TOPIC: OCCUPY-1

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN) which is a statewide prayer movement for community-wide spiritual transformation. KSN empowers believers statewide to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to simultaneously speak God's Word over our state as written in Isa 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am (other dates as needed)

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning

yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen

for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Establish Your Mindset to OCCUPY

This Blessing Saturday, we are focused on the command Jesus gave in the parable of the Talents in Luke 19: 12-27 when those with the Talents were told to "Occupy until I come." Those who serve God have each been given gifts, talents and provisions. Those gifts empower us to "Occupy" as we go about our Father's business in whatever way the Lord directs us.

As a Kingdom Steward, one way to occupy is to declare God's Word into the atmosphere of your territory.

This month, we will bless the people of Colorado with all that is needed to serve the advancement of God's Kingdom in our state and beyond. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

Blessing Declarations for JULY 12: OCCUPY-1

In agreement with the Word of God and AS ONE in mind and spirit, we bless the people and land of Colorado, including the Ecclesia to faithfully steward and occupy, as released in the following Blessing Declarations.

- 1. We declare, as in Daniel 7:22, that it is time for the saints to possess and occupy the kingdom (Colorado), for God's glory. We bless them to occupy this land until Jesus comes (Luke 19:13).
- 2. As written in Genesis 12:1-3, we thank You Lord God for giving us the land known as Colorado. We thank You for the covenant made with Abram and we bless Israel and Your Colorado Ecclesia with all the promises of that covenant. You promised to bless Abram and make him a great nation, and to bless all the families of the earth through him. Lord, we declare this to be true for Colorado and we now align with those blessings.
- 3. We pray that every Colorado believer now chooses to occupy, bless and intercede for their city and the people around them as written in Jeremiah 29:7, "Seek the welfare of the city where I have sent you into exile, and pray to the Lord on its behalf; for in its welfare, you will have welfare. "
- 4. As written in Genesis 2:15, we repent Lord God for shirking our duty and responsibility to tend and keep Your garden, called Colorado. Out of love for God and appreciation for this land, we now bless the people of Colorado with open hearts, eyes and minds to recognize and act on the privilege of occupying and stewarding the land. We release heartfelt stewarding love across this state which includes simple actions such as picking up trash along the road.
- 5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to occupy their local territory through demonstrations of God's love as written in Mark 12: 29-31, "29 Jesus answered, "The first and most important one is: 'Hear, O Israel (O Colorado), the Lord our God is one Lord; 30 and you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul (life), and with all your mind (thought, understanding), and with all your strength.' 31 This is the second: 'You shall [unselfishly] [h] love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these."
- 6. We decree the Word of the Lord and its blessings of Deuteronomy 28: 3-14 over the believers across Colorado who choose to occupy the land by honoring God in all that they do. "You will be blessed in the city, and you will be blessed in the field. ⁴ "The offspring of your body and the produce of your ground and the offspring of your animals, the offspring of your herd and the young of your flock will be blessed. ⁵ "Your basket and your kneading bowl will be blessed. ⁶ "You will be blessed when you come in and you will be blessed when you go out. ⁷ "The Lord will cause the enemies who rise up against you to be defeated before you; they will come out against you one way, but flee before you seven ways. ⁸ The Lord will command the blessing upon you in your storehouses and in ^[c] all that you undertake, and He will bless you in the land which the Lord your God gives you. ⁹ The Lord will establish you as a people holy [and set apart] to Himself, just as He has sworn to you, if you keep the commandments of the Lord your God and walk

[that is, live your life each and every day] in His ways. ¹⁰ So all the peoples of the earth will see that you are called by the name of the Lord, and they will be afraid of you. ¹¹ The Lord will give you great prosperity, in the offspring of your body and in the offspring of your livestock and the produce of your ground, in the land which the Lord swore to your fathers to give you. ¹² The Lord will open for you His good treasure house, the heavens, to give rain to your land in its season and to bless all the work of your hand; and you will lend to many nations, but you will not borrow. ¹³ The Lord will make you the head (leader) and not the tail (follower); and you will be above only, and you will not be beneath, if you listen and pay attention to the commandments of the Lord your God, which I am commanding you today, to observe them carefully. ¹⁴ Do not turn aside from any of the words which I am commanding you today, to the right or to the left, to follow and serve other gods.

- 7. We bless each Colorado believer to be a reflection of the light of God's Kingdom spoken of in Isaiah 60:1-3 where it reads "Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the Lord is risen upon you. For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; But the Lord will arise over you, and His glory will be seen upon you. The Gentiles shall come to your light, And kings to the brightness of your rising." See also Matthew 5:16.
- 8. Lord Jesus, we pray for every Coloradan to have greater trust and dependance on You alone as written in Jeremiah 17:7-8; "But blessed is the one who trusts in the Lord, whose confidence is in him. They will be like a tree planted by the water that sends out its roots by the stream. It does not fear when heat comes; its leaves are always green. It has no worries in a year of drought and never fails to bear fruit".
- 9. We bless and celebrate the victory for Colorado believers as written in John 8:36; "If the Son sets you free, you are truly free.
- 10. We celebrate the freedom with have in Christ Jesus and declare that believers statewide can now be free of condemnation and bondage because the "law of the Spirit of life" has freed them from the "law of sin and death" as written in Romans 8:1-2 and 2 Corinthians 3:17.
- 11. We declare that Colorado believers now stand firm for their territory by seeking God for His Truth in every situation as written in James 1:5; "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him."
- 12. We decree the Word of the Lord and its blessings over the Colorado Ecclesia as written in 1Corinthians 15:57-58 "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord."
