Blessing Declarations

January 24, 2026

TOPIC: **Praise & Adoration**

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

PRAISE & ADORATION FOR GOD ALONE

Believers are encouraged to praise God alone because Scripture consistently reveals that He alone is worthy of worship, glory, and exaltation. The Bible teaches that God is the Creator of all things, and therefore no created being is to share in His glory. "I am the LORD; that is My name; and My glory I will not give to another" (Isaiah 42:8). From beginning to end, Scripture calls God's people to direct their praise exclusively to Him, recognizing His unmatched holiness, power, and sovereignty.

God alone is to be praised because He alone saves and redeems. The psalmist declares, "It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves" (Psalm 100:3), and Jonah proclaims, "Salvation belongs to the LORD" (Jonah 2:9). Unlike idols or human strength, God delivers, sustains, and forgives. "Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the LORD our God" (Psalm 20:7). Praise is therefore an act of faith, acknowledging that all help and hope come from Him alone.

Blessing Declarations for January 24: PRAISE & ADORATION FOR GOD ALONE

Believers are called to praise God alone because He alone is eternally worthy. "Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable" (Psalm 145:3). In heaven and on earth, worship belongs to Him alone: "To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and power forever and ever" (Revelation 5:13). Praise directed solely to God reflects His eternal nature and affirms that He alone reigns, now and forever. You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

1. Lord Jesus, we submit Colorado to You and give You all the praise as we declare in agreement with 1Chronicles 29:10-11, *"Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendor, for everything in heaven and earth is yours. Yours, Lord, is the kingdom; you are exalted as head over all."*
2. We declare over Colorado in agreement with the heavenly hosts described in Revelation 4:11: *"You are worthy, our Lord and God, to receive glory and honor and power, for you created all things, and by your will they were created and have their being."*
3. As the Colorado Ecclesia, we declare praise and honor to God our Creator and faithful Shepard who tends to our every need as declared in Romans 11:36, *"For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen."*
4. We call believers statewide to spring forth in song as Mary did in Luke 1:46-47 and 1:49-50 when she declared *"...My soul magnifies the Lord, and my spirit has rejoiced in God my Savior. (49-50) For He who is mighty has done great things for me, and holy is His name. And His mercy is on those who fear Him from generation to generation."*
5. We give God all the glory as we declare His greatness to the people of Colorado as written in Daniel 4:3, *"How great are God's signs, and how mighty are His wonders: His kingdom is an eternal kingdom; His dominion endures from generation to generation."*
6. We bless every Coloradan to see and praise God for the Truth of Daniel 4:17 *"In order that the living may know that the Most High rules in the kingdom of men, gives it to whomever He will, and sets over it the lowest of men."*
7. We call forth every Colorado believer to respond to God as Nebuchadnezzar did in Daniel 4:34-35, *"... I will bless the Most High and praise and honor Him who lives forever. His dominion, and His kingdom endures from generation to generation. ... (37) ... I praise, exalt, and honor the King of heaven, for all His works are true, and all His ways are just, and He is able to humble those who walk in pride."*
8. We bless every Coloradan to have a healthy fear of the Lord which compels them to worship the Lord as declared in Revelation 15: 3-4, *"Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Righteous and true are Your ways, King of the nations! Who will not fear You, O Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. All nations will come and worship before You, for Your righteous acts have been revealed."*
9. We join with believers statewide to lift up non-stop praise to Jesus Christ as written in Psalms 113: 3-4 *"From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised. The Lord is high above all nations, His glory above the heavens."*
10. We praise and glorify God and decree His Word in 1 Corinthians 8:6 which declares, *"yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live."*
11. We join with Almighty God to exalt King Jesus as the apostle Paul wrote in Philippians 2: 9-11 *"Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, that at the name of Jesus*

every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue acknowledge that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

12. As it is written in Revelation 4:11 (NKJV), we come to you Lord Jesus, in praise and adoration. We fall down before You as You sit on Your throne and we worship You who lives forever and ever. We cast any good thing we have before You and declare, *“You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power, for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created,”*
13. As it is written in Revelation 5: 12-14 (NKJV), we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to now join with the voices of heaven to declare, *“Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing!’ And every creature which is in heaven and on earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying; Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever!”*
14. As the Colorado Ecclesia, we call all people of, and from, Colorado to sing God’s praises and receive the Truth of His characteristics into their hearts as written in Psalm 145: 1-21 (NKJV) *“I will extol You, my God, O King; And I will bless Your name forever and ever. 2 Every day I will bless You, And I will praise Your name forever and ever. 3 Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised; And His greatness is unsearchable. 4 One generation shall praise Your works to another, And shall declare Your mighty acts. 5 I will meditate on the glorious splendor of Your majesty, And [d]on Your wondrous works. 6 Men shall speak of the might of Your awesome acts, And I will declare Your greatness. 7 They shall [e]tter the memory of Your great goodness, And shall sing of Your righteousness. 8 The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy. 9 The Lord is good to all, And His tender mercies are over all His works. 10 All Your works shall praise You, O Lord, And Your saints shall bless You. 11 They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, And talk of Your power, 12 To make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, And the glorious majesty of His kingdom. 13 Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, And Your dominion endures throughout all generations. 14 The Lord upholds all who fall, And raises up all who are bowed down. 15 The eyes of all look expectantly to You, And You give them their food in due season. 16 You open Your hand And satisfy the desire of every living thing. 17 The Lord is righteous in all His ways, Gracious in all His works. 18 The Lord is near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth. 19 He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them. 20 The Lord preserves all who love Him, But all the wicked He will destroy. 21 My mouth shall speak the praise of the Lord, And all flesh shall bless His holy name Forever and ever.”*
15. We bless every Colorado community with the Lord’s perceptible, manifest Presence every day as He bears our burdens according to Psalm 68:19 where David declares, *“Praise be to the LORD, to God our Savior, who daily bears our burdens.”*
