Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

## PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in this Digest to guide your prayers for Colorado, Colorado Prays and the Fields of Harvest statewide. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

## Core Prayer Points for Colorado:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed, and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as churches in every city now meet the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted, or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of the Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

## Colorado Prays: Ministry Prayer Points:

1. We pray blessings on the 60+ pastors and their churches that each host a monthly Church Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays...let them each continue to complete their 24-hour Prayer Watch each month.
2. We now call forth 30+ Colorado churches in each of the 64 counties to engage in the Church Prayer Watch which will cover every county in non-stop, day and night prayer.
3. We pray for creative ways to engage young people in one or more of the Colorado Prays prayer initiatives or become a social media Prayer Influencer who encourages others to pray for our state.
4. We ask for blessings and favor for someone to join our leadership team to raise up and direct social media Prayer Influencers and someone to guide our fund-raising efforts.

7. We ask for protection and wisdom for every Colorado Prays Board member including Amy, Brad, Phil, Brittany, Mark, Kristen and Mike.
8. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Field of Harvest Prayer Team leaders who are laser-focused on each of the Fields of Harvest covered in this Prayer Digest. Protect each of them physically and spiritually Lord God.

## Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/foh-teams>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

### Colorado Prays for MEDIA:

1. We pray that Colorado's landmark AI regulations protect every person, especially children, from harm, deception, and manipulation by artificial intelligence in every form of media and technology.
2. We pray that Colorado public broadcasters now emerge from every merger and funding battle stronger and more committed than ever to serving their communities with truth.
3. We decree that the Sundance Film Festival's arrival in Colorado now becomes a divine open door, and that God places His people in every room where stories are told to carry His light into the film industry.

### Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We praise You, Lord, for answering our prayers with the hiring of Kristy Neeley as Executive Director of ProLife Colorado, and we ask You to fill her with joy, wisdom, fresh ideas, unity, and protection as she leads this vital work (Psalm 136).
2. We humbly ask, Lord, for clear strategies, open doors, and the right people to step forward to address maternity and rural care voids across Colorado, bringing life-affirming medical care to every community that needs it (Jeremiah 8:22).
3. We cry out for more trauma-informed mental health professionals across Colorado who are trained to bring healing to those suffering from traumatic grief and moral injury related to abortion, trusting You to raise up workers and meet every need (Jeremiah 30:17).
4. Lord, we humbly kneel at your feet and plead for every little one in Colorado whose life is at risk from abortion today, asking You for mercy, for hearts to be changed, and for eyes to be opened to the full reality of the full effects of abortion on mom, baby, and those around them." (Matthew 18:10).
5. We declare that the Church in Colorado now rises as the solution, grounding families in truth, serving those in need, offering gospel-based healing, and standing firm against this evil, knowing the gates of hell will not prevail against her (Luke 10:25-37; Matthew 16:18).

### Colorado Prays for MUSLIMS:

1. Father, we lift up Colorado's 2026 elections, asking that no ungodly political pressure shape the outcome and that the Muslim vote carries no viable power or influence.
2. Lord, may you grant wisdom to every Colorado commission reviewing mosque and training center approvals, and raise up believers who will speak truth in love.
3. Father, we ask that you guard Colorado pulpits from any blending of the Gospel with other faiths keeping our pastors faithful to the message of Jesus alone.
4. Lord, give Colorado Christians a spirit of discernment to research and verify, and expose any fraud or hidden agendas behind land purchases and fundraising in our state.

## Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. We declare, as written in Malachi 4:6, that the hearts of fathers are now turning to their children and children to their fathers across Colorado, and we ask You, Lord, for a supernatural spirit of love and protection to overtake every parent of the born and unborn in our state.
2. We pray for the harvesters (volunteers) to take their places and do the work of the Kingdom for families across Colorado.
3. We declare, as written in Isaiah 54:2-3, that the Church in Colorado now stretches wide her tent stakes to welcome more families and children into Godly community, and we ask You to stir a deep longing in every heart to return to Your house.
4. We praise You, Lord, for opening eyes across Colorado to see clearly what is happening in our culture, and we ask for supernatural wisdom to know how to reshape it into what Your heart desires.
5. We praise You, Lord, that You love and care for every family, for the born and the unborn, and we declare that Your people in Colorado now rise as a bold remnant to retake and occupy every spiritual and physical place You have given us.

## Colorado Prays for the ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT:

1. We declare that every closet Christian in Colorado's creative world now steps boldly into the light, joining the Body of Christ and unleashing their God-given talents for His glory.
2. We call forth a generation of young Colorado creatives who know Jesus alone is worthy of worship and boldly spread His good news through every art form.
3. Lord, let a river of joy and godly creativity flow through Colorado's arts community, drawing the talented and the searching straight to Your Spirit.
4. We decree that every form of exploitation and darkness hidden within Colorado's arts and entertainment industry is now fully exposed and dismantled by the light of Jesus Christ.
5. We declare that the Church in Colorado is wide awake — every believer with a creative gift now stepping boldly onto every stage, screen, and platform for the glory of God.

## Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. We declare that Colorado's churches and religious schools now stand fully protected in their God-given freedoms, and every effort to shut faith out of public life now fails.
2. We pray that every pastor and leader across Colorado in this season carries a fresh mantle of humility and servant leadership.
3. We declare that the Church of Colorado is now stirred with compassion to draw the spiritually hungry into a genuine encounter with Jesus Christ.
4. We decree that Colorado's youth be touched and burdened to become bold witnesses for Jesus Christ, taking the Gospel into every school, campus, and community across our state.
5. We pray that the growing fellowship among Colorado's pastors now moves beyond encouragement, shifting the spiritual climate of every city and county in our state.

## Colorado Prays for Freedom From Trafficking:

1. We decree in the mighty name of Jesus that every trafficking network in Colorado is now exposed and dismantled, for nothing hidden will escape His light (Luke 8:17).
2. We declare divine protection over every child and vulnerable person in Colorado, commanding His angels to guard them day and night against every predator (Psalm 91:11).
3. We ask, Lord, for supernatural wisdom and favor upon every officer, advocate, and ministry fighting trafficking in Colorado, declaring no weapon formed against this work will prosper (Isaiah 54:17).
4. We declare liberty, healing, and full restoration over every trafficking survivor in Colorado, by the same Spirit who came to set every captive free (Isaiah 61:1).
5. We decree that Colorado is a land of justice and freedom where the light of Christ exposes every darkness, rescues every captive, and establishes His righteousness from border to border.

## Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. In great faith, we thank You, Lord, for securing the boundaries of the state of Colorado with Your governmental authority, increasing protection in the natural realm from drug lords, human trafficking, and crime.
2. We praise God for Colorado believers, from every corner of the state, who are now walking in a greater level of faith and spiritual governmental authority to shift the statewide spiritual climate, as confirmed by prophetic voices from outside of this state.
3. We declare a release of great courage and boldness among conservatives statewide to stand for biblical morality in our local and state governments.
4. We declare that God's people will fully follow You alone, Lord God, reclaiming Colorado and its government structure for Your glory.
5. We declare a dramatic increase in godly hope among all Coloradans, resulting in a dramatic increase in the number of conservative voters casting their ballots in November.

## Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. We humbly ask, Lord, that every Colorado worker who is brokenhearted or crushed in spirit today knows You are near to them right where they are, in every office, job site, and place of business (Psalm 34:18).
2. We pray, Lord, that every believer carrying grief or loss in Colorado's marketplace finds the comfort that only You can give, knowing You see every burden they carry (Matthew 5:4).
3. We declare over every Colorado worker that there be no fear or dismay, for You, Lord, You are the God who strengthens, helps, and upholds them with Your righteous right hand (Isaiah 41:10).
4. We pray that the peace Jesus gave to us, the peace the world cannot give, now guards the heart of every believer in Colorado's marketplace against fear and anxiety (John 14:27).
5. We declare that the God of hope now fills every Colorado worker with joy and peace in believing, causing hope to overflow in them by the power of the Holy Spirit (Romans 15:13).

## Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. We thank You, Lord, for every first responder in Colorado who has answered the call You placed on their life to serve, protect, and bring order to our communities (Isaiah 6:8).
2. We ask, Lord, that You command Your angels to guard every first responder on and off duty, keeping them and their families safe from every seen and unseen danger (Psalm 91:11).
3. We declare that every first responder in Colorado is Your servant for our good, and we pray they walk in that calling with courage, integrity, and the knowledge that You go before them (Romans 13:4).
4. We pray that every first responder who walks through darkness and trauma on the job knows You are with them, finding their strength and peace in You alone (Psalm 23:4).
5. We ask, Lord, that You stir deep and genuine gratitude in the hearts of all Coloradans for those who sacrifice daily to keep us safe, and that our thankfulness always point back to You (1 Thessalonians 5:18).

## Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. We pray that truth and God's unchanging standard now govern every Colorado classroom and that every divisive ideology loses its foothold in our children's education.
2. We pray that every door closed to faith-based education in Colorado now reopens and that Christian families across our state are free to raise God-fearing individuals as the next generation.
3. We cry out, Lord, for Colorado's children who are still struggling in classrooms and ask that every school becomes a place where students thrive and excel in learning.
4. We pray that Colorado voters choose wisely this November on school funding and that every decision made serves our children's futures with righteousness and wisdom.
5. We pray that every Colorado teacher who shows up faithfully is seen, strengthened, and sustained in the mighty name of Jesus.

## Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. We pray, Lord, that you now accomplish Your will and purposes in Iran, drawing the Iranian people to Himself and pouring out His Holy Spirit across the entire Middle East.
2. We declare blessings over every Christian and Messianic community in Israel that they be led by the Holy Spirit and bear lasting fruit unto salvation among every people and background.
3. We pray, Lord, as written in Ezekiel 11:19 and Jeremiah 32:39, that the people of Israel now receive an undivided heart and singleness of purpose for Your glory.
4. We ask, Lord, that You bless and expand Israel's cooperation with her neighbors in agriculture, environment, and technology for the benefit of all peoples willing to work together in peace.
5. We pray for healing in body, soul, and spirit for all in Israel and the innocent people in surrounding countries who have suffered loss or trauma that they find their only true comfort in You, Lord Jesus.

## Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. We pray that every decision about Colorado's aging power plants is guided by God's wisdom and that no Colorado family is ever left without reliable, affordable power.
2. We declare that Colorado's conversation around nuclear energy is now covered in discernment and the fear of the Lord and that every path chosen truly serves the people of our state.
3. We thank You, Lord, for every new energy project breaking ground across Colorado, and we ask that Your provision flow through every investment in our state's grid.
4. We declare that the energy resource God placed beneath Colorado's soil is now unlocked for the good of all Coloradans, bringing relief and independence from volatile energy markets.
5. We pray that Colorado's growing energy partnerships produce fruit that blesses every community and that believers in every boardroom and job site carry the light of Christ into the energy industry.
