The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

### Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

#### Instructions:

When? 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in

Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthrone Jesus as King over

yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put

regarding anything He might want you to add.

# PEACE for the People and Government of Colorado

In the Bible, peace is often associated with the reign of a righteous government, particularly in Isaiah 9:6-7, which describes a future King Jesus who will bring everlasting peace and justice. This scripture emphasizes that the government rests on His shoulders, highlighting the connection between divine governance and peace.

The concept of government in scripture is not just about authority but also about the responsibility to maintain peace and justice. Romans 13:1-4 highlights that governing authorities are established by God to promote good and punish wrongdoing. This aligns with the biblical view that a just government is essential for societal peace.

The idea that peace is a form of government suggests that true peace comes from divine authority. In Isaiah 26:3-4, it is stated that those who trust in God will experience His perfect peace. This indicates that peace is not merely the absence of conflict but a state of well-being that is rooted in a relationship with God and His governance.

## **Blessing Declarations for OCTOBER 25: PEACE**

Scripture presents peace as an integral aspect of God's government. The reign of the "Prince of Peace" signifies a future hope where justice and righteousness prevail, establishing a framework for understanding how divine governance leads to true peace in the world. You are encouraged to claim this perspective and mindset as you speak the following Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

- 1. As it is written in Acts 17:28, we bless every person in Colorado to now live, move and have their being in Jesus, the Prince of Peace, upon whose shoulders rests the government according to Isaiah 9:6. "For unto us a Child is born, to us a Son is given; and the government shall be upon His shoulder, and His name shall be called Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace."
- 2. We declare that God's Peace (His Government) now consumes His Colorado Ecclesia which breaks every chain of anxiety or fear just as He said in Nahum 1:13.
- 3. We declare that God's peace now operates like a soldier, guarding and protecting the heart and mind of every Colorado believer as written in Philippians 4:6-7, "Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus".
- 4. We decree John 14:27 to the people of Colorado, "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your heart be troubled and do not be afraid".
- 5. We encourage every Coloradan to now trust in Jesus as it is written in Isaiah 26:3 "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in You"
- 6. We bless every Colorado believer with an abundance of the Galations 5:22-23 fruit of the spirit including love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.
- 7. As joint heirs with Jesus, we bless every Colorado believer with peace as written in John 16:33 NLT: "I have told you all this so that you may have peace in Me. Here on earth, you will have many trials and sorrows. But take heart, because I have overcome the world." John 16:33 NLT
- 8. We declare that Colorado is now blessed with an abundance of true peacemakers who are called sons of God as described in Matthew 5:9. "Blessed (enjoying enviable happiness, spiritually prosperous, with life-joy and satisfaction in God's favor, and salvation, regardless of their outward conditions) are the makers and maintainers of peace, for they shall be called the sons of God!" Matthew 5:9 AMPC
- 9. We encourage Colorado believers to adhere to what is written in Romans 12: 17-18 "Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everyone. If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone."
- 10. We call the Colorado Ecclesia into alignment with the words written in Ephesians 4: 2-3: "be humble and gentle with one another and to bear with each other in love by keeping the unity of Your Spirit through the bond of peace."
- 11. We bless every person in Colorado with God's Word in Romans 15:13: "May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit".
- 12. As it is written in Romans 8:6, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to have minds that are perpetually governed by the Spirit: "For to be carnally minded is death, but to be spiritually minded is life and peace."
- 13. We encourage the Colorado Ecclesia to let the words of Colossians 3:15 govern their hearts bringing oneness into every community "And let the peace of God rule in your hearts, to which also you were called in one body; and be thankful."
- 14. We declare Isaiah 54:13 over parents statewide believing in faith that "All your children will be taught by Yahweh, and great will be their peace and prosperity."

- 15. As it is written in Isaiah 61:4 AMPC, we declare that peace now brings restoration to the streets of Colorado: "And they shall rebuild the ancient ruins; they shall raise up the former desolations and renew the ruined cities, the devastations of many generations."
- 16. We now bless every Colorado family with the promise of Malachi 4: 6 as God's peace now turns the hearts of the fathers to the children and the hearts of the children to their fathers",
- 17. We declare, in complete agreement with the words of Isaiah 9:7, that peace is now entering Colorado in powerful new ways and that "Of the greatness of his government and peace there will be no end.
- 18. We now bless the people of Colorado to follow God's commands to have peace as written in Isaiah 48:18 NLT "Oh, that you had listened to my commands! Then you would have had peace flowing like a gentle river and righteousness rolling over you like waves in the sea.
- 19. Known as the "Headwaters State", we bless the people of Colorado as it is written in Amos 5:24 AMPC: "But let justice run down like waters and righteousness as a mighty and ever-flowing stream."
- 20. We bless every Colorado believer with complete healing as written in Isaiah 53:5 "But He was pierced for our transgressions, He was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was on Him, and by His wounds we are healed.
- 21. We bless ever person in, and from, Colorado as it is written in 2 Thessalonians 3:16, "Now may the Lord of peace Himself give you peace always, in every way. The Lord be with you all."
