We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). When the Church Prayer Watch and County Prayer Watches are fully subscribed, Colorado will be covered 3 times in non-stop, day and night prayer!

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by 9 prayer leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during their monthly prayer time. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

Get your bible and a notebook/pen. Set yourself apart from distractions. Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

A prayer for you: Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.



3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *"Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting."* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- · loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. Phil. 2:13
- · earnestly seeks God. Ps. 63:1
- · loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.-Ps.122:1
- · deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God's Word. Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- · Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- · God builds the House and has His way there.
- · Church members keep, guard and protect God's work.
- · Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- · The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- · Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- · Leaders put God's desires before their own.



PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

- 1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
- 3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
- 4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
- 5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
- 6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
- 7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
- 8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
- 9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
- 10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
- 11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
- 12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
- 13. We declare that the hearts of the people of The Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
- 14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

- 6. We pray that each participating church in the Church Prayer Watch Initiative faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch and is blessed by their participation in Colorado Prays.
- 7. We ask for protection and wisdom for every Colorado Prays Board member including Amy, Brad, Phil, Brittany, Mark and Mike.
- 8. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the 12 Prayer Trust leaders who are laser-focused on each of the fields of harvest covered in this Prayer Digest and for their physical and spiritual protection. We pray blessings on our Prayer Trust Leaders: John, Marcia, Angela, MaryAnn, Phil, Kaity, Nic, Gaylyn, Laura, CJ and Toni.

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

Colorado Prays for MEDIA:

- 1. We ask You, Lord God, to abundantly pour out Your Presence on every person in media across Colorado to remove any veils of deception from their eyes and allow them to have radical encounters with You that bring freedom to everyone in media statewide. (2 Cor 3:16-18).
- 2. We ask You, Jesus Christ, to reveal the depth, width, length and height of Your love to every believer in, and through, Colorado media. (Eph 3: 17-20)
- 3. Let every believer in Colorado media now experience Your love and have no fear as they share Your love with others. (1 John 4:16-19)
- 4. Father God, we ask that You give Your believers in Colorado media Your boldness which causes them to walk righteously before You, bold as lions broadcasting Your love and truth. (Proverbs 28:1)
- 5. Father God, Thank You for Your Jesus followers in media throughout Colorado. Continue the work of sanctification in their lives. Draw them to walk closer and closer with You each day to become fruitful in every area of their lives including their creative gifting. (2 Peter 1:4-8)
- 6. Father God, protect Your followers that are in media from the evil one. As their Shepherd, keep them safe as they wage war against the evil one in the secular areas of media. (John 10:9-11)

Colorado Prays for CHURCH:

- 1. We declare that every pastor, reverend and priest across Colorado now awakens to the Truth of Jesus Christ as King of kings and Lord of lords over their lives and over all of Colorado. (1Tim 6:15)
- 2. We thank You, Lord God, for releasing Your Holy Spirit in power and might to snap every Jesus-believing Colorado Church into alignment with God's will on Earth as it is in Heaven. (Matt 6:10)
- 3. We declare that every church leader across Colorado is now infused with a Holy Spirit backbone which causes them to no longer defile themselves with worldly ways as they stand proactively for our God's justice and righteousness. (Dan 1: 8-20)
- 4. We declare: "Church, arise across Colorado and put on the full armor of God every day." Let us now fight together in the John 17 oneness of Christ's love against the tactics of Satan and his minions. (Eph 6: 10-18)
- 5. We declare to every believer across Colorado: "You are a minister of the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Go forth and share the love of Jesus with others through prayer and service."

COLORADO

Colorado Prays for The MARKETPLACE:

- 1. We declare Psalm 55:22 over every person working in the Colorado marketplace: "Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken."
- 2. We declare to people working in businesses statewide, that God will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. Psalm 91:4
- 3. We declare that our God will refresh the weary and satisfy the faint in the Colorado marketplace based on Jeremiah 31:25.
- 4. We proclaim Psalm 62:2 which declares that truly He is your Rock and your Salvation; He is your Fortress, you will never be shaken in the Colorado marketplace. Psalm 62:2
- 5. We declare, "Trust in God" to every worker across Colorado, for "He will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in Him." Isaiah 26:3

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

- 1. We ask, Lord God, that You bless all your First Responders across Colorado with a closer walk with You as they allow you to be the Guiding Light in their lives.
- 2. Prompt each believing First Responder to start and end every day and shift with a special time with You for prayer, guidance, and thanksgiving.
- 3. Give First Responders a heightened awareness of your Holy Spirit's presence within them to encourage them throughout their day.
- 4. Help each believer and their family to always be open to receive Your wisdom and guidance through Your written Word, the trustworthy words of other believers and through other cues you may give them day by day.
- 5. Lead each believer to incorporate Your communication with them in all areas of their life, especially when on duty, so that their actions are Spirit-led.
- 6. Help them to listen to Your small, quiet voice and to respond appropriately in immediate obedience to Your guidance.
- 7. Help them to be sensitive to the nudging, feelings and other nonverbal cues You give them so that they may make God-guided decisions and actions for their own good and the good of those they serve.
- 8. Give each First Responder "divine appointments" that increase their effectiveness in protecting and serving others and in keeping themselves safe.
- 9. Help them to incorporate Your teaching in how they live their lives by putting You first, then their family, coworkers, and those they serve.
- 10. Help every believing First Responder to always go forth rejoicing in the presence and power of the Holy Spirit in their lives.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

- 1. Heavenly Father, we pray for favor and open doors for Christian college ministries to lovingly dialogue and build relationships on every college campus to counter anti-Semitism and anti-Zionism.
- 2. Father God, we ask for open doors for new relationships and enhanced communications between the Jewish community and Christian churches in every Colorado community. Let them be strengthened with cords of love, honor, respect and friendship.
- 3. As Your covenant is with us day and night (JER 22), so is Your covenant with the Jewish people. We declare that this covenant of faithfulness now be manifest and understood in every church in Colorado.
- 4. We declare a Psalm 91 hedge of protection around Colorado Jewish communities, synagogues and neighborhoods against acts of violence and anti-Semitism.
- 5. We pray for our state government to now stand strong and steadfast in its support of Israel.
- 6. We continue to pray for supernatural Godly wisdom, counsel, strategies, plans and endurance for the government and military leaders in Israel. May they be in one accord as they fight this war, bring an end to Hamas and establish safety from all enemies on every front.
- 7. We declare a new level of safety for every IDF soldier, that You would watch over and keep them safe in every operation they carry out. We pray for refreshing of body, soul and spirit as they have to be away from their families. Watch over and provide for their families.
- 8. We pray for breakthroughs in discovering the locations and rescuing the remaining hostages, and for healing and wholeness for all those suffering from hurt and loss.
- 9. We pray for humanitarian aid from the nations to pour into Israel as they deal with the cost of war, the needs of displaced people, families of soldiers who are unable to work their jobs, the economy put on hold, the cost of caring for the sick and wounded, etc., etc. Let us be their helping hands!
- 10. We pray for the Jewish and Arab believers in Israel to work together for the good of all their people.
- 11. We pray for an outpouring of Holy Spirit among the Palestinians and among Muslims. Give them dreams and visions of who Jesus is for them!

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

- 1. We declare that Jesus Christ is King over every classroom in every Colorado community statewide.
- 2. Thank You, Jesus, for Your blood which You already applied to our students, teachers, staff and administrators. May it be applied again with increase.
- 3. Lord, we ask that You now awaken and engage more parents with hearts to raise up their children in the way they should go and You would give them the courage to be obedient to Your will for their children. (Proverbs 22:6, Duet. 6:4-9 and Psalm 78:5-8)
- 4. Lord God Almighty, we pray that You put into place good, just, merciful and God-fearing leaders over our Colorado schools, that our students, families and communities would now have peace.
- 5. We ask, Lord, for an outpouring of Your love to be experienced and felt by every Colorado youth which softens their hearts to hear and receive the gospel.



Colorado Prays for FAMILY:

- 1. We pray for new Godly organizations and opportunities to open up for families in Colorado, that they may be successful and impactful.
- 2. We pray that the Lord would give new strategies to organizations to strengthen the family and be as effective as possible in the state of Colorado.
- 3. We pray for the volunteers who are giving their time and resources towards helping Colorado families, that they would be overwhelmingly blessed and fulfilled in all that they need.
- 4. We pray for the hearts of the churches to turn towards the needs of their local community. We pray for a renewed spirit of brotherly love towards our neighbors that the church may show them Jesus in a true and loving way.
- 5. We thank You, Lord, for all the progress and open doors that have already made such a difference for families in Colorado. We thank You for the forerunners and pray for their endurance and boldness to continue to do a good work in Colorado.

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

- 1. We declare in the name of Jesus that the energy field is now led by the Holy Spirit because every leader is filled with wisdom that is God-inspired and has eyes that actively seek His guidance without interference from the allure of ungodly actions.
- 2. Let the Lord show each worker in the energy sector how to navigate the pathway that God sets before them, whether that be through new inventions, better safety, or better ways to conserve the blessings God has given them.
- 3. We declare that Jesus is King over the Colorado energy field and that His love and salvation is now sweeping over the people that work in the energy sector. We pray and declare that not one would be lost so that all would come to the saving knowledge of Jesus.
- 4. Let the entire energy sector of Colorado now be filled with God's manifest Presence which draws workers closer to Him.
- 5. Let every Colorado business in the energy sector now grow and expand in abundance.
- 6. We declare that energy businesses are now run by owners who stand firm against politicians who do not call Jesus their Lord.
- 7. We declare that governmental decisions affecting the energy industry are now led by Spirit-filled believers who choose to serve God above all else.
- 8. We declare that every godly energy bill being considered for the November ballot will be approved for the ballot and approved by the voters of Colorado.
- 9. We declare that godly politicians now serve in our House and Senate to support and expand energy businesses statewide.
- 10. We declare safety over the workers and the families of the oil and energy sector. Lift them up in Your arms, Lord God, as they work hard doing dangerous jobs. Fill their heart with joy, gladness and purpose.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

- 1. Lord, we declare that the parental rights hearings will go in favor of righteousness. Your plan will prevail in the Name of Jesus.
- 2. We stand as the Ecclesia and decree that You, Lord God, are the Judge who judges the judges.
- 3. We declare that it is time for righteous judges to now be in place at all levels in our state.
- 4. Numbers 23:19 states that our God is not a man that He should lie, therefore we decree that Your biblical Truth now prevails over the state of Colorado, at all levels of government.
- 5. Just as 2024 is the year of the open door, we declare that the State of Colorado is now open to truth, open to receive Jesus in every home and open to a right-standing government at the city, county and state level.
- 6. We bless our representatives and senators who stand on the Truth of God's Word as they speak and war for our state. Guide them, Lord, to war over righteous laws, righteous resolutions, individual concerns and community issues important to the people of God and all Coloradans.

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

- 1. As we grieve over the loss of innocent lives, we humbly ask for forgiveness, Lord God, for allowing them to be taken and we ask that Your name be glorified through us as we choose to give You glory, honor and praise in our efforts to stand for life and be a voice for the vulnerable. (2 Cor 12:9)
- 2. We declare that the people of Colorado now remember that God's Word calls us to "Defend the weak and the fatherless as we uphold the cause of the poor and the oppressed, and rescue the weak and the needy, delivering them from the hand of the wicked." Ps 82:3-4
- 3. We declare that the people of Colorado now choose to "Rescue those being led away to death by holding back those staggering toward slaughter." Prov 24:11
- 4. Lord, help us to remember that those who are pro-choice are not the enemy but rather trapped and enslaved by the devil who has taken them captive to do his will. Let us bless and not curse them.
- 5. We pray that every abortion worker now be awakened to the evil they are doing, and that You use their redemption to move them into ministries to combat this evil and bring healing for those affected by it.
- 6. We declare that the time is soon coming when abortion and assisted suicide will be so fowl and bitter, so abhorrent and unthinkable, that our state will be transformed into a culture of life.
- 7. We ask, Lord, for sidewalk advocates to be outside every Colorado abortion facility carrying God's Presence with such intense manifestation that not one pregnant woman wants to set foot in them again.
- 8. We ask for favor and blessing on the first Colorado March for Life set for April 12. Bring the right speakers, Lord God, the people to rally, favorable media coverage and protection for all in attendance; let lives be changed to protect Life.



Colorado Prays for ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT:

- 1. We proclaim to the Bride of Christ in Colorado: "Lift your gaze," as you now enjoy Godly arts and entertainment!
- 2. We declare that Coloradans now set their affections and attention on the things above not the things below so that hope now arises as our worship ascends through the arts.
- 3. Let Coloradans now lift their spiritual gaze upon God's beauty alone for we "Behold the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world" Psalm 121:1, John 1:29, I Peter 1:3-6
- 4. We declare that, in Colorado, the Exalted Lamb of God who was slain will receive the reward of His suffering through an increase in humility flowing from church pulpits, songs, and sermons. Let church services now draw humbled hearts to join in the song of the Redeemed at the altar in worship before His throne. Rev 5:8-14
- 5. We declare a soon coming time when stories are shared of the masses responding to the Salvation message of the Cross as the Church collectively displays the power of the Cross in their sermons, songs, productions, skits, outreaches, and services.
- 6. May our worship services this Easter be electrified with the Redemption story of Christ, bringing all to repentance. Isaiah 1:18, Col. 2:13-14
- 7. We declare that the airwaves in Colorado are now filled with God's presence and power as the saints of God release His worship! "But I will sing of Your power; yes, I will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; for You have been my defense and refuge in the day of trouble. To You, O my Strength, I will sing praises; for God is my defense, my God of mercy." Psalm 59:16–17—NKJV)
- 8. We declare that the new song in Colorado is now opening portals of glory over Colorado. "They sang a new song saying, 'You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth.'" Rev. 5:9-10, Psalm 96
- 9. We command the lies, confusion, delusion, and destruction attacking the hearts, minds, ears, and eyes of the saints in Colorado to now stop in the Name of Jesus Christ because Jehovah Nissi, our Banner, is lifting up a standard against the enemy.
- 10. We declare that the Son of God, who is being revealed, is now turning every ungodly strategy back toward the enemy's camp and bringing destruction to the enemy's plans and schemes. Hallelujah! I John 3:8, John 10:9-10, Is. 59:19-20
