TOPIC: Expectant Hope2

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN) which is a statewide prayer movement for community-wide spiritual transformation. KSN empowers believers statewide to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually, simultaneously (at 9am) speak God's Word over our state as written in Isa 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am (other dates as needed)

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning

yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen

for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Establish Your Mindset to have Faith with Expectant Hope

Although it appears obvious that Colorado is infiltrated by darkness and evil in our government, schools and marketplace, the Bible repeatedly reminds us that there is always hope for renewal and restoration. No situation is too hopeless for God to bring transformation. This means that we should wait with expectation and faith that hope will arise no matter the situation, so, we wait on the Lord with Expectant Hope.

As a Kingdom Steward, you are charged to release God's Word to instill Expectant Hope in people across Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

Blessing Declarations for AUGUST 23: EXPECTANT HOPE-2

In agreement with the Word of God and AS ONE in mind and spirit, we bless the people and land of Colorado, to stand firm with faith-filled EXPECTANT HOPE. We believe, in faith, that our Blessing Declarations are bringing effectual change to our state. We declare all glory to Jesus as we co-labor with Him through His Word, releasing the following Blessing Declarations.

- 1. We encourage the Colorado Ecclesia to praise the Lord as a powerful way to increase our faith until it becomes "expectant hope". Let Psalm 146:1-2 be on our lips: "Praise the Lord! Let all that I am praise the Lord. I will praise the Lord as long as I live. I will sing praises to my God with my dying breath".
- 2. We encourage the Colorado Ecclesia to readily share the hope they have in Jesus as instructed in 1 Timothy 6: 18-19 "Let them do good, that they be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life."
- 3. We bless pre-believers throughout Colorado with the words of Colossians 1:27, "To them God chose to make known how great among the Gentiles are the riches of the glory of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."
- 4. As written in Romans 8:24-25, we bless believers across Colorado with a revelation of the patience that comes with expectant hope. "For in this hope we were saved. Now hope that is seen is not hope. For who hopes for what he sees? But if we hope for what we do not see, we wait for it with patience".
- 5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the instruction found in Romans 12:12 "Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer".
- 6. We declare to the people of Colorado that the Word of God brings hope as written in Romans 15:4 which reads "For whatever was written in former days was written for our instruction, that through endurance and through the encouragement of the Scriptures we might have hope".
- 7. We declare the blessings of Jeremiah 29:11 over the people of Colorado: "For I know the plans I have for you, declares the Lord, plans for welfare and not for evil, to give you a future and a hope".
- 8. We bless Coloradans with the expectant hope that comes from God's love as written in Romans 5: 2-5 which tells us "Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God. Not only that, but we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us".
- 9. We bless every Colorado believer with the revelation written in 1John 3:3, "And everyone who thus hopes in Him purifies Himself as He is pure".
- 10. We encourage the Colorado Ecclesia to receive the hope-filled declaration written in Psalm 62:7, "In God is my salvation and my glory; The rock of my strength, and my refuge, is in God." You, Lord Jesus, are my all and all!
- 11. Hope is diminished by sin and iniquity. With this in mind, we encourage Colorado believers to turn from their evil ways as written in 2 Timothy 2:19 "Nevertheless the solid foundation of God stands, having this seal: "The Lord knows those who are His," and, "Let everyone who names the name of Christ depart from iniquity."
- 12. As written in Ezekiel 37:11b and on behalf of the people of Colorado, we acknowledge that 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off." However, with expectant hope, we now declare what is written in Ezekiel 37: 3, 9. We prophesy to the *ruach* breath of God "Thus says the Lord God: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live." We declare LIVE! to every dead bone of hopelessness, heart sickness and emotional trauma throughout Colorado.

- 13. In the midst of hard times (described in Hosea 2:15 as the Valley of Achor), we bless every person in Colorado to experience an open door of hope and expectation anticipating the time when God will restore His favor on them.
- 14. As it is written in Hebrews 6:19, we bless the people of Colorado with hope that is well-anchored behind the veil of the heavenly temple in the very Presence of Christ Himself.
- 15. As written in Hebrews 6:18b-19, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to run into the heart of God, hiding ourselves in His faithfulness, receiving His strength and comfort and empowered to seize the unshakable hope that has already been established ahead of time.
- 16. We pray for the Colorado Ecclesia as Paul did in Ephesians 1:18 (AMP), that the eyes of your heart [the very center and core of your being] may be enlightened [flooded with light by the Holy Spirit], so that you will know and cherish the hope [the divine guarantee, the confident expectation] to which He has called you, the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints.
- 17. We bless the people of Colorado with the hope that has been laid up for each one in heaven according to Colossians 1:5
- 18. We bless every person in, and from, Colorado with hope that fills them with all joy and peace in believing, that each person may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit as written in Romans 15:13.
- 19. We bless believers statewide with expectant hope which produces confidence (Psalm 71:5 AMPC), courage and strength of heart (Psalm 31:24 NKJV) so they may be brave and enduring (Psalm 27:14 AMPC).
- 20. We bless you with expectant hope for your children as it is written in Jermiah 31:7: "There is hope in your future, says the Lord, That your children shall come back to their own border".
- 21. As it is written in Romans 5:5, we bless each Colorado community with God's hope which never disappoints because God's love has been abundantly poured out within our hearts through the Holy Spirit who was given to us.
- 22. As written in Jeremiah 17:7 (AMP), we declare "Blessed [with spiritual security] is the man who believes and trusts In, and relies on the Lord, and whose hope and confident expectation is the Lord.
- 23. We bless believers statewide to engage their trust and hope in the Lord by becoming God's answer to the prayers of those around them as written in Philippians 2:4 (CSB): ""Everyone should look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others."
- 24. We bless the people of Colorado with brave confidence as they abide in Jesus with expectant hope and bear much fruit as written in Jeremiah 17:8 (AMP) "For he will be nourished like a tree planted by the waters, That spreads out its roots by the river; And will not fear the heat when it comes; But its leaves will be green and moist. And it will not be anxious and concerned in a year of drought nor stop bearing fruit."
- 25. We declare that expectant hope now results in ongoing diligence for the Colorado Ecclesia as written in Hebrews 6: 11-12, "We want each of you to show this same diligence to the very end, so that what you hope for may be fully realized. We do not want you to become lazy, but to imitate those, who through faith and patience, inherit what has been promised."
