TOPIC: Mercy

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the <u>Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN)</u> which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in

Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put

regarding anything He might want you to add.

Mercy for the Next Great Awakening

Were you aware that the Second Great Awakening began in 1800 at a corporate communion table in the Red River Meeting House near Adair, Kentucky? Could a similar gathering kick off another Great Awakening for our nation?

On this Blessing Saturday, thousands are gathering in tents (one for every U.S. State) on the National Mall in Washington DC to worship God and intercede for our nation for 50 hours. Today, at 2:30pm EST, representatives from every U.S. state will celebrate communion while seated at a communion table that is a mile long. It runs from the U.S. Capitol Building to the Lincoln Memorial. https://awakenthedawn.com/communionamerica/

Gatherings like these give us expectant hope that Healing and Harvest are at hand! As written in 1 John 1:3-4 MSG, "We saw it, we heard it, and now we're telling you, so you can experience it along with us, this experience of communion with the Father and his Son, Jesus Christ. Our motive for writing is simply this: We want you to enjoy this, too. Your joy will double our joy!"

With that in mind, we suggest that you take Communion today after you release these Blessing Declarations or you can take it at 12:30 mtn time in harmony with the communion taking place at that time on the Mall in DC.

Blessing Declarations for OCTOBER 11: MERCY

As written in Leviticus 16: 14-16, It is on the Mercy Seat where Christ's Blood is spread; where the very Presence of God dwells. This is evidence of the power of Christ's Blood and His atonement, which is what released mercy to mankind.

You are encouraged to claim that perspective/mindset as you speak the Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

1. We bless every person in Colorado with God's mercy of salvation as written in Hebrews 9:27-28: "And just as it is appointed for mortals to die once, and after that the judgment, so Christ was offered once to bear the sins of many; and to those who are looking for him he will appear a second time, without sin, to save them".

- 2. We declare that Colorado is now blessed by the Good News of Hebrews 11-15 (MSG). "But when the Messiah arrived, high priest of the superior things of this new covenant, He bypassed the old tent and its trappings in this created world and went straight into heaven's "tent"—the true Holy Place—once and for all. He also bypassed the sacrifices consisting of goat and calf blood, instead using His own blood as the price to set us free once and for all. If that animal blood and the other rituals of purification were effective in cleaning up certain matters of our religion and behavior, think how much more the blood of Christ cleans up our whole lives, inside and out. Through the Spirit, Christ offered himself as an unblemished sacrifice, freeing us from all those dead-end efforts to make ourselves respectable, so that we can live all out for God."
- 3. We bless Colorado believers and pre-believers alike with the words written in Hebrews 10:10: "And by that will we have been made holy through the sacrifice of the body of Jesus Christ once for all".
- 4. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the faith spoken of in Jude 3:_ "Beloved, although I made every effort to write to you about our common salvation, I feel compelled to write to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints".
- 5. Lord Jesus, we thank you and bless Colorado with Your abundant compassion and forgiveness, as it is written in Psalm 103:8, "The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in steadfast love".
- 6. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to demonstrate God's mercy, as it is written in Luke 6:36, "Be merciful, just as your Father is merciful."
- 7. We also shower the Colorado Ecclesia with the blessings that come with being merciful as written in Matthew 5:7, "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy."
- 8. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to confidently draw nearer to God's Throne of Grace so they may receive mercy and find grace to help them in their times of need. (Hebrews 4:16)
- 9. We decree Psalm 23:6 over Colorado believers: "Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever."
- 10. We decree as it is written in Titus 3: 4-7, that all people in Colorado will experience God's mercy which brings them to a place that they may be saved, washed clean, and renewed by the Holy Spirit to walk in their new life with their Lord and King.
- 11. We bless every Colorado believer to live out what is written in Psalm 123:1-4 MSG "I look to you, heaven-dwelling God, look up to you for help. Like servants, alert to their master's commands, like a maiden attending her lady, we're watching and waiting, holding our breath, awaiting your Word of Mercy. Mercy, God, mercy! We've been kicked around long enough, kicked in the teeth by complacent rich men, kicked when we're down by arrogant brutes."
- 12. We bless the people of Colorado with the truth of Lamentations 3:22-24 (NLT) "The faithful love of the Lord never ends! His mercies never cease. Great is his faithfulness; His mercies begin afresh each morning.
- 13. We bless Colorado with the promise from Luke 1:78. Because of God's tender mercy, the morning light from heaven is about to break upon us.

- 14. Because Mercy triumphs over judgement (James 2:13), Christ has called the Colorado Church to the table where He will "prepare a feast in the presence of our enemies and anoint our heads with oil." Psalm 23:5
- 15. We praise God for the mercy He has released to the Colorado Ecclesia as written in Hebrews 10:19-22 TLB "And so, dear brothers, now we may walk right into the very Holy of Holies, where God is, because of the blood of Jesus. This is the fresh, new, life-giving way that Christ has opened up for us by tearing the curtain—his human body—to let us into the holy presence of God. And since this great High Priest of ours rules over God's household, let us go right in to God himself, with true hearts fully trusting him to receive us because we have been sprinkled with Christ's blood to make us clean and because our bodies have been washed with pure water.
- 16. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with His mercy which produces unity in accordance with 1 John 1:7. "But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another and the blood of Jesus, His Son, purifies us from all our sin."
- 17. As it is written in Joen 2: 13 (AMPC), we send out a clarion call in the spirit to rend your hearts and not your garments and return to the Lord, your God, for He is gracious and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in loving-kindness; and He revokes His sentence of evil.
- 18. We bless every Colorado household with a healthy fear of the Lord which gives them God's kiss of mercy as written in Luke 1:50 (TPT) "Mercy kisses all who fear Him, from one generation to the next!"
- 19. We decree over Colorado as it is written in Psalm 145:9 (AMPC) The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works [the entirety of things created].
- 20. According to Romans 12:1 [AMPC], In view of all the mercies of God, we appeal to every person residing in Colorado to make a decisive dedication of your bodies [presenting all your members and faculties] as a living sacrifice, holy (devoted, consecrated) and well pleasing to God, which is your reasonable (rational, intelligent) service and spiritual worship.
- 21. We bless the those who are called as written in Jude 1:1b-2 (CJB) To: Those who have been called, who are loved by God the Father and kept for Yeshua the Messiah: May mercy, love and shalom be yours in full measure.
- 22. We declare Psalm 136:1 (NKJV) to the people of Colorado "O, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever
