**Overview.** Thank you for participating in a Church Prayer Watch or a County Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays! The vision of Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every field of harvest in our society to better align with God's will. We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). When the Church Prayer Watch and County Prayer Watches are fully subscribed, Colorado will be covered 3 times in non-stop, day and night prayer!

**Source and Tone.** Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by our Field of Harvest Prayer Team Leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

**What to Pray.** The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during the monthly prayer time with their team. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

### PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

### 1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

**A prayer for you:** Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

### 2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. *You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.*

### 3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

### 4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God. –Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity. – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways. – Ps 91:11.

### 5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another. (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9)
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil. (Ps 91:11)
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

# PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

## Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of The Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

We ask, Lord, that every county have a fully subscribed 24hr Prayer Watch which will cover the state in non-stop, day and night prayer. 13. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor participating in the Church Prayer Watch (including myself).

## Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/prayermeetings>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

### Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. As it is written in Colossians 3:12, we exhort marketplace people across Colorado to: "Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience" in the marketplace.
2. As it is written in Philippians 2:3-4, we exhort every person working in the marketplace of Colorado to: " Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, <sup>4</sup> not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."
3. We decree to workers across Colorado as it is written in James 4:10: "Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up."
4. We pray that humility be released into workers statewide as is written in Luke 14:11: "For all those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted," in the marketplace.
5. We pray that Colorado workers and leaders choose to let go of pride as it is written in Proverbs 16:18: "Pride goes before destruction, a haughty spirit before a fall."

### Colorado Prays for ELECTIONS:

1. We pray that more people engage in prayer for the November elections. Let each believer pray with the authority they carry as they are seated in heavenly places in Christ Jesus. (Eph 2:6)
2. We declare a great movement of unity amongst conservatives statewide, unity with God and with one another to declare God's glory into the election process.
3. We pray that every person in Colorado now discerns the truth in the midst of campaign lies and innuendos.
4. We pray, Lord God, that the Ecclesia of Colorado now stand together with arms courageously linked to stand AS ONE in the battle over the election processes and integrity.
5. We plead the powerful Blood of Jesus over every candidate running for office, protecting them and causing only truth to be told about their positions and values.
6. We pray that the election process this November aligns with God's will and purpose for our state.
7. We declare that our God will fight for His people during the November elections by releasing His glory to destroy every plan of the evil one.

## Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. We pray that the shepherds of the Lord's flocks across Colorado now tend to their sheep well, loving them as they love themselves.
2. We pray that the flock of Colorado will no longer be scattered or divided but will be unified in their fold (Church) and across each city.
3. We pray that Colorado shepherds now become fearless leaders and bold protectors, keeping their sheep from succumbing to fear or going down the wrong paths.
4. We pray that the Lord will guard the heart, mind and body of every shepherd (pastor), keeping each one focused on their task and mission for the King.

## Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We pray that a panel of former abortion providers and physicians will come together in God's timing and with the right resources to collaborate on a project of the Colorado chapter of the American Assoc of Pro-Life OBGYNs and that it will effectively reach a local and national audience with the facts about abortion.
2. We fervently pray that registered voters now discern and acknowledge the truth regarding the evil intention and effect of the abortion ballot initiative (Amendment 79) which is purposed to change our state constitution to make abortion a constitutional right. Pray that woke people in Colorado (and across the nation) now awake as God moves in their hearts to soundly reject Amendment 79.
3. We pray for powerful, complete unity among all pro-life organizations in Colorado, that they all share the same media messaging to stop Amendment 79 and protect babies in the womb.
4. We pray for urgent financial support for "Righttoknowco.com" so that they can counter the false narratives publicized by media outlets about the abortion industry and the pro-life movement.
5. We pray that members of the Colorado Chapter of the American Association of Pro-life OB/GYNS now actively engage in writing, speaking, and educating the public about truth about abortion and the "Right to Abortion" Amendment 79.
6. We pray that our Sovereign Lord Jesus Christ stands in intercession for, and has mercy on, the people of Colorado who have allowed abortion to flourish in this state. We ask that they now come to the saving knowledge of Jesus which awakens them to the truth of the destructive evil of abortion which takes a human life.
7. We pray that God, who fights our battles, now dismantles and destroys the evil spiritual forces pushing abortion in Colorado and nationwide.

## Colorado Prays for the MEDIA:

1. Based on Proverbs 2:1-5, we pray that people across Colorado now accept God's Word, turn their ear to wisdom, and cry out for insight and understanding to find the knowledge of God regarding communications from every form of media.
2. We pray, Lord, that You now remove the veil of deception (2Cor 3:14) which opens the eyes and ears of Coloradans so they readily understand truth, righteousness and justice in every circumstance.
3. We pray that viewer discretion regarding media now be greatly increased so that more people across Colorado are able to readily distinguish truth from lies in every form of media.
4. We ask, Lord, that, as written in Prov 2: 8, You guard the course of the just in Colorado media and protect the ways of Your faithful ones who speak truth in media. Let them thrive professionally and financially. Let their voices be heard in Colorado and beyond.
5. We pray for salvations in every form of Colorado media transforming woke minds to awakened hearts that bring God the glory in all that they do.
6. We pray that more and more people in media across Colorado now walk in Godly integrity and righteousness.
7. We pray that moral ethics is now returned to journalism to present truth in every article and news item.

## Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. Lord, we thank You that You said in Matthew 19:14, "Let the little children come to Me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." We proclaim this as Your heart and with faith believe You have opened doors for the children of Colorado to come to You.
2. Lord, please put Your hand of protection and blessing over all those who are now back to school.
3. We ask, Lord, that there now be peace in our education systems statewide.
4. May there be an increase of God's Word boldly shared and spread across all aspects of the Colorado education system.
5. We ask, Lord God, for a release of the fear of the Lord, which is the beginning of wisdom, upon every person in the Colorado education system for the knowledge of the Holy One is insight. (Proverbs 9:10)
6. In the name of Jesus Christ and in the power of the Holy Spirit, we proclaim God's mercy for every Colorado educator and administrative staff. Let them now receive Your revival and spiritual awakening across all aspects of our education system.



## Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. We pray for the return of all remaining hostages and healing for those who have lost loved ones.
2. Father God, we ask for open doors for new relationships and enhanced communications between the Jewish community and Christian churches in every Colorado community. Let them be strengthened with cords of love, honor, respect and friendship.
3. We declare a Psalm 91 hedge of protection around Jewish communities, synagogues, and neighborhoods in Colorado against acts of violence or anti-Semitism.
4. As is it written in Jeremiah 33:19-26, God has covenant with the night and the day. Likewise, He has covenant with the Jewish people. We declare that this covenant now be manifest and understood in every church in Colorado.
5. We pray for supernatural Godly wisdom, counsel, strategies, plans and endurance for the government and military leaders in Israel. May they be in one accord as they fight this war, bring an end to evil terrorists and establish safety from all enemies on every front.
6. We pray that innocent civilians on both sides be protected from further bloodshed.
7. We pray that the U.S. would stand strong with Israel, not just for Israel's sake but also so that we would be found doing what is right and be worthy to be blessed as a nation according to Your promise in Genesis 12:3.
8. We pray for an outpouring of Holy Spirit across the whole Middle East, to bring those lost in darkness into the inheritance of the saints in God's Light, and into the Kingdom of Your beloved Son.(Col 1:12-13)

## Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. We pray for supernatural wisdom for Colorado parents and grandparents who are navigating family issues and finances at this time.
2. We pray for safety for children in Colorado schools and that parents would have boldness to make the safest and most peaceful choices in schools for their children.
3. We stand with the families in Aurora Colorado. We pray that anarchy will not be allowed to continue and there would be a peaceful outcome for all families involved.
4. We pray for strong leadership to stand up and protect the people of Colorado and that political influence would not stand in the way of good choices for families.
5. We thank You, Lord, for the many healings in relationships in Colorado families. Let there be a continuation of reconciliation for families in this state



## Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. We decree that the glory of the Lord now resides over Colorado for the days ahead.
2. We declare our state is now becoming known as the dwelling place of God.
3. We declare that every Colorado government leader in all areas of government (state, city and county) will soon know Jesus as Lord and Savior and bow to His name so that each govern with the righteous Word of the Lord.
4. We declare that the November elections will cause a shift in state government leaders towards righteousness in both the house and the senate.
5. We declare that those who are corrupt or willfully wicked in our state government are now being removed and replaced with those whom the Lord chooses.
6. We declare that ungodly, progressive legislation is now being cancelled and nullified.
7. We come into agreement with believers in our state who are praying every day for our God to rule and reign over Colorado government, that the Lord prevails in every government activity or legislation.
8. We declare life and liberty over Colorado.
9. We declare that the people of Colorado now choose to bow only to the Name of Jesus.

## Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. Thank you for all the Colorado men and women who have responded to the call to be First Responders as dispatchers, police officers, firefighters and EMTs as well as all those who work in hospital emergency rooms. Bless each one, Lord God, and their family members, with your comforting love, joy and peace.
2. As they start each shift, with prayer for guidance and protection, remind each believing First Responder to put on the full Armor of God even as they dress in their uniforms so that they may be protected from any assaults of the enemy.
3. We pray that every Colorado First Responder goes forth each day with the power of Holy Spirit surrounding and engulfing them.
4. We pray that each believing First Responder sees every person they serve as a child of God who is having issues in their life. Let God's compassion and firm love flow through the First Responders throughout our state.
5. We pray that every First Responder is alert and enabled to protect themselves and those they serve.
6. We pray that, at the end of each shift, First Responders are able to leave all the negative contacts, thoughts, feelings and concerns in God's capable hands so as to not internalize them or take them home to their families.
7. Let each Colorado First Responder go off duty rejoicing in the power of Holy Spirit working in their lives while praising God for all He did for, and through, them during their shift.

## Colorado Prays for the ARTS:

1. We ask, Lord, for an influx of spirit-filled arts organizations across Colorado which provide Godly influence through art in the people and culture of our state.
2. Lord, we confess that many Colorado artists have not placed You in the center of their creativity which comes from You, our Creator. We repent of our transgression, and we thank You, Jesus, for Your forgiveness.
3. Lord, we ask for Godly believers to now be placed into leadership positions in arts organizations across Colorado. These arts organizations include art leagues, galleries, and student art clubs.
4. We declare that the protective, creative blood of Jesus now covers every form of art across our state.
5. Lord, we pray that Colorado artists now declare the glory of God over the people and land statewide.

## Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. Lord God, we ask that every person in the Colorado energy industry now be filled with Godly wisdom with deep discernment regarding their job. Let every eye be open and every ear hear the guidance of Holy Spirit.
2. We especially pray that every leader in the energy sector will wisely steward the blessed treasures contained in the land of Colorado as a beacon to the nation of God's goodness.
3. We declare that no attempt of the enemy to disrupt or destroy any aspect of Colorado's energy production will prosper in any way, shape or form.
4. We declare our God's divine peace and protection over Colorado oil fields, power grids, natural gas pipes, wind farms and solar power supplies.
5. We praise You, Lord God, and give You all the glory for amazing new innovations that now come forth throughout Colorado's energy sector.
6. We ask, Lord, that You manifest Your glory in every Colorado energy operation, causing lives to be blessed, souls to be saved and Your Name to be exalted.
