### Blessing Declarations

January 10, 2026

#### TOPIC: **Praise & Adoration**

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

#### Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

#### Instructions:

When? 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

**Preparation:** Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

## PRAISE & ADORATION FOR GOD ALONE

Believers are encouraged to praise God alone because Scripture consistently reveals that He alone is worthy of worship, glory, and exaltation. The Bible teaches that God is the Creator of all things, and therefore no created being is to share in His glory. "I am the LORD; that is My name; and My glory I will not give to another" (Isaiah 42:8). From beginning to end, Scripture calls God's people to direct their praise exclusively to Him, recognizing His unmatched holiness, power, and sovereignty.

God alone is to be praised because He alone saves and redeems. The psalmist declares, "It is He who has made us, and not we ourselves" (Psalm 100:3), and Jonah proclaims, "Salvation belongs to the LORD" (Jonah 2:9). Unlike idols or human strength, God delivers, sustains, and forgives. "Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the LORD our God" (Psalm 20:7). Praise is therefore an act of faith, acknowledging that all help and hope come from Him alone.

## Blessing Declarations for January 10: PRAISE & ADORATION FOR GOD ALONE

Believers are called to praise God alone because He alone is eternally worthy. "Great is the LORD, and greatly to be praised; and His greatness is unsearchable" (Psalm 145:3). In heaven and on earth, worship belongs to Him alone: "To Him who sits on the throne and to the Lamb be blessing and honor and glory and power forever and ever" (Revelation 5:13). Praise directed solely to God reflects His eternal nature and affirms that He alone reigns, now and forever. You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

1. As one with the Colorado Ecclesia, we declare what is written in Judges 1:2, that Judah (praise) is now leading Colorado into, and through, the new year of 2026 breaking open what human strength cannot.
2. As written in Psalm 100:4, we encourage Colorado believers to now "enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise" leading us into God's promises and our potential for 2026. Let us each *"Enter his gates with thanksgiving and his courts with praise; give thanks to him and praise his name. For the Lord is good and his love endures forever; his faithfulness continues through all generations."*
3. We now bless the people of Colorado with a chorus of exuberant, chain-breaking praise, as Paul and Silas released while in prison in Acts 16: 25-26 (NLT): *"Around midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns to God, and the other prisoners were listening. Suddenly, there was a massive earthquake, and the prison was shaken to its foundations. All the doors immediately flew open, and the chains of every prisoner fell off!"*
4. As written in Genesis 49:10, we declare that the scepter (God's authority) now flows through the praise of believers statewide.
5. We bless Colorado believers with breakthrough praise which confounds and defeats the enemy just as Jehoshaphat received victory in 2 Chronicles 20:21, *"After consulting the people, the king appointed singers to walk ahead of the army, singing to the Lord and praising Him for His holy splendor. This is what they sang: 'Give thanks to the Lord; his faithful love endures forever!' At the very moment they began to sing and give praise, the Lord caused the armies of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir to start fighting among themselves."*
6. As it is written in 1 Chronicles 16:20, we invite every Colorado believer to *"Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; bring an offering and come before him; worship the Lord in the splendor of his holiness."* Let this increase in praise bring God's breakthrough power and victory into every situation.
7. As written in Exodus 20:3, we declare a powerful increase of praise to the One True God, across all of Colorado, which confuses darkness, disarms fear, shifts the spiritual atmosphere and opens a way for God to move in our state.
8. When the battle of daily life gets overwhelming, we declare that the Colorado Ecclesia will readily choose to take a break to praise God as written in Psalm 46:10 where *"He says, 'Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth.'"*
9. We bless believers statewide to speak God's praises according to Psalm 150:6 (TPT) *Let everything that has breath praise the Lord!" And, "Let all the universe praise him! The high heavens and everyone on earth, praise him! Let the oceans deep, with everything in them, keep it up!"*
10. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to shout praises to God as directed in Psalm 98: 4-6 (TPT) *"So go ahead, everyone, and shout out your praises with joy! Break out of the box and let loose with the most joyous sound of praise! Sing your melody of praise to the Lord and make music like never before! Blow those trumpets and shofars! Shout with joyous triumph before King Yahweh!"*

11. In accordance with Psalm 71:7 & 8, we bless the Ecclesia across Colorado to become a “wonder” to those around them as they overflow with praise to the Lord.
  12. Because God is worthy of the highest praise as declared in Psalm 145:3, we encourage every generation across Colorado to now praise God’s works to one another as written in Psalm 145:4.
  13. We bless every Coloradan to meditate on our God’s awe-inspiring acts of power and tell their friends about them as described in Psalm 145:5-6.
  14. As it is written in Hebrews 13:15, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia with much fruit from our lips (the words we speak) as we release a continual offering of praise to God.
  15. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the truth of 1 Peter 2:9 (AMP) *“But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a consecrated nation, a [special] people for God’s own possession, so that you may proclaim the excellencies [the wonderful deeds and virtues and perfections] of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light.”*
