December 27, 2025

TOPIC: THE GOODNESS OF GOD

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the <u>Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN)</u> which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in

Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put

regarding anything He might want you to add.

THE GOODNESS OF GOD

The goodness of God is woven throughout Scripture, revealing a Father whose nature is overflowing with love, mercy, and faithful care. The psalmist declares, "The Lord is good to all; He has compassion on all He has made" (Psalm 145:9), reminding us that God's goodness is not selective but extended to all creation. His generosity is evident in every good gift, for "every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of lights" (James 1:17).

Even in times of hardship, God's goodness becomes our refuge, as Nahum testifies: "The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; He knows those who trust in Him" (Nahum 1:7). Ultimately, His goodness is most vividly displayed in His steadfast love—"Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures forever" (Psalm 136:1)—a love that never wavers and continues to pursue us with grace and faithfulness.

Blessing Declarations for December 27: THE GOODNESS OF GOD

Believers should declare the goodness of God because Scripture teaches that spoken praise strengthens faith, shifts focus to God's character and testifies of His works to others. Psalm 107:2 urges, "Let the redeemed of the Lord say so," reminding us that those who have experienced His goodness should proclaim it openly. Declaring God's goodness also aligns our hearts with truth, for "death and life are in the power of the tongue". You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

- 1. We agree with every believing Coloradan as written in Psalm 106:1 "Praise the Lord! Oh give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; For His mercy is everlasting."
- 2. We encourage the Colorado Ecclesia to thank God for His goodness in order to receive goodness, as written in Psalm 107:8-9 (NKJV). "Oh, that men would give thanks to the Lord for His goodness, and for His wonderful works to the children of men! For He satisfies the longing soul and fills the hungry soul with goodness."
- 3. We bless Believers statewide to now see the Lord turning to them and answering their prayers as requested in Psalm 69:16 "Answer me, O Lord, for your steadfast love is good; according to Your abundance mercy, turn to me."
- 4. We bless every Coloradan to now dwell in the house of the Lord as written in Psalm 23:6 "Surely Goodness and Mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever."
- 5. We declare that God's goodness now blesses and satisfies Colorado believers as written in Jeremiah 31:14 "I will fill the soul of the priests with abundance, and My people will be satisfied with My goodness, declares the Lord."
- 6. We bless Colorado with a powerful movement of repentance rising up from the goodness of God as it is written in Romans 2:4 (NKJV). "Or do you despise the riches of His goodness, forbearance and long-suffering, not knowing that the Goodness of God leads you to repentance?"
- 7. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the wisdom and boldness to ask God, in His goodness, to give them a fresh infilling of Holy Spirit as written in Luke 11:13: "So if you, despite being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask Him?"
- 8. As followers of Jesus, made in the image and goodness of God, we bless every Colorado Believer to receive a fresh anointing of Holy Spirit and do as Jesus did in Acts 10:38 "He went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him."
- 9. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to now choose obedience and humility as described in Micah 6:8: "He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the Lord require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God?"
- 10. We bless every Coloradan with the Truth of 1 Timothy 4:4. "For everything created by God is good, and nothing is to be rejected if it is received with thanksgiving."
- 11. We bless Colorado with a greater witness of God's goodness as declared in Acts 14: 17 (AMP). 'Yet He did not leave Himself without some witness [as evidence of Himself], in that He kept constantly doing good things and showing you kindness, and giving you rains from heaven and productive seasons, filling your hearts with food and happiness."
- 12. We bless everyone in Colorado to actually experience the manifestation of the goodness of God as directed in Psalm 34:8 "Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good: blessed is the man who trusts in Him!"

- 13. We bless every Colorado Believer with the Truth of Philippians 1:6 "He who begin a good work in you will bring it to completion at the day of Jesus Christ."
- 14. As 2025 is ending, we proclaim Psalm 61:11 over our state with great faith: "You crown the year with Your goodness and Your paths (for 2026) drip with Abundance."

Final Declaration. Psalm 145 is full of worship that celebrates the goodness of God. He is worthy of more worship than we can ever give Him. This psalm displays a great balance between the glory (great power) of God and His gentleness and kindness. Let's speak the entire Psalm into the atmosphere of Colorado declaring God's goodness statewide.

1 My heart explodes with praise to You! Now and forever my heart bows in worship to You, my King and my God! 2 Every day I will lift up my praise to Your name with praises that will last throughout eternity. 3 Lord, You are great and worthy of the highest praise! For there is no end to the discovery of the greatness that surrounds You. 4 Generation after generation will declare more of Your greatness and declare more of Your glory. 5 Your magnificent splendor and the miracles of Your majesty are my constant meditation. 6 Your awe-inspiring acts of power have everyone talking! I'm telling people everywhere about Your excellent greatness! 7 Our hearts bubble over as we celebrate the fame of Your marvelous beauty, bringing bliss to our hearts. We shout with ecstatic joy over Your breakthrough for us. 8 You're kind and tenderhearted to those who don't deserve it and very patient with people who fail You. Your love is like a flooding river overflowing its banks with kindness. 9 God, everyone sees Your goodness, for Your tender love is blended into everything you do. 10 Everything You have made will praise You, fulfilling its purpose. And all Your godly ones will be found bowing before You. 11 They will tell the world of the lavish splendor of Your kingdom and preach about Your limitless power. 12 They will demonstrate for all to see Your miracles of might and reveal the glorious majesty of Your kingdom. 13 You are the Lord who reigns over Your neverending kingdom through all the ages of time and eternity! You are faithful to fulfill every promise You've made. You manifest Yourself as kindness in all you do. 14 Weak and feeble ones You will sustain. Those bent over with burdens of shame You will lift up. 15 You have captured our attention and the eyes of all look to You. You give what they hunger for at just the right time. 16 When You open Your generous hand, it's full of blessings, satisfying the longings of every living thing. 17 You are fair and righteous in everything you do, and Your love is wrapped into all Your works. 18 You draw near to those who call out to You, listening closely, especially when their hearts are true. 19 Every godly one receives even more than what they ask for. For You hear what their hearts really long for, and You bring them Your saving strength. 20 God, You watch carefully over all Your devoted lovers like a bodyguard, but You will destroy the ungodly. 21 I will praise you, Lord! Let everyone everywhere join me in praising the beautiful Lord of holiness from now through eternity!
