TOPIC: FEAR OF THE LORD

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

FEAR OF THE LORD

It is important to understand what the "fear of the Lord" truly is. It is not being so afraid of God that we hide ourselves in fear that we will be struck down or sent to hell because of our mistakes. That erroneous understanding does not show the depth of love and forgiveness that Father God gives to each of us. The "Fear of the Lord" is quite the opposite, it's being so awestruck with God that one can't help but to love, reverence, honor, and have a deep respect for Him. This healthy understanding of "Fear of the Lord," stirs up a passionate desire in believers to draw closer to God and live a life that honors Him by aligning with His will and purposes. As a result, it shows great wisdom and respect when we choose to "Fear the Lord".

Scripture repeatedly affirms that this fear is the beginning of true wisdom: "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge; fools despise wisdom and instruction" (Proverbs 1:7, ESV). Similarly, Proverbs 9:10 declares, "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and the knowledge of the Holy One is insight." To fear the Lord, then, is to rightly understand one's place before Him—to acknowledge that all wisdom, righteousness, and blessing flow from walking in reverent submission to His will.

Blessing Declarations for November 8: FEAR OF THE LORD

In the New Testament, this reverence remains essential for believers. Paul exhorts Christians to “work out your own salvation with fear and trembling” (Philippians 2:12), not out of dread, but in humble recognition of God’s holiness and grace. Ultimately, the fear of the Lord draws the heart into right relationship with God—it purifies motives, guards against sin, and anchors one’s life in awe-filled devotion to the Creator and Redeemer. You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

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1. We bless the people and land of Colorado with the desire to revere God alone as it is written in Psalm 33:8 “Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him!”
 2. As written in Proverbs 1:7, We bless Colorado believers to walk in the Fear of the Lord letting His wisdom guide their steps.
 3. We bless every person in Colorado to walk in obedience to God in the reverential Fear of the Lord according to Psalm 128:1 which reads “Blessed is everyone who fears the LORD, who walks in His ways.”
 4. As it is written in Isaiah 33:6, we declare that the Fear of the Lord is now establishing God’s “sure foundation for your times, a rich store of salvation and wisdom and knowledge; the fear of the Lord is the key to this treasure.”
 5. As it is written in Proverbs 14:26, we declare that the Fear of the Lord is now creating a secure fortress for each Colorado family, and their children.
 6. We bless the people of Colorado with the fruit of Fearing the Lord as written in Psalm 34:9 which says, “Fear the Lord, you his holy people, for those who fear him lack nothing.”
 7. We bless the Ecclesia of Colorado to hate all evil as it is written in Proverbs 8:13 “To fear the Lord is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech.”
 8. As Peter wrote in 1 Peter 1: 14-16, we bless and call every Colorado believer to be “as obedient children, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance. But just as he who called you is holy, so be holy in all you do; ¹⁶for it is written: “Be holy, because I am holy.”
 9. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to walk in obedience to God’s word as written in Proverbs 8:13 “To fear the Lord is to hate evil; I hate pride and arrogance, evil behavior and perverse speech.”
 10. We bless Colorado believers with the understanding of the value of the healthy fear of the Lord as written in Psalm 103:11 “For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is His love for those who fear him.” Let every believer who submits to the Fear of the Lord now experience the amazing heights and depths of God’s love God for them.
 11. We bless God’s children across Colorado to experience what is written in Proverbs 14: 27 “The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, turning a person from the snares of death.”
 12. We bless the people of Colorado and every generation to come with the truth of Psalm 103:17 “But from everlasting to everlasting the Lord’s love is with those who fear Him, and His righteousness with their children’s children.”
 13. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the fruit of the Fear of the Lord as it is written in Proverbs 19:23 “The Fear of the Lord leads to life; then one rests content, untouched by trouble.”
 14. We decree Psalm 128:1, to the people of Colorado “How blessed is everyone who fears the Lord; who walks in His ways.”
 15. We bless every Colorado believer with God’s mercy as it is written in Luke 1:50; “His Mercy is for those who fear him from generation to generation.”
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
