



Monthly Prayer Digest

Sept, 2017

Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church or ministry's monthly 24hr Prayer Watch in support of the 1Church Initiative. The vision for the 1Church Initiative is to build a wall of day and night prayer across Colorado, 1 Church at a time, in an appeal to heaven for statewide transformation.

Feel free to re-use each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

Get your bible and a notebook/pen.

Set yourself apart from distractions.

Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. PRAISE GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good, He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable, He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign, He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Shout for joy to the Lord, all the earth. Worship the Lord with gladness; I now come before Him with joyful songs. I know that the Lord is God. It is he who made me, and I am his; we are his people, the sheep of his pasture. I now enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; I give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations.

Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

2. PURIFY YOURSELF

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: "Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way

everlasting." Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for.

Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

3. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following believing, in faith, for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God's Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

4. Intercede For YOUR Church

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped, gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God's work
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God's desires before their own.

5. Intercede for the 7+ Mountain Prayer Points

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God's will (Scripture) according to Job 22:28 "You will also declare a things and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways." (NKJ)

PRAYER POINTS

1Church Initiative PRAYER POINTS:

1. Pray for favor with church leaders as we seek to add 35 churches in each of the 64 counties across all of Colorado (over 2200 churches statewide).
2. Currently, there are 21 churches on the Prayer Wall. Pray that each church is able to fill their time slots from their congregation or are proactive to partner with another church so that there are no gaps in the Prayer Wall.
3. For accurate wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries and possessions).
4. For protection for the leadership team and their families: Fr. Phil Eberhart, Amy Everette, Jim Hepting, Yolanda & Brian Morris.
5. For Protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the 1Church Prayer Wall.
6. For wisdom and discernment as we invest in an update to a website to facilitate church participation in the 1Church Initiative: www.onevoice4t.org.

Culture-Wide Prayer Issues

Address the following issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Suicides among teens and adults
(Colorado is unusually high in suicides)
2. Drug Abuse
3. Abortion
4. Sex trafficking
5. Anarchy/Deep division among citizens
6. Homelessness in each Colorado city.

7+ Spheres of Influence – Prayer Points

GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that the senators and representatives for the state of Colorado will experience encounters with the Lord this summer instilling a biblical “fear of the Lord” so that they govern righteously and draft/support righteous laws. (Matt 11:15)
2. We decree and declare that any of our legislators who are supporters of ‘death’ via abortion, euthanasia or other means, will be removed from their positions of influence. That they be saved and turned to godly legislation or that their ability to influence laws for our state be removed. (Rom 13: 1-7)
3. We declare freedom over every person held in the sex trade in Colorado...even as our legislators establish “Safe Zones” in every Colorado city. We decree that Colorado is now known to “handlers” as the State to avoid because they are actively pursued and prosecuted here!

4. We decree that Colorado is a state filled with Christians who are actively involved and aware of their duties in civil government...at all city, county and state levels. (Job 22:28)
5. We use our authority in Christ to close all doors to the Spirit of death which was invited in by Planned Parenthood and the euthanasia bill. We declare a release of the Spirit of Life over the State of Colorado. Is 22:22

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray that Christian business people operate in abundance and not scarcity, while giving God all the glory.
2. Lord God we ask that You give business people new ways to move forward releasing a "win, win" atmosphere in the Denver metro area.
3. Lord, we ask for a release of Divine revelation to the people of Colorado that God can be trusted in the economy causing a shift toward trusting Him in all things.
4. We pray for a shift the minds of business people to faith in Your abundant release in the marketplace.
5. We ask Lord that You remove division in the marketplace and give business people eyes to see every possibility in You.
6. We pray for more opportunities for the Marketplace Prayer Trust to pray for, and encourage, businesses. More opportunities to hear your voice.

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. Believing teachers to remain faithful to teaching scriptural truth.
2. Teachers to now teach with godly wisdom.
3. Students learn to demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God.
4. Students take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ (2 Corinthians 10:3-5) - no more suicides!
5. Teachers are bold to teach students to fear the LORD (Proverbs 9:10).
6. Student leaders rise up with wisdom and understanding because they know their God (Daniel 1).

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray for more young people, called to the mountain of Arts and Entertainment, to ARISE!! That the next generation might know the Lord, and boldly tell their children, so that they will set their hope in God. (Psa 78:5,6)
2. That God would infuse the minds of creatives this month with new ideas for expressing God's character and Word through the mediums of music, poetry, scripts, dramas, commercials, books, cartoons, and any inspirational outlet that contains the voice and thumbprint of the Lord. That they would provide Godly influence from the youngest to the oldest. (Gen 1:27)

3. That just like Nehemiah was called to rebuild the Wall, those called to this mountain will run to Him, find their place on the Wall, and faithfully rebuild on this mountain for His kingdom and for His glory. (Neh. 6:3-6)
4. We pray for increased dependence on the Spirit of God and the ability to operate by His Spirit as we engage the arts/entertainment mountain in prayer covering for His advancement. (Heb 4:12)
5. We declare an increase in the number of Christian/family friendly films shown and concerts held throughout Colorado.
6. Pray for Butch and Juliann Hartman who are raising up their own Christian Cartoon Network called Noog Network which will reach young children with biblically principled, amazing cartoons! "Please pray for its success and God-inspired ideas to reaches MILLIONS of Kids."

FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. Read Exodus 14: 13-16 - When God parted the Red Sea. We say NO!! and raise our shields of faith to any more attacks on our teenagers. (a friend's son was lured out of state recently by drug dealing gangsters. Thankfully he has been returned and is now safe. Another friend's daughter took a bunch of pills and is now on suicide watch.) We declare war on the enemy's attacks on our teenagers. As in Exodus, we declare that our children are now delivered and protected from all harm.
2. We pray against attacks of the parents from their children. We now stand on Malachi 4:4 -6 declaring that the Lord is turning the hearts of the fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to their fathers, lest He comes and strikes the earth with a curse.
3. We declare unity in the family between husbands and wives!!! More Intimacy with the Father!
4. We declare that the Godly authority of parents is now protected against interference from anywhere (such as Planned Parenthood, Government, Religious organizations, schools, etc.).
5. We declare favor over husbands, wives and children; over work places; over ministries and over family finances.
6. WE also declare protection over families from sex trafficking in Jesus' name!!!!

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. We join together praying to Jesus that the glorious splendor of God's majesty and the glorious majesty of His kingdom would be revealed to Your Body, the church. Ps 145: 5, 12
2. We also cry out that the Church of Jesus Christ now actively displays the glorious splendor of God's majesty and the glorious majesty of His kingdom to all of Colorado... for Your Glory. Ps 145: 5, 12
3. We call Your Church to Sing, Shout and Proclaim... "O Lord Save Colorado!" Jer 31:7
4. We make supplication O God, that churches will partner with other churches, ministries and organizations to advance Your kingdom, and kingdom principles here in Colorado as it is in Heaven.
5. We decree support, unity and agreement amongst churches and ministries in Colorado. Amos 3:3

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. In the Name of Jesus, The Breaker, we declare that He now goes before us to break up and break through every ungodly gate over the media mountain throughout Colorado. (Mic 2:13)
2. We decree that Jesus the Christ is King of kings and Lord of Lords over every aspect of media throughout Colorado. (Eph 1:20-21)
3. We ask Lord God that You send Michael, Your archangel, to battle against and defeat the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms over the media mountain in Colorado. (Dan 10:13, Rec 12:7-8)
4. Lord God You put all things under the feet of Jesus and appointed Him head over everything including the media in Colorado (Eph 1:22). We now we call believers in media to take their rightful position as members of His body operating in His authority to release God's will into every aspect of media statewide.
5. By the Grace of our Lord Jesus Christ and by the gift of righteousness of faith in God, we declare that the media mountain now comes under the government of God Almighty. (Rom 5:17, Rev 1:4-6)

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. Pray that all first responders (fire, police, sheriff, ambulance workers, etc.) would experience strong positive encouragement and reinforcement from their families and their community. (1Tim 2:1-2)
2. Pray that there will be no on-the-job injuries of any kind among first responders for the remainder of this year. (Isa 54.17)
3. Pray that every non-believing first responder has an encounter with the living God and receives Jesus as their savior. (Matt 11:15)
4. Pray that every first responder is immune to tunnel vision and is acutely aware of possible dangers in every situation they encounter. (Jam 1:5)
5. Pray for the family of Lieutenant Allen who was killed because he was "in the black" with tunnel vision – unaware of the danger from a suspect who was in a roll over accident.
6. Pray that believing first responders seek greater intimacy with Father God so that they grow in spiritual maturity and authority resulting in favor with the Lord and with men. (1Sam 2:26)
