Overview. Thank you for participating in a Church Prayer Watch or a County Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays! The vision of Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every field of harvest in our society to better align with God's will. We do this by calling churches and believers to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). When the Church Prayer Watch and County Prayer Watches are fully subscribed, Colorado will be covered 3 times in non-stop, day and night prayer!

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each Field of Harvest are drafted by 9 prayer leaders. As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during their monthly prayer time. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

Get your bible and a notebook/pen. Set yourself apart from distractions. Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

A prayer for you: Lord God, help me to not conform to the pattern of this world, but let me now be transformed by the renewing of my mind. Let me be able to test and approve what Your will is—Your good, pleasing and perfect will.

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song or declare the attributes of God. I praise You Lord God. You are Jehovah. You are infinite. You are omnipotent. You are good. You are love. You provide. You are peace. You are immutable. You are transcendent. You are just. You are holy. You are our healer. You are omnipresent. You are merciful. You are sovereign. You are our banner. You are wise. You are faithful. You are full of grace. You are our comforter. You are the Almighty. You are Father. You are the head of the Church. You are our intercessor. You are Master/Lord. You are our strength.



3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *"Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me and lead me in the way everlasting."* Pray these verses out loud then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to repent for, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed and repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member. Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family. Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank You Lord that my child/family member:

- · loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. II Tim. 3:14-15
- · allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. Phil. 2:13
- · earnestly seeks God. Ps. 63:1
- · loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.-Ps.122:1
- · deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. Jas. 4:7-10
- · knows and loves God's Word. Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Cultivate deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- · Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Instill deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- · God builds the House and has His way there.
- · Church members keep, guard and protect God's work.
- $\cdot\,$ Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- $\cdot\,$ The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- · Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- · Leaders put God's desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest to guide your prayers for the nine fields of harvest for Colorado. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

- 1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
- 3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
- 4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
- 5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
- 6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
- 7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
- 8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
- 9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
- 10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as The Church of Colorado now meets the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted or suffering from mental illness.
- 11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
- 12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
- 13. We declare that the hearts of the people of The Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
- 14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address key topics in societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Declare God's Word: Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions, declarations and decrees below in faith believing that we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1 John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. Lord, we thank You that You said in Matthew 19:14, "Let the little children come to me and do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of heaven." We proclaim this as Your heart and with faith believe You have opened up doors for the children of Colorado to come to You.
- 2. Thank You, Lord, for the many ways You have protected our youth and their schools across our state.
- 3. Thank You, Lord, for bringing ungodly things that have been hidden in the darkness out into the light in every Colorado school at every level of education.
- 4. Lord, will You please rise up and provide Colorado with leaders in education who will lead with integrity, according to Your will and in the fear of the Lord?
- 5. Lord, we ask for You to strengthen and embolden Christian students, teachers and staff members to share the gospel boldly and protect them as they do so. Matthew 28:16-20 and Mark 16:14-20
- 6. Lord, please protect those who are Jewish within our school systems in Colorado and keep them safe from anti-Semitic threats. May they find salvation in You.
- 7. We welcome and ask for revival and spiritual awakening in Colorado schools that ignite and spread across all of Colorado.
- 8. We pray that Your people, who are called by Your name, will now humble themselves and pray and seek Your face, and turn from their wicked ways, because You have said You will hear them from heaven, You will forgive them their sins and You will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14.
- 9. Your kingdom come Your will be done in the schools of Colorado as it is in heaven.
- 10. Lord, we ask that You continue to change the hearts of more parents to raise up their children in the way they should go knowing that You will give them the courage to be obedient to Your will for their children. Proverbs 22:6, Duet. 6:4-9 and Psalm 78:5-8



FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare that families and single people across Colorado now operate in God's abundance.
- We declare that Colorado families now flow in blessed protection with clear direction for their future. Num 6: 22-27
- 3. We declare that the culture of living together outside of marriage, divorce and separation that ravages families can no longer plague any family in Colorado.
- 4. We declare that roots of faith and belief now run so deep in Colorado families that they are not affected by the woke culture of today's society.
- 5. We declare that the evangelistic mission across Colorado now awakens families to declare Christ as their Savior and fulfill their destiny in the Kingdom of God. John 10:10

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We decree Psalm 94:19 over very person in the Colorado marketplace: "When the cares of my heart are many, Your consolations cheer my soul."
- 2. We decree Psalm 30:11 over Colorado marketplace people who are hurting: "You have turned my mourning into dancing; You have loosed my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness."
- 3. We decree Psalm 33:21 for marketplace believers across Colorado: "For our heart is glad in Him, because we trust in His holy name."
- 4. We decree Jeremiah 15:16 for every believer working in or with Colorado businesses: "Your words were found, and I ate them, and Your words became to me a joy and the delight of my heart, for I am called by Your name, O Lord, God of hosts."
- 5. We decree that Psalm 16:8-9 now becomes the mantra of every Colorado person who works in business: "I have set the Lord always before me; because He is at my right hand, I shall not be shaken. Therefore my heart is glad, and my whole being rejoices; my flesh also dwells secure (in the Marketplace)."

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. O God the Holy Spirit, Sanctifier of the faithful: Sanctify Your Church in Colorado through Your abiding Presence. Acts 4:31
- 2. We ask Lord God that you bless all the clergy who minister Your Holy Word and Sacraments. Give them boldness in the face of opposition and apathy from the world. 2 Tim 1:7 ;
- 3. Enlighten the minds of Your people more and more with the light of the everlasting Gospel. Bring erring souls to the knowledge of our Savior Jesus Christ; and those who are walking in the way of life, keep steadfast to the end. 2 Cor 3:18; 4:4-7, 16-18
- 4. Give patient endurance to the sick and afflicted even as You heal and renew them in body and soul. Rom 5:3; James 1:4,12
- 5. Guard those who are strong and prosperous from forgetting You. Increase in Your Church Your many gifts of grace, and make every church member fruitful in good works. James 1:9-11; 1 Cor 12; Rom 12
- 6. All this we ask, O blessed Spirit, whom with the Father and the Son we worship and glorify, one God, world without end. Amen.

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS

- 1. Father, we ask that You would cause Christians in media to see value in one another and work in unity with one another. (Ephesians 1:18)
- 2. Father, we declare inspiration to Your sons and daughters, bringing heaven to earth through engaging, relevant and convicting types of media.
- 3. Father, help believers in Colorado to discover avenues to shed light on current political and social issues through the genre of short and long form documentaries. And to find ways to tell these docu-stories through the lens of Your heart for humanity.
- 4. Father, provide financially for filmmakers in Colorado who are stewards of their creative giftings. Give them favor when approaching investors, sponsors and applying for funding for the stories they desire to tell that bring glory to You.
- 5. Father God, open the eyes, mind and heart of those who know You in the creative industries in Colorado so that they become deeply acquainted with You (Psalm 119:18). And take the blinder off of the eyes of those who do not know You (2 Corinthians 3:14-16), draw them to the Father by Your Holy Spirit. (John 6:44)
- 6. We declare a revival among Christians and non-Christians in the creative industries in Colorado. (John 17:3)

FIRST RESPONDER PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare that every Colorado First Responder now meditates daily on your many blessings with thanksgiving, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.
- 2. We ask, Lord, that You remind each First Responder that every good and perfect gift comes from You.
- 3. We ask, Lord, that You prompt Colorado First Responders to thank You daily for their family, friends, coworkers and all those who support them and pray for their protection.
- 4. Let each believing First Responder across Colorado come into Your presence with expectant thanksgiving and hope before every shift.
- 5. Prompt each First Responder to go forth rejoicing in the power of your Holy Spirit in their lives every day.
- 6. As the best protection, we ask, Lord, that You help every First Responder to start each day thankfully putting on the full armor of God in addition to their physical body armor.
- 7. Lord God, regularly remind each First Responder that Your strength is made perfect in their weakness so that they can seek not only Your strength, but Your wisdom and discernment in the midst of every circumstance.
- 8. Fill each Colorado First Responder with holy boldness so they are not anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let their requests for the shift be made known to You, God, so that Your peace may be with them the entire time no matter the circumstances.
- 9. In this month of Thanksgiving, let each First Responder at the end of each shift, give You thanks with praise for another day of Your protection.

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare Your Word over Israel today, "Thou, O Lord, art a shield for me; my glory and the Lifter of my head!" May Your anointed fortified presence surround Your people today and stand as a fortified wall against the attacks of the enemy. We proclaim that peace is within Your borders, O Jerusalem! May those in the Colorado arts and entertainment now stand in the gap for Israel. Psalm 3:3, Rom 10:12, Psalm 122:6
- 2. We proclaim that praise is a weapon believers use to silence the enemy in Colorado arts and entertainment. Lord, let the worshipers arise with the high praises of God on their lips and a two-edged sword in their hands so that You inhabit theirs praises statewide. Psalm 22:3, Psalm 149:6-9
- 3. We proclaim that the Son of Righteousness now arises with healing in His Wings over Colorado through every form of art and entertainment. Malachi 4:2, Jer. 17:14
- 4. We give thanks to the Lord for He is good to us across Colorado. Let every form of Thanksgiving remembrance also declare that the Lord's faithfulness is from generation to generation. He has been faithful to our families and His Word watches over us to perform it. Jer 1:12, Psalm 118:1, Psalm 119:90-91
- 5. We join with Heaven to proclaim that, at the right time, God will bring everything in Heaven and on Earth together under the authority of Christ. Let every form of art and entertainment throughout our state now begin to align with Heaven.
- 6. Let every form of art and entertainment in, and through, Colorado now encourage the Bride to "come...take the free gift of the water of life." Rev 22:17
- 7. Let the Song of the Redeemed now resonate through Your creation across all of Colorado. Rev 14:3

ISRAEL PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare, Lord God, that every person held hostage by Hamas is now uninjured and set free to return to their families and friends in Israel.
- 2. We pray, Lord God, for massive revelations and salvations to erupt among disciples and practitioners of Islam throughout the Middle East.
- 3. We pray for a greater revelation of Israel's right to the Holy Land based on the true history of the land.
- 4. We pray that the love of Jesus now overshadows the evil strongholds behind antisemitism.
- 5. We ask, Lord, for deep revelation for Christian leaders to understand the Gen 12 ramifications of rejecting or denouncing Israel.
- 6. We pray that the agenda of saturating nations like Israel with orchestrated, immigrating populations that weaken and destroy national sovereignty from within is now exposed in a greater way and stopped worldwide.
- 7. We ask, Lord, for the peace of Jerusalem...that no weapon formed against her shall prosper.
- 8. Heavenly Father, You are the Holy One Who is the guardian of Israel and of Your people. We pray for Your protection over the Jewish people in Israel and in communities here in Colorado. Let every bomb threat and every plan of violence fail and every person who would threaten and perpetrate such violence be brought to justice.
- 9. We lift up the Messianic community, Jew and Gentile, here in Colorado and in Israel. We ask that You would give them favor, unity of Spirit and of purpose, boldness of testimony and effective doors of opportunity for ministry. 1 Cor 16:9



GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare that all of Colorado, including our government leaders, now pray for the peace of Jerusalem and bless the Holy Land! We declare that 'those who bless Israel will be blessed', so we as Colorado citizens stand on that promise!!!
- 2. We decree Ps 91 and our God's protection over our government and over all those who dwell within its borders.
- 3. We declare that the November elections will bring godly people onto school boards statewide, allow righteousness to prevail at every level of government, and bring about the passage of only the ballot issues that align with God's will.
- 4. We declare that conservative, righteous people of God across Colorado will get out and vote to stand for righteousness in our state.
- 5. We declare that the time for a Micah 2:13 breakthrough and turnaround has come, causing Colorado to turn to Jesus. Let our state now turn to the Blood of Jesus and be known as the state of life, liberty and the pursuit of happiness in Jesus the Messiah!
