (Whom the Son sets free, is free indeed!)

## **CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We decree Your Word Lord God, that You foil the plans of the nations; You thwart the purposes of the people. But Your plans stand firm forever, the purposes of Your heart through all generations. (Ps 33:10-11 NIV)
2. We call forth Your Ekklesia to stand watch, stand guard, and to stand firm. (Gen 2:15; Job 1:10; Isa 5:5; Eze 13:5; Eze 22:30; Ps 144: 14b; Is 52:8; Jer 6:17; Eze 33:2-7; Eze 3:17; Isa 62:6-7; Isa 21:8; I Cor 16:13; Eph 6:11-14)
3. We shout out a clarion call to Your Church: “Wake up; watch and pray.” Rom 13:11; I Thess 5:5-6; Rev 3:2-3; Eph 5:14; Isa 52:1; Isa 60:1-2; Matt 25:5; Lk 21:36; Matt 26:41)
4. We cry out, “Church, be silent no more, pick up your sword and take back your roar.” (KJV verses- Eph 6: 17; Heb 4:12; Ps 149:6; Ps 144:1; I Sam 15:13; Isa 49:2; Isa 5:29-30; Isa 42:13; Jer 25:30-31; Joel 3:16)
5. Every day, we decree that our nation’s capital and every state capital is a “home of justice, and a mountain of holiness”. (Jer 31:23 NKJV)

## **FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We pray that people across Colorado now hear, see, know and receive the truth of Jesus Christ as their Savior which sets them free from their sin nature. (John 8:32, John 3:16)
2. We pray for a supernatural awakening in Colorado families to trust God in all things.
3. We pray for peace in every Colorado family to overcome the stress of COVID restrictions.
4. We pray for wisdom for parents regarding the schooling of their children.
5. We pray for protection over every Colorado family to overcome COVID-19, flu, or any other sickness that would come against them.
6. We pray that every Colorado family has their every need met regardless of their financial situation.
7. We pray that families will continue to hold onto and believe for the fulfillment of their God-given dreams and vision.

## **FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:**

1. We pray for a return to a statewide sense of honor, respect and appreciation for all first responders.
2. We pray Psalm 91 over our first responders, that God is their refuge and their fortress, who saves them from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
3. We declare miraculous healing for any person entering a Colorado prison, fire station, police station or sheriff's office, that they are immediately set free from any form of virus, bacterial infection or disease of any kind.
4. We ask, Lord God, that every non-believing first responder in Colorado now have an encounter with the living God leading them to receive Jesus as their Savior.
5. We declare that every Colorado first responder is supernaturally protected and consistently functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings so that not one is taken off guard or injured in any way.
6. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every work day with no repercussions from leadership or any outside entity.
7. We declare that every prison and jail in Colorado now manifests God's presence with such intensity that each person inside has perfect clarity regarding their identity in Christ Jesus which eliminates all illness, anger, bitterness, intolerance, violence and gender confusion.
8. We ask, Lord God, that the jails and prisons of Colorado continue to be effective and efficient in isolating and quarantining the sick so that there is minimal COVID-19 exposure for inmates, deputies, and corrections officers statewide.
9. We declare that all corruption and unrighteous behavior among Colorado law enforcement now be exposed and brought to justice.
10. We pray blessings over prayer warriors who intercede for prisons, jails and everyone associated with them. May the Lord of Heaven's armies fight for us all.

## **HEALTHCARE PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We pray for the immediate exposure and dismantling of drug dealers and their network throughout Colorado which brings an end to the opioid epidemic in our state.
2. We pray that all corruption and misuse of drug prescriptions by doctors is now exposed and brought to prosecution across Colorado.
3. We ask, Lord, that you awaken every person in Colorado to the need to take charge of their own health by being proactive with healthy eating, exercise and a healthy lifestyle.

## **ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We declare that God-breathed art and entertainment across Colorado will be a beacon of hope during this Christmas season. May the story of Jesus bring “tidings of comfort and joy” for such a time as this to a hurting and fearful world.
2. We declare that our God is the Hope of every nation and ask for a revival of HIS-STORY that brings new birth and re-birth to those with ears to hear. Let your FACE be seen, and your HEART be made known to all mankind during Christmas 2020.
3. We declare that the voice of the church (the Ekklesia) will not be silenced in this hour, that we will bring glory to the name of Jesus Christ through every form of arts and entertainment across Colorado declaring thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is done in heaven. Amen.
4. We declare, “Arise our King. Command Your heavenly army to destroy the work of the evil one across Colorado.” May the loud clatter of the enemy be shut up and silenced so that the Savior of all may be made known as songs of deliverance are released through the church in this hour! May stories and testimonies of our Savior be expressed through writing, entertainment, music, and stories shared from generation to generation.
5. With expectancy in our hearts, we declare, “The king is coming!” We ready ourselves, set a banqueting table, and keep our lanterns fueled with the oil of Your Spirit, Lord God.
6. All across Colorado, may the Lord God be welcomed and adored. May Your coming be ushered in on the faithfulness of Your people who have kept Your story alive - who have not bowed to the spirit of the age, but have held fast to Your promise to us. We sound the alarm of your arrival! May all who have ears to hear - let them hear!

## **MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We declare that the Media Mountain is now restored to righteousness and truth as God’s Kingdom comes and His will is done enforcing the Lordship of Jesus Christ in every form of media statewide. (Col. 1:20 TPT, Matthew 6:10)
2. We decree, “Let there be Light!” (Gen 1:3) across every form of media in Colorado to break off the power of principalities and pierce the darkness of chaos and manifest the righteous rule and dominion of the Kingdom of God over every form of darkness. (2 Cor.4:4-6, Gen. 1:3)
3. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, the Blood of Jesus Christ and the Word of God, we proclaim that people working in any form of media are now loosed from the captivity of bondage and set free from darkness, lies, deception and lawlessness. (Col. 1:20, John 14:12-14)
4. We declare that Jesus Christ is King over everyone and everything in the Colorado Media Mountain. (1 Tim 6:15)
5. We declare that Colorado media people who are now set free, have the opportunity to now do whatever God’s Hand and His Purpose determined before to be done – to especially step into leadership roles in the media. (Acts 4:28).
6. We declare that all forms of media in Colorado are now empowered to communicate the Word of God freely and courageously, awakening people statewide to the Light of God’s Glory. (Acts 4:29, Eph. 5:14)
7. We ask You, King of Glory, to stretch out Your Hand to bring in the fullness of the harvest of Colorado souls with signs, wonders and miracles that draw in the most hardened non-believer. (Ps 144:7)

## **EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We declare that children, teachers and administrators are now fully protected with supernatural immunity to COVID-19, that each one lives out good health and wellness throughout the school year.
2. We declare that the Lord rebuke the spirit of fear among administrators, parents and students across Colorado regarding COVID-19, releasing them from emotional bondage.
3. We declare that every Colorado school is now a COVID-19-free zone filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness and self-control.
4. We release physical healing for every Colorado student, family member, teacher or administrator who is battling with COVID-19 or any other illness.
5. We pray that all young people statewide now stay away from social media sites and online activities that incite bad choices or instill ungodly behavior towards themselves or others.
6. We declare that every form of bullying online or in person must now stop in the name of Jesus Christ.
7. We declare that every Colorado student has the support and resources needed to be successful with the teaching they receive whether it be in person or online.
8. We ask for a release of supernatural provision for parents who need childcare during online school sessions.
9. We declare protection, safety and diligence for children left alone during the day, that they will obey the directions from their parents and follow through on their school assignments.
10. We declare provision, employment and unique and legal income opportunities for every Colorado family, so they have no lack of food, water or shelter.
11. We declare a release of provision for college students who cannot attend college because of COVID restrictions.

## **MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We declare that marketplace people are now be devoted to one another in love honoring one another above themselves in the Marketplace. (Rom.12:10).
2. We declare to marketplace owners, leaders and workers: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid." (John 14:27)
3. We declare Acts 20:35 over Colorado marketplace people: "In all things I have shown you that by working hard in this way (you) must help the weak and remember the words of the Lord Jesus, how he himself said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'"
4. We declare Matt 11: 28-30 over Colorado marketplace people: "Come to me, all who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you, and learn from me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy, and my burden is light."
5. We decree that the Lord will send a blessing on your barns and on everything you put your hands to. The Lord your God will bless the land and businesses of Colorado. (Deut.28:8)
