We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). When the Church Prayer Watch and County Prayer Watches are fully subscribed, Colorado will be covered 3 times in non-stop, day and night prayer!

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by 9 prayer leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during their monthly prayer time. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

A prayer for you: Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. *You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.*

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps. 122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of The Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

1. We thank You, Lord, for mobilizing 62+ Church Prayer Watches which now cover every day of the year in non-stop, day and night prayer at the state level! Let every church faithfully complete their monthly Church Prayer Watch.

7. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Team leaders who are laser-focused on each of the fields of harvest covered in this Prayer Digest and for their physical and spiritual protection. We pray blessings on our Leaders including John, Marcia, Angela, MaryAnn, Phil, Kaity, Nic, Gaylyn, Laura, Catherine and Lacricia.

13. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor participating in the Church Prayer Watch (including myself).

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/prayermeetings>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

Colorado Prays for MEDIA:

1. We ask you, Lord God, to abundantly pour out Your Presence on every person in media across Colorado to remove any veils of deception from their eyes and allow them to have radical encounters with You that bring freedom to everyone in media statewide. (2 Cor 3:16-18).
2. We ask You, Jesus Christ, to reveal the depth, width, length and height of Your love to every believer in media. (Eph 3: 17-20)
3. Let every believer in Colorado media experience Your love and have no fear as they share Your love with others. (1 John 4:16-19)
4. Father God, we ask that You give Your believers in Colorado media Your boldness which causes them to walk righteously before You, bold as lions broadcasting Your love and truth. (Proverbs 28:1)
5. Father God, thank You for Your Jesus followers in media throughout Colorado. Continue the work of sanctification in their lives. Draw them to walk closer and closer with You each day to become fruitful in every area of their lives including their creative gifting. (2 Peter 1:4-8)
6. Father God, protect Your followers that are in media from the evil one. As their Shepherd, keep them safe as they wage war against the evil one in the secular areas of media. (John 10:9-11)

Colorado Prays for CHURCH:

1. We pray that a spirit of grace is now released upon every Colorado church, so that we (the Church) can endure in our calling as good soldiers of Jesus Christ. 2Tim 2: 3-5
2. We pray that a spirit of prayer now falls upon every Colorado church so that we (the Church) now remember where our help comes from and who is the only One who can usher in revival. Psa 121: 1-2
3. We pray that the eyes of believers in every Colorado church now be fixed on Jesus so that we don't lose our focus and first love. 1John 4:19
4. We pray for a spirit of repentance to fall upon every church in Colorado so that God's presence can manifest in this state again and heal our land. 2Chr 7:14

Colorado Prays for The MARKETPLACE:

1. We decree as it is written in 1Cor 15:51, "But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ" in the marketplace.
2. We decree as it is written in Phil 4:13, "I can do all things through him who strengthens me" in the marketplace.
3. We decree as it is written in John 16:33, "I have said these things to you, that in me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation. But take heart; I have overcome the world."
4. We decree as it is written in 1Cor 10:13, "No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it."

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We repent, Lord God, on behalf of believers across Colorado for being silent, passive, comfortable with their blessings from God as the dark evil of abortion has taken root in our state. Forgive and move us to no longer be silent. Let the church arise and our enemy behind acts of abortion be scattered. (Amos 5:18-6:3)
2. We pray, Lord God, that the people of Colorado now recognize that abortion is not a political issue; it is a moral, sin issue.
3. We ask, Lord, that believers across Colorado now unite in repentance for the sin of abortion with weeping, fasting and mourning. (Joel 2:12-13)
4. We pray that pastors now equip their congregations to engage in loving conversations about the beauty, dignity and divinity of life in the womb and how to stand courageously for life. (Gen 1: 26-28)
5. We pray, Lord, that churches in every Colorado community now actively engage with love and compassion by starting or supporting at least one Pregnancy Resource Center which will support women during their unplanned pregnancies.
6. We pray that Christian women (and men) seeking help after an abortion are met by the body of Christ with nonjudgemental, compassionate care and ministry that helps them find forgiveness and redemption through Christ. (John 3:16-17)
7. We pray, Lord, that Christians across Colorado now extend themselves to do more than donate money for women and men facing challenging pregnancies and for single parent families. Let there be a movement of active engagement with pregnancy centers and church ministries that find creative ways to be the love, hands and feet of Jesus to these people in need. (Prov 31)
8. We ask for forgiveness, Lord God, for not effectively teaching our children that sex before marriage is not healthy and usually leads to emotional stress and broken relationships. Pour out Your Spirit, Lord God, to encourage Your Bride to effectively teach and reinforce that the gift of sex within marriage is beautiful, righteous, good and protective. (Gen 2:18-25, Ezek 3:16-21)

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. Thank You, Lord, that all First Responders are really “Second Responders” for all of us. Let every Coloradan learn to turn to You in times of need before calling on a human resource.
2. Let every Colorado First Responders recognize that their identity does not come from their badge but from their identity as a Child of God.
3. Help each believing First Responder in Colorado remember that they serve You first and then those whom they serve in their job description.
4. Guide each believing First Responder to follow Jesus’s example of servant leadership by serving out of love for You and for their fellow man instead of from a desire for power or control over others.
5. At the beginning of each shift, help all First Responders seek You first and Your righteousness so that everything else they need will be given to them by You.
6. Remind them to pray for themselves and their co-workers to be protected and blessed by Your Holy Spirit.
7. Teach believing First Responders to prayerfully appropriate the power of Your Holy Spirit for the wisdom, guidance and strength they need every minute of every day.
8. Help First Responders to lovingly pray for every contact they make during their shift.
9. Lord God, prompt each First Responder to complete their shift by thanking You for Your divine guidance and protection.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. Lord God, Israel is the apple of Your eye and we ask You to have mercy to deliver them from their enemies on every side. We declare victory and salvation for Israel and the Jewish people.
2. We pray, Lord, that You would give all Israelis and Jews around the world a renewed understanding of the need to rely on You. Awaken in them a hunger to know You personally face to face, even as Moses spoke to You face to face.
3. We pray for our government, at all levels, to continue to resist bills which demonize and marginalize the Jewish people. Let the United States stand strong in our support of Israel.
4. We declare a new level of safety for every IDF soldier, that You would watch over and keep them safe in every operation they carry out.
5. We pray for breakthrough to find, rescue and bring home every remaining hostage.
6. We continue to pray for Psalm 23:3 healing and wholeness, body, soul and spirit, for all those who are hurting from trauma, fear and loss of loved ones.
7. We pray for supernatural Godly wisdom, unity, counsel, strategies, plans and endurance for the Israeli government and military leaders.
8. We pray that You would open the eyes of the Palestinian people to see that hatred of Israel is against You. (Gen 12:3) Give them a hunger to live in peace and to raise their children with a better hope.
9. Father God, we ask for open doors for new relationships and enhanced communications between the Jewish communities and Christian churches in every Colorado community. Let them be strengthened and bound together with cords of love, honor, respect and friendship.
10. We pray for the Messianic believers in Israel as they serve with their fellow Jews in the IDF and go through the same trials and tribulations, that they would come to be seen as one with their brothers and sisters, and that the hope which lies within them would shine forth as a beacon of truth and light and love.

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. We decree as it is written in Matthew 19:14, "Let the little children come to Me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." We proclaim this as Your heart and with faith believing that You have opened doors for the children of Colorado to come to You.
2. We declare the fear of the Lord is the beginning of wisdom, and that the youth of Colorado would now have the knowledge of the Holy One which is understanding. For by You, Lord, their days will be multiplied, and years of life will be added to them. If the youth of Colorado are wise, they are wise for themselves, and if they scoff, they alone will bear it. Proverbs 9:10-12
3. We ask for an increase of your Holy Spirit to move among our youth in Colorado.
4. We ask for our youth to have an increase of opportunities to hear and receive salvation through the gospel of Jesus Christ.
5. Lord Jesus, You are the vine, and the believing youth of Colorado are the branches. Let there be an increase in those who believe in you and let them bear much fruit, for apart from You, they can do nothing. John 15:5
6. We pray for an increase of educational opportunities that are centered in You, Lord God.
7. We ask for Your blessing, Lord God, as You send laborers for the harvest of youth and their parents because it is written in Luke 10:2, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore beseech the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into the His harvest."
8. We declare Your will be done in our educational system in Colorado as it is in Heaven.

Colorado Prays for FAMILY:

1. We pray for the release of an outpouring of Holy Spirit on the sons and daughters across Colorado.
2. We pray for an anointing of dreams and visions for destiny and identity to be loosed on every man, woman and child in Colorado.
3. We pray that Colorado churches would now submit to the new ways the Lord is working and ready themselves to receive the soon coming harvest of souls.
4. We pray for the church family, that we may love and forgive each other; that we may come together as a healthy, happy spiritual family that desperately needs each other.
5. We pray that believers would come into such beautiful covenant with one another and with Christ that we would be a great example for non-believing families of Colorado, that the way we treat each other would become a beautiful picture of what family is supposed to be.
6. We pray for our leadership, that they would repent for their partnership with evil agendas against the family and that those who are unrepentant would be exposed and replaced with people of God.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. We declare that every level of government in the state of Colorado now returns to the Lord Jehovah and to the Truth proclaimed in HIS word.
2. We declare that all in Colorado shall be saved in the Name of Jesus.
3. We declare that we, the people of Colorado, represent our elected government and stand with Israel in covenant with the Lord Jesus.
4. We stand in the Truth of God's Word and thank You, Lord, for now exposing all of the corrupt rules and regulations that has been put into law in the last legislative session. We decree that any and all evil laws will be made null and void.
5. We decree that Colorado will be governed by righteous leaders and that the unrighteous will be redeemed or removed.
6. We thank You, Lord, for the promises You have given us and the hope we have in You in our lives, both personal and corporate.
7. We declare that Colorado will be a landing pad for a mighty move of the Holy Spirit which attracts those hungering for more of God.

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. Lord Jesus, we declare in Your holy Name that the principalities and powers that come against the Colorado energy industry are now thoroughly defeated.
2. Lord God, we pray that there would now be a wave of righteous believers who flood the energy industry with prayers proclaiming that every piece of land used by the energy sector is holy ground belonging to You.
3. We give You the authority, Lord God, to penetrate every corner of the Colorado energy industry to touch the hearts of every worker and every decision maker concerning the energy industry.
4. We thank You in advance, Lord God, for removing those who stand in the way of Your plans, and for replacing them with those who will partner with you.
5. In the name of Jesus, we ask, Lord, that You go before each of us and make the path clear to allow the Colorado energy industry to prosper.
6. We ask, Lord, that every heart and soul working in the Colorado energy industry now accepts Jesus as their Lord and Savior.

Colorado Prays for ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT:

1. We declare, in the powerful Name of Jesus Christ, that all idols that are falsely worshiped in Colorado through arts and entertainment of all kinds are now being exposed and destroyed because Jesus is the only One to be worshipped and glorified in our State.
2. We declare that our God is now taking all hearts of stone in the arts and entertainment industry here in Colorado and turning them to flesh.
3. We declare that believers in every form of Colorado arts and entertainment are humble and pliable in His hands, fashioned for His good works.
4. We declare that every church in Colorado is full of praise and adoration for Jesus through various forms of art and entertainment.
5. We declare that every Colorado family is now gathering around the centerpiece of Christ in their homes and worship flows freely, bringing life and restoration to all.
6. We ask, Lord God, that Colorado arts and entertainment now declares God is good!
7. We proclaim the high praise of God is on the lips of every Colorado believer, forging a weapon of mass destruction against the powers of darkness.
8. We declare by faith that thankfulness and gratefulness are now themes in all forms of art and entertainment across Colorado which softens hearts of believers and non-believers.
9. We lift up the banner of Jesus over Colorado to protect, guide, and flourish our homes, businesses and churches for His glory!
