TOPIC: Expectant Hope1

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN) which is a statewide prayer movement for community-wide spiritual transformation. KSN empowers believers statewide to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to simultaneously speak God's Word over our state as written in Isa 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am (other dates as needed)

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning

yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen

for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Establish Your Mindset to have Faith with Expectant Hope

Although it appears obvious that Colorado is infiltrated by darkness and evil in our government, schools and marketplace, the bible repeatedly reminds us that there is always hope for renewal and restoration. No situation is too hopeless for God to bring transformation. This means that we should wait with expectation and faith allowing hope to arise no matter the situation, so, we wait on the Lord with Expectant Hope.

As a Kingdom Steward, you are charged to release God's word to instill Expectant Hope in people across Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord with expectant hope. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

Blessing Declarations for AUGUST 9: EXPECTANT HOPE-1

In agreement with the Word of God and AS ONE in mind and spirit, we bless the people and land of Colorado, to stand firm with faith-filled EXPECTANT HOPE. We believe, in faith, that our Blessing Declarations are bringing effectual change to our state. We declare all glory to Jesus as we co-labor with Him through His Word, releasing the following Blessing Declarations.

- 1. We bless every believer in Colorado with the hope-filled words of Isaiah 28:16 (NLT), Therefore, this is what the Sovereign Lord says: "Look! I am placing a foundation stone in Jerusalem (Colorado), a firm and tested stone. It is a precious cornerstone that is safe to build on. Whoever believes, need never be shaken".
- 2. We decree that Jesus is now established as the Chief Cornerstone of Colorado as written in Psalm 118: 22-24 The stone the builders rejected has become the Cornerstone; the Lord has done this, and it is marvelous in our eyes. The Lord has done it this very day; let us rejoice today and be glad" with Expectant Hope for the future of our state.
- 3. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with revelation and wisdom to carefully build on the foundation that Jesus has laid as it is written in 1 Corinthians 3: 10-11, "According to the grace of God given to me, like a skilled master builder I laid a foundation, and someone else is building upon it. Let each one take care how he builds upon it. For no one can lay a foundation other than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ."
- 4. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to be the united, dwelling place of God in the Spirit, as it is written in Ephesians 2: 20-22, "having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ Himself being the chief cornerstone. in whom the whole building, being fitted together, grows into a holy temple in the Lord, in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit".
- 5. Known as The Treasure State, we declare that the people of Colorado are blessed by Isaiah 33: 5-6 which reads "Though the Lord is very great and lives in heaven, he will make Jerusalem (Colorado) his home of justice and righteousness. In that day he will be your sure foundation, providing a rich store of salvation, wisdom, and knowledge. The fear of the Lord will be your treasure".
- 6. We bless every Coloradan with a healthy dose of The Fear of the Lord as written in Provers 14:27 which tells us that "The fear of the Lord is a fountain of life, that one may turn away from the snares of death". Let this fountain of life give every Coloradan greater hope for their future.
- 7. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the strong foundational knowledge and understanding of God's Word in all its depth and wisdom. To that end, we declare Matthew 7: 24-25, "Everyone then who hears these words of mine and does them will be like a wise man who built his house on the rock. And the rain fell, and the floods came, and the winds blew and beat on that house, but it did not fall, because it had been founded on the rock".
- 8. As Solomon made sure that all the work related to building the Temple of Lord was carried out as written in 2 Chronicles 8, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to now trust in the Lord with expectant hope that He will rebuild every Colorado town and city on His Sure Foundation.
- 9. As written in Matthew 16:18, we decree that God is building His Church in Colorado and the gates of Hades will not overcome it.
- 10. We decree peace to every Coloradan as it is written in Jeremiah 29:11-13 "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, says the Lord, thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you a future and a hope. Then you will call upon Me and go and pray to Me, and I will listen to you. And you will seek Me and find Me, when you search for Me with all your heart".

- 11. We bless every Coloradan with the truth of Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go."
- 12. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to righteously stand firm with Expectant Hope as written Proverbs 10:25 which reads "When the storm has swept by, the wicked are gone, but the righteous stand firm forever."
- 13. As written in Isaiah 61:3, we bless the people of Colorado with beauty for ashes which instills faith to believe that "Up from the ashes, hope will arise".
- 14. We release the Holy Spirit Winds of Hope to every Coloradan as written in Job 26:13 which tells us that "By His breath the heavens are cleared."
- 15. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to be God's living stones who are confident and bold to declare the Name of Jesus above all names. that even if we are rejected by men, we know that in God's sight we are precious because it is written in 1 Peter 2: 4-6, "As you come to him, the living Stone—rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to Him you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. For in Scripture it says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a chosen and precious cornerstone, and the one who trusts in him will never be put to shame".
- 16. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with quick obedience to the promptings of Holy Spirit as it is written in Zechariah 8:9 (ESV) "Thus says the Lord of hosts: "Let your hands be strong, you who in these days have been hearing these words from the mouth of the prophets who were present on the day that the foundation of the house of the Lord of hosts was laid, that the temple might be built."
- 17. We bless the people of Colorado to abide in Jesus with expectant hope as written in Psalm 18:2 "The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer, my God, my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold." Let this Word confirm our hope as we read in Romans 8:31 "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?"
- 18. We decree to the people of Colorado as it is written in Romans 15:13, "Now may the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit.
- 19. As written in the song "Raise a Hallelujah", we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to "sing our Hallelujah louder than the unbelief and watch the darkness flee."
- 20. We pray with Expectant Hope for God's provision for Colorado as it is written in Malachi 3:10 "Bring all the tithes into the storehouse so there will be enough food in my Temple. If you do," says the Lord of Heaven's Armies, "I will open the windows of heaven for you. I will pour out a blessing so great you won't have enough room to take it in! Try it! Put me to the test!
- 21. With expectant hope, we welcome and bless structural changes to the mission of every Colorado church to more closely align with God's blueprint to flow in the Ephesians 4: 11-16 fivefold ministries, unified, steadfast, Spirit-filled, praying, worshipping, discipling, caring for one another and evangelizing in every Colorado community.
- 22. As it is written in Psalm 62: 5-8, we declare that our hope individually, and for Colorado, rests in God alone.
- 23. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with expectant hope, to see the regular manifestations of healing, deliverance and a massive statewide harvest of lost souls.
- 24. We declare that, with a deep infilling of expectant hope, our mourning is now turning into dancing as written in Psalm 30:11.
