TOPIC: Deliver Us From Evil

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth in Colorado as it is in Heaven. It also entails shifting the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Deliver Us From Evil

We continue to release Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6. This month, we will speak blessing declarations addressing the first part of verse 13 which asks **"And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil."** ESV With the phrase "Deliver us from evil" we are asking God for protection from the influence of evil forces that are described in Ephesians 6:12, "For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places." We are instructed in Ephesians 6:10-11 to be strong in the Lord and in His power and might. God gives us everything we need to be delivered from evil, because He knows we can't overcome sin and temptation on our own. We Need Jesus!

Blessing Declarations June 27: Deliver Us From Evil

1. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the request of Matthew 6:13a, "...lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil."
2. We now release the words of Isaiah 54:17 over believing Coloradans to deliver each of us from evil because, "no weapon that is fashioned against you shall succeed and you shall refute every tongue that rises against you in judgment. This is the heritage of the servants of the Lord and their vindication from me, declares the Lord."
3. We declare a release of deep faith that God hears our prayers for deliverance from evil as it is written in 1 Peter 3:12-14, "For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, and his ears are open to their prayers. But the face of the Lord is against those who do evil. Now who is there to harm you if you are zealous for what is good? But even if you should suffer for righteousness' sake, you will be blessed. Have no fear of them, do not be troubled."
4. We bless every Colorado Believer with the ability to submit to God and see the devil flee from them as written in James 4:7 ESV which tells us to "Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you."
5. In the midst of the battle against evil for the future of Colorado, we stand in faith that the Lord is mighty in battle to deliver our state from evil in a Divine Reversal, even as Esther and Mordecai witnessed regarding Haman's evil; as written in Esther 7:10, "So they hanged Haman on the gallows that he had prepared for Mordecai."
6. We bless Coloradans with answers to their prayers for deliverance as it is written in Psalm 107:19, "Then they cried to the Lord in their trouble, and He delivered them from their distress."
7. We bless the people and land of Colorado with the Zeal of the Lord which will bring justice and righteousness into every sphere of society as written in Isaiah 9:7 "Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this."
8. We bless Coloradans with God's promise of Light which dispels evil as written in Isaiah 42:16, "And I will lead the blind in a way that they do not know, in paths that they have not known I will guide them. I will turn the darkness before them into light, the rough places into level ground. These are the things I do, and I do not forsake them."
9. We bless Colorado Believers with a desire for God's Light which exposes all evil as it is written in Ephesians 5:11-14, "Take no part in the unfruitful works of darkness, but instead, expose them. For it is shameful even to speak of the things that they do in secret. But when anything is exposed by the Light, it becomes visible, for anything that becomes visible is Light."
10. May every Coloradan now be blessed with the "Light of Men" as described in John 1:4-5, "In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it." (ESV)
11. We bless the people of Colorado with continued deliverance from the evil of darkness as it is written in Colossians 1:13, "He has delivered us from the domain of darkness and transferred us to the Kingdom of His Beloved Son."
12. We bless our entire state with the "Great Light" described in Isaiah 9:2, "The people who walked in darkness have seen a great light; those who dwelt in a land of deep darkness, on them has light shone!"

13. We bless Colorado Believers with the freedom to walk as children of the light! Ephesians 5:8 “For at one time you were darkness, but now you are Light in the Lord.”
14. Proverbs 8:13 tells us that, “The fear of the Lord is hatred of evil. Pride and arrogance and the way of evil and perverted speech—these the Lord hates.” May the Fear of the Lord now fall upon every Coloradan setting them free from every form of evil.
15. We bless the Ecclesia statewide with deliverance and preservation as it is written in 2 Timothy 4:18, “And the Lord will deliver me from every evil work and preserve *me* for His heavenly kingdom. To Him *be* glory forever and ever. Amen!”
16. We declare that Believers across Colorado are now blessed by the Truth of Psalm 121:7 which tells us that, “The Lord shall preserve you from all evil; He shall preserve your soul.”
17. As part of the Colorado Ecclesia, we declare that we are blessed by the words of Psalm 34:17, “*The righteous* cry out, and the LORD hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles.”
18. We believe Psalm 91:3-4 for every person in Colorado: “Surely, He shall deliver you from the snare of the fowler *and* from the perilous pestilence. He shall cover you with His feathers, and under His wings you shall take refuge; His truth *shall be your* shield and buckler.”
19. We bless Colorado sons and daughters of God’s Kingdom with His faithful promises as written in Jeremiah 15:21, “I will deliver you from the hand of the wicked, and I will redeem you from the grip of the terrible.”
20. We bless Believers statewide with the comfort written in Isaiah 43:2, “When you pass through the waters, I will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overwhelm you; when you walk through fire you shall not be burned, and the flame shall not consume you.”
21. We bless every person in Colorado with the Truth of Psalm 18:2, “The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.”
22. Finally, we pray 2 Thessalonians 3:1-3 over Believers statewide: “Finally, brothers, pray for us, that the word of the Lord may speed ahead and be honored, as happened among you, and that we may be delivered from wicked and evil men. For not all have faith. But the Lord is faithful. He will establish you and guard you against the evil one.”
