TOPIC: Thy Kingdom Come

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's input regarding anything He might want you to add.

THY KINGDOM COME

Through July of this year, we will be releasing Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer. Last month, we focused on "Praise and Adoration" for "Our Father who art in Heaven". This month, we move on to the next phrase "Thy Kingdom Come." These words have become so familiar that believers usually speak them without a thought about their meaning.

The phrase "Thy Kingdom Come" in the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:10) refers to a request that Jesus would take His rightful place in our lives and our state. It is a petition asking God to establish His sovereign rule more fully in the heart of every Coloradan. When prayed earnestly, it expresses our willingness to submit and surrender our own agendas, inviting God the Father, Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit to rule in our lives: "For behold, the Kingdom of God is in your midst." (Luke 17:21) It encourages believers to actively participate in the Kingdom by living out its beliefs, foundational principles and values.

Seeking “Thy Kingdom come” is also a means of inviting God to reveal and make known aspects of His nature – to make manifest His Presence to draw people to Himself: to shine His light into the world so that others may respond to Him with awe and reverence as John the Baptist does in John 1:1–15.

God wants us to experience Him in a deeper way, beyond surface-level faith. You are encouraged to go deeper in your time with the Lord this month to seek God’s Kingdom and His righteousness in your life. Listen for Holy Spirit to speak to you as you proclaim “Thy Kingdom Come.” Be open to a deep walk with The Lord leading to a deep clean. Let God reveal Himself to you, move you to repentance and give you a clean slate. Let deep hope arise in your being causing you to believe deeply in what is promised as God’s Kingdom comes to earth as it is in Heaven.

Blessing Declarations for Feb 14: THY KINGDOM COME

We start by welcoming The King of Glory and His Kingdom to enter into the gates of Colorado.

1. We bless every Coloradan to see and welcome the Kingdom of God as we decree Psalm 24:7: “Lift up your heads, you gates (of Colorado); be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.”
2. We join with believers statewide, as one voice, to shout out our appeal to God based on Matthew 6:10: Lord God, bless us as we declare “Thy Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.”
3. As written in Daniel 2:44 (TPT), we bless Colorado with God’s eternal, indestructible Kingdom as He manifests His Presence and permeates our state: “In the days of those kings of iron and clay, the God of heaven will set up an eternal kingdom that will never be destroyed nor ruled by other people.”
4. We bless Colorado to welcome God’s Kingdom rule as written in Psalm 103:19: “The LORD has established His throne in heaven, and His kingdom rules over all.”
5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the words of Psalm 93: 1-2 which declares God’s everlasting kingship and rule. “The LORD reigns, He is clothed with majesty; The Lord is clothed, He has girded Himself with strength. Surely the world is established, so that it cannot be moved. Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting.”
6. We bless every sphere of society throughout Colorado to now come into alignment with the Kingdom of God...including godly reformation in schools, businesses, government, families, healthcare, churches, media, entertainment, arts, and sports.
7. As written in Isaiah 60:18, we decree that every spiritual and natural gate across Colorado is now reclaimed, reinforced and strengthened as a Kingdom Gate called “Praise”, blessing Colorado with a surge of God’s Glory which causes all wickedness to become fuel for a mighty move of God.
8. We declare blessings on every Coloradan who recognizes and acknowledges God’s Presence within themselves as written in Luke 17: 20-21 because “...The kingdom of God does not come with observation; nor will they say, ‘See here!’ or ‘See there!’ for indeed, the kingdom of God is within you.”
9. We now bless every person in, and from, Colorado with the invitation to submit to God’s Kingdom as written in Matthew 12:28 “But if I drive out demons by the Spirit of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.”
10. We bless the people of Colorado to join with the heavenly hosts as written in 1Chronicles 16:31 to “Let the heavens rejoice and let the earth be glad; And let them say among the nations, “The LORD reigns.”
11. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to now walk in Kingdom authority wielding the keys of the Kingdom as written in Matthew 16:19: “I will give you the keys of heaven’s Kingdom realm to forbid on earth that which is forbidden in heaven, and to release on earth that which is released in heaven.” TPT

12. We invite the Colorado Ecclesia to both experience and proclaim God's Kingdom statewide as written in Psalm 145:10-13, "All of your works will thank You, Lord, and Your faithful followers will praise You. They shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, and talk of Your power, to make known to the sons of men His mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations."
13. We bless every Coloradan with the invitation of Mark 1:15 "...The time is fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the Gospel."
14. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the desire and will to now align with 1Pet2: 11-12 "Dearly beloved, I beseech you as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul; Having your conversation honest among the Gentiles: that, whereas they speak against you as evildoers, they may, by your good works, which they shall behold, glorify God in the day of visitation."
15. As God's Kingdom comes to Colorado, we welcome the blessing of Holy Spirit to move on all flesh until all of Colorado comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ as written in 1Tim 2:4 which tells us that God "would have all men to be saved, and to come unto the knowledge of the truth."
16. Even as Nebuchadnezzar acknowledged in Daniel 4: 36 that God's "dominion is an everlasting dominion, And His kingdom is from generation to generation," we now release the blessings of God's dominion over every person in, and from, Colorado from generation to generation.
