...for Unity in the Body of Christ (phase 1)

Blessing Saturdays These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the Kingdom Stewards Network. The purpose of the declarations is to speak God's Word over the state of Colorado because, as written in Isa 55:11 "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty, but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him....positioning yourself

seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6)

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the

Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

- 1. We declare as it is written in Eph 2:14, that Jesus is our peace who tore down the dividing wall of hostility between Jew and Gentile. We ask Lord God that You now further tear down the divisions in Your redeemed Colorado family and make us One, by the Spirit.
- 2. We decree to the Colorado Ecclesia as Jesus said in John 17:21-23, that you all may be one, as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You; that they also may be one in Us, that the world may believe that You sent me. And the glory which You gave Me I have given them, that they may be one just as We are one: I in them, and You in Me.
- 3. We decree as it is written in John 17:23 that believers across Colorado are now made perfect in one, and that the world now knows that God sent Jesus.
- 4. As it is written in Psa 133:1, we bless the body of Christ across Colorado as they now choose to dwell together in unity, for it is good and pleasant.
- 5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to be transformed into the elect of God, holy and beloved functioning as it is written in Col 3: 12-17, "we have been called to be one mind; to put on tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness, longsuffering; bearing with one another, and forgiving one another, if anyone has a complaint against another; even as Christ forgave you, so you also *must do*. But above all these things put on love, which is the bond of perfection. And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly in all wisdom, teaching and admonishing one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with grace in your hearts to the

- Lord. And whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him."
- 6. We decree to the people of Colorado as it is written in Rom 15: 5-6: Now may the God of patience and comfort grant you to be like-minded toward one another, according to Christ Jesus, that you may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.
- 7. We decree that the Ecclesia of Colorado is now of one mind as written in 1 Peter 3: 8-9, reflecting the mind of Christ, and showing compassion for one another, and has love and tenderheartedness towards one another always. May we honor and bless one another and know that as we do, so we will also inherit blessings.
- 8. As it is written in 1Cor 12:13 and Acts 4:32, we now bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the revelation and understanding that we have been baptized into one body with one heart and mind regardless of background (Jew or Greek, slave or free). We are part of the same body of Christ and drink deeply from the same Holy Spirit.
- 9. We decree as it is written in Phil 2:1-4 Therefore if you have any encouragement from being united with Christ, if any comfort from his love, if any common sharing in the Spirit, if any tenderness and compassion, then make My joy complete by being like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind. Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others.
- 10. We decree to believers across Colorado as it is written in Eph 2: 21-22 In Him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in Him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by his Spirit.
- 11. We bless believers across Colorado with the ability to no longer pass judgement on others, letting Jesus be their judge and jury, as it is written in Rom 14:13 "Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister."
- 12. We bless Colorado believers with the good sense to live out Prov 19:11 which declares that "Good sense makes one slow to anger, and it is his glory to overlook an offense.
- 13. As it is written in Eph 4:3, we decree that Colorado Ecclesia is now eager and diligent to guard and keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace.
- 14. We bless the Body of Christ in Colorado to now shine brightly as beacons in the dark displaying the Word of Life to all (Phil 2: 15-16)
- 15. We decree as it is written in John 17 that the prayer of Jesus is now being answered across Colorado causing believers to now be One Colorado Ecclesia; One in spirit, One in mind and One in heart.
