TOPIC: Thy Will Be Done

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering Believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth as it is in Heaven and shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

THY WILL BE DONE

Through July of this year, we will be releasing Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:10. Last month, we focused on "Thy Kingdom Come". This month, we move on to the next phrase "Thy Will Be Done." This phrase, taught by Jesus, expresses the desire of Believers for God's purposes, authority, and plans to be fulfilled on earth just as perfectly as they are in heaven. At the core, He was teaching all believers to submit their desires and decisions to God's authority. It is acknowledgement that that God's wisdom and purposes are higher than human understanding as written in Isaiah 55: 8-9, which tells us "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord." This phrase is a declaration of trust, surrender and submission to God's plan for our lives and families.

"Thy will be done" also communicates a willingness to actively obey what God has revealed through revelation and scripture. As written in James 1:22, we are to "be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving

yourselves.” That means applying God’s Word in daily life to align with God’s commands and purposes. It requires faith and trust in God and His Word to be obedient, but it is “better than sacrifice” (1 Samuel 15:22).

The blessing declarations we release this month will focus on both God’s Perfect (Sovereign) Will and His Moral (Revealed) Will. As described in Psalm 33:11, God’s Perfect Will refers to His sovereign plan and purposes which cannot ultimately be stopped or changed: “The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of his heart to all generations.” It is the unfolding of His divine plan in history.

God’s Moral (Revealed) Will is evident throughout scripture as His standards of righteousness. It describes what God desires people to do and how they should live. Unlike God’s sovereign will, people can choose to disobey His moral will, which is why Scripture frequently calls people to repentance and obedience. Let’s believe that people in Colorado will humble themselves and submit to God’s will.

Join with us as we declare God’s will be done through the people and land of Colorado.

Blessing Declarations March 14: *THY WILL BE DONE*

1. We agree with God’s will to do what He has predetermined for Colorado as written in Psalm 24:1 AMP. “The Earth is the Lord’s, and the fullness of it, the world and they who dwell in it.”
2. We bless the people of Colorado to now receive revelation to understand God’s sovereignty and come into alignment with what is written in Daniel 4:35 “*He does according to His will in the army of heaven and among the inhabitants of the earth. No one can restrain His hand or say to Him, “What have You done?”*”
3. Lord Jesus, we bless the people and land of Colorado to experience the manifested truth of Your will being done on earth as it is in heaven as You taught us to pray in Matthew 6:10 “*Your kingdom come. Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven.*”
4. We bless Colorado to now align with God’s sovereign will for our state because it cannot be stopped as stated in Acts 4:28 (AMP) “*to do whatever Your hand and Your purpose predestined [before the creation of the world] to occur [and so without knowing it, they served Your own purpose].*”
5. We bless Colorado Believers with humility to submit fully to God’s sovereign will, a desire to surrender their will to God’s will, along with a passionate love for God which causes them to set aside their self-will and seek God’s will as Jesus demonstrated in Luke 22:42 “*Father, if it is Your will, take this cup away from Me; nevertheless not My will, but Yours, be done.*”
6. As it is written in Romans 8:28, we bless those in Colorado who are called by God with fresh understanding that submitting to His will and purpose works together for their good because “...we know that all things work together for good to those who love God, to those who love God, to those who are the called according to His purpose.”
7. We bless Believers statewide with a willingness to submit to God’s will as written in 1Peter 3:17 “*For it is better that you suffer [unjustly] for doing what is right, if that should be God’s will, than [to suffer justly] for doing wrong.*”
8. We bless Your Colorado Ecclesia with the transforming truth of God’ good, acceptable and perfect will as written in Romans 12:2, “*And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.*”
9. We declare that a greater number of Believers are now obedient to give thanks to God for all things as it is written in 1 Thessalonians 5:18, “*in everything give thanks; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.*”

10. We thank You Lord God that You are making every Colorado Believer complete in every good work to do Your will according to Hebrews 13:20-21, *“Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you what is well pleasing in His sight, through Jesus Christ, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.”*
11. We bless the people of Colorado with the invitation to adhere to God’s goodness and will, walking humbly with Him, loving mercy and justice as it is written in Micah 6:8, *“He has shown you, O man, what is good; And what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with your God?”*
12. We stand in humble faith believing that this is a Kairos time for Colorado to see His great glory manifest in our midst. Let the Believers statewide now *“Humble yourselves, therefore, under the mighty hand of God so that at the proper time He may exalt you.”* 1 Peter 5:6.
13. We bless Colorado Believers with the Word of God in Isaiah 46:10 which reads *“My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please.”*
14. We declare that the Colorado Ecclesia is blessed to rely on God’s plans, purposes and will for our state as it is written in Jeremiah 29: 11-14 (NLT) *“For I know the plans I have for you, says the LORD. They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me. I will be found by you, says the LORD. I will end your captivity and restore your fortunes.”*
15. We bless Believers statewide to submit to God’s will and purpose for their life as written in Proverbs 19:21, *“Many are the plans in a person’s heart, but it is the LORD’s purpose that prevails.”*
