TOPIC: **Justice - 2**

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement for community-wide spiritual transformation. KSN empowers believers statewide to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state at 9am. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am (other dates as needed)

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's input regarding anything He might want you to add.

Establish Your Mindset to see **Justice across Colorado**

Justice and Righteousness are derived from the same Hebrew word: *šāḏāqā* which means that they go hand in hand as foundational to God's rule and reign in our state. Think of the following Blessing Declarations as building, brick-by-brick, the foundation of God's throne of rulership throughout Colorado. As ONE, we believe that every Colorado neighborhood, city, county and region is now being re-established on the foundation of God's righteousness.

You are encouraged to claim that perspective/mindset as you speak the Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

Blessing Declarations for SEPTEMBER 27: JUSTICE - 2

As a Kingdom Steward, you are charged to release God's Word out loud to see Justice arise in every Colorado community. In agreement with the Word of God and AS ONE in mind and spirit, we bless the people and land of Colorado, to stand firm as justice comes forth through these Blessing Declarations, bringing effectual change to our state. We believe that God's gavel of justice now comes down as we release His Word and call forth justice across Colorado.

1. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the wisdom to understand, as written in 2 Corinthians 3:14, that "in Christ (the veil) is taken away" allowing believers to boldly bring exposure, justice and righteous restoration to every person and situation.
2. We declare blessings on intercessors statewide as written in Luke 18:7 which reads "And will not God bring about justice for his chosen ones, who cry out to him day and night?"
3. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to bless others, rather than take revenge, as written in Romans 12:19 "Do not take revenge... for it is written: 'It is mine to avenge; I will repay,' says the Lord."
4. We bless Colorado with true justice in accordance with Deuteronomy 16: 18-20 (NLT) "Appoint judges and officials for yourselves from each of your tribes in all the towns the Lord your God is giving you. They must judge the people fairly. You must never twist justice or show partiality. Never accept a bribe, for bribes blind the eyes of the wise and corrupt the decisions of the godly. Let true justice prevail, so you may live and occupy the land that the Lord your God is giving you."
5. As the army of the Lord on earth, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the words of governance and justice presented in Psalm 18: 37-39 "I chased my enemies and caught them; I did not stop until they were conquered. I struck them down so they could not get up; they fell beneath my feet. You have armed me with strength for the battle; you have subdued my enemies under my feet.
6. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with God's Word as written in Isaiah 41:10, "Fear not [there is nothing to fear], for I am with you; do not look around you in terror and be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen and harden you to difficulties, yes, I will help you; yes, I will hold you up and retain you with My [victorious] right hand of rightness and justice." (AMPC)
7. We bless believers across Colorado to do what is written in Isaiah 56:1-2a because "This is what the Lord says: "Maintain justice and do what is right, for my salvation is close at hand and my righteousness will soon be revealed. Blessed is the one who does this— the person who holds it fast"."
8. We declare that the justice and righteousness of Colorado's Ecclesia is now a beacon of God's Light as written in Psalm 37:6 which states that our God "brings forth [our] righteousness as the light, And [our] justice as the noonday."
9. We declare to the people of Colorado as written in Psalms 9:7-8; "The Lord reigns forever; He has established His throne for judgment. He rules the world in righteousness and judges the peoples with equity."
10. We bless Colorado with God's wrap-around robe of justice and righteousness as written in Job 29:14 "I put on righteousness, and it clothed me; My justice was like a robe and a turban."

11. We decree to the people of Colorado what is written in Isaiah 28:17 “I will set justice as the true measurement and integrity as its plumb line. My hailstorm will sweep away your refuge of lies, and my floodwaters will overwhelm your hiding place.”
 12. As it is written in Proverbs 21:15 (NIV), we bless the Colorado Ecclesia who move in God’s justice because “When justice is done, it brings joy to the righteous but terror to evildoers.”
 13. We bless believers across Colorado to abide by God’s justice as written in Psalms 37:27-28 “Turn from evil and do good; then you will dwell in the land forever. 28 For the Lord loves the just and will not forsake his faithful ones.
 14. We bless the people of Colorado to hear and act on the Word of God as written in Psalm 82: 2-4 (MSG) “Enough! You’ve corrupted justice long enough; you’ve let the wicked get away with murder. You’re here to defend the defenseless, to make sure that underdogs get a fair break; Your job is to stand up for the powerless and prosecute all those who exploit them.”
 15. We bless Colorado with the fruit of righteousness and justice as written in Psalm 85:10-13 (KJV): Mercy and truth are met together; righteousness and peace have kissed each other. Truth shall spring out of the earth; and righteousness shall look down from heaven. Yea, the Lord shall give that which is good; and our land shall yield her increase. Righteousness shall go before him; and shall set us in the way of his steps., Your justice goes before You and sets us in the way of Your steps.
 16. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with God’s protection as written in 2 Thessalonians 1:6; God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you”
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
