Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24-hour Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. *He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.*

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways." (NKJ) Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6)

Colorado Prays Ministry PRAYER POINTS:

1. We praise You Lord that Colorado is now covered in day and night prayer at the state level with nearly 60 participating churches and groups – let the Wall of Prayer now expand so that every county is covered in a Neh. 4:20 wall of non-stop prayer.
2. We pray for new strategies and resources to communicate the vision of Colorado Prays to pastors statewide.
3. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch.
4. We ask for a new Prayer Trust Leader for the First Responder sphere of influence in Colorado.
5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest and for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need a pastor to engage other pastors, an administrator, a WIX web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
8. We praise God that we now have 9 counties covered by Cover the County which hosts a regularly-scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado county while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer. We pray that more leaders come forth in each of the 64 counties statewide.

Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado—that God's love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God's love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of "taking offense" to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

Seven Mountain Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINT

1. Lord God, we thank you that your plans and purposes for Colorado are still in place, and you are moving the people of Colorado to return to righteousness, even though we cannot see it.
2. We decree continued exposure and rectification of every plan of evil that is being perpetrated against the citizens of Colorado.
3. We rejoice as we stand in you, Lord God, declaring that Your people will not comply with the lies of the enemy because we are victorious overcomers.
4. Lord God, we thank you that your promises to believers are yes and amen AND THAT Your perfect love casts out all fear throughout Colorado! We refuse to 'come under' the lies of the enemy disseminated through the media, and through officials who are working with or through a demonic agenda.
5. We declare that no evil mandate of any kind is allowed to be placed on the people of God across Colorado as we stand in You in the power of Your might, Your anointing, and Your promises.
6. We declare that the Psalm 91 angels have charge over Tina Peters, every Mesa County Clerk employee and all county clerks statewide as the truth prevails for such a time as this.

FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that people across Colorado now throw off the bondage of fear and anxiety that has caused stress and sickness as they live out Phil 4:6: “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.”
2. We pray for total unity for every Colorado husband and wife (Eph 2:14); that they will stay firm in the Spirit (Zech 4:6) with great discernment in the midst of the turmoil and chaos.
3. We declare that every believing husband and wife now rise up to pray together for their family, that every child now reflects godly character, moral courage, personal integrity and mature behavior. (Eph 4:1)
4. We pray for deep revelation for every Colorado family to know their identity in Christ.
5. We declare that, despite laws on the books, the definition of marriage in Colorado remains strong between one man and one woman.

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that people in the Media Mountain across Colorado now carry the fire of God's glory with such intensity that they release manifestations of God's Presence statewide.
2. We declare that the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand over the Media Mountain in Colorado so that our God's Will shall now be done on earth as it is in heaven. For the LORD has established His Throne in heaven and His Kingdom rules over all. (Matthew 3:2, Psalm 103:19)
3. We declare that our Father-God, the Creator-God is the Lord of the earth and all its fullness, the world and those that dwell in it. Your Kingdom Come, Your Will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Ps. 24:1, Matthew 6:9,10)
4. We declare that the blood of the Lamb of God, the perfect sacrifice, speaks through every form of media in and coming from Colorado.
5. We declare now to every person in the Media Mountain: "Wake up, you sleepyhead! GOD has armed you and made you battle-ready. Join now with the King of Glory, God of the angel armies as He is ready to enter." (Ps. 24:7-10)
6. We declare: "Now salvation and power are set in place (among the media across Colorado), and the kingdom reign of our God and the ruling authority of his Anointed One are established." (Rev 12:10)

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray for new godly men and women to take up Colorado school district board seats in this next election according to the Lord's will.
2. We pray for godly men and women to take up Colorado school staff and teaching positions according to the Lord's will.
3. We pray that more Colorado families now raise up their children the way they ought to go. *"Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old, they will not turn from it."* Proverbs 22:6.
4. We pray for revival and spiritual awakening in every Colorado school.
5. We pray that *God would open children's and teacher's eyes and turn them from darkness to light, from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in Jesus."* Acts 26:18.
6. We pray that God would now open doors for His appointed ministries to impact Colorado children and schools for the sake of the gospel.
7. We pray for Colorado Christian teachers. *"Therefore, (teachers in Colorado schools) must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body."* Ephesians 4:25.
8. We pray that the next election cycle in Colorado will be fair and the results be truthful.
9. We pray that God would assure safety for Colorado children, families, and school staff from all threats caused by Covid-19.
10. We declare Psalm 91 over every Christian student, teacher and staff member in Colorado.

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that the worshipers in your Kingdom are now arising across Colorado in Spirit and Truth. Let worship within each church increasingly be marked by Your Spirit. Sound forth a clarion call into the atmosphere to shake heaven and earth!
2. In the hour that "the Spirit and the Bride say Come!" we declare that your Bride is becoming One with the Spirit to release a call in the earth to those with ears to hear. And they WILL come to Jesus and be ushered into the Kingdom in these days. John 4:24, Rev 22:17
3. We lift high the canopy of your Presence across Colorado, Lord God, and declare that no weapon formed against Your people will prosper!
4. We give thanks to you that the table you set before us, even in the presence of our enemies, is abundant and steadfast in provision and peace for all who are hungry and thirsty. We will come and feast with you and trust you during this hour. Isaiah 54:17, Psalm 23
5. We declare that "The Spirit of the Lord God is upon (every person in the arts/entertainment mountain) because He has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor. He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set the oppressed free."
6. We call forth the Worship Warriors who now take their place in your Kingdom to deliver your purposes on earth through songs and prayers. With every song sung, every note played, every prayer prayed, every heart unified in your presence, you are arising powerfully in our midst to accomplish Your Word in this earth. - Isaiah 61:1, Luke 4:18
7. May songs of deliverance be birthed within your walls, O Jerusalem. You are our hiding place, and we find refuge in You from the troubles of today. We declare these songs of deliverance become the anthem of your worshiping church. You are teaching us to keep our eyes upon you, and our hearts steadfast in this hour. Psalm 32:7
8. We declare: Behold, The King is Coming!! Let worship make way for the King's entrance!! In triumph, we shout from the rooftops that Our God is near! Look up, look up, O people! See the Lord of Hosts make his appearance. He is coming swiftly. Zech 9, Matthew 24:15

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray, Lord God, that we, Your Intercessors, would prepare the way for people to walk on the pathway of prayer into Your presence. (Isa 57:14, 62:10; Ps 16:11)
2. Oh Lord, we pray that Your Church would walk in Your authority and anointing to loose the bonds of wickedness, to release the tormented, to set the oppressed free, and to break every yoke in Your Name, Jesus. (Isa 58:6)
3. We agree with Your Word, oh Lord, that we would call for justice, plead for truth, take a stand for righteousness, call for equity to enter, and lift up a standard against the enemy. (Isa 59:4-19)
4. May we, the Ekklesia, take a stand as watchmen on our walls crying out day and night, being silent no more, interceding, giving Him no rest until He establishes our land as a praise in the earth. (Isa 62:6-7)
5. Oh, King Jesus, heaven is Your throne and the earth is Your footstool, therefore, may we humble ourselves and tremble at Your Presence and Your Word. (Isa 64:2; 66:2)

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. We pray for a statewide flood of appreciation, honor, respect and gratitude for all first responders.
2. We pray Psalm 91 over every Colorado first responder, calling each of them into deep habitation in the secret place with the one True God and Savior, Jesus Christ. Let each one be quieted in the safety of the arms of Jesus.
3. We declare Eph 1:17-19 over each Colorado first responder, that they now abide in deep revelation, discernment and wisdom minute by minute functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings at all times.
4. We ask, Lord, that You open spiritual eyes and ears so that every first responder hears, sees and instinctively knows what to do in every situation they encounter.
5. We declare Gal 6:9 over Colorado first responders, that they not give up or grow weary. Bring a refreshing to them, Lord God.
6. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every workday with impunity.
7. May every first responder cast their cares on You, Lord God. Let them release every form of pain and trauma to the foot of the cross.
8. We declare physical, mental, emotional and spiritual healing for every first responder in Colorado.
9. We ask for healing for first responders who have taken the vaccine and protection for every first responder against any variation of COVID.
10. We declare Is 41:10 over Colorado first responders: "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. In the midst of vaccine mandates, we declare to every Colorado marketplace leader and worker: "Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the Lord your God will be with you wherever you go." Joshua 1:9
2. We declare that marketplace people do not live by a spirit of fear or timidity but of power, love and self-discipline. 2Tim 1:7
3. We encourage every person in the Colorado marketplace: "Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong. 1 Cor.16:13
4. We declare to people in every Colorado business 2 Chron 15:7: "But you, take courage! Do not let your hands be weak, for your work shall be rewarded."
5. We declare strength and endurance for Colorado people in every aspect of business statewide based on Isa 41:10 where our God says He will uphold you with His righteous right hand.
6. We speak to Colorado business people and declare: "Submit to God and be at peace with Him; in this way prosperity will come to you. Accept instruction from His mouth and lay up His words in your heart." Job 22:21-2
