TOPIC: Thy Will Be Done

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth as it is in Heaven and shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

THY WILL BE DONE

Through July of this year, we will be releasing Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6:10. Last month, we focused on "Thy Kingdom Come". This month, we move on to the next phrase "Thy Will Be Done." This phrase, taught by Jesus, expresses the desire of Believers for God's purposes, authority, and plans to be fulfilled on earth just as perfectly as they are in heaven. At the core, He was teaching all believers to submit their desires and decisions to God's authority. It is acknowledgement that that God's wisdom and purposes are higher than human understanding as written in Isaiah 55: 8-9, which tells us "For my thoughts are not your thoughts, neither are your ways my ways, declares the Lord." This phrase is a declaration of trust, surrender and submission to God's plan for our lives and families.

"Thy will be done" also communicates a willingness to actively obey what God has revealed through revelation and scripture. As written in James 1:22, we are to "be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving

yourselves.” That means applying God’s Word in daily life to align with God’s commands and purposes. It requires faith and trust in God and His Word to be obedient, but it is “better than sacrifice” (1 Samuel 15:22).

The blessing declarations we release this month will focus on both God’s Perfect (Sovereign) Will and His Moral (Revealed) Will. As described in Psalm 33:11, God’s Perfect Will refers to His sovereign plan and purposes which cannot ultimately be stopped or changed: “The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of his heart to all generations.” It is the unfolding of His divine plan in history.

God’s Moral (Revealed) Will is evident throughout scripture as His standards of righteousness. It describes what God desires people to do and how they should live. Unlike God’s sovereign will, people can choose to disobey His moral will, which is why Scripture frequently calls people to repentance and obedience. Let’s believe that people in Colorado will humble themselves and submit to God’s will.

Join with us as we declare God’s will be done through the people and land of Colorado.

Blessing Declarations March 28: THY WILL BE DONE

1. We ask Lord that You now bless the people of Colorado to turn to Your truth, actively obey Your word, resist temptation and follow Your divine Guidance according to James 4:7 *“Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.”*
2. We pray that Colorado is soon blessed with a massive harvest of souls as it is written in 1 Timothy 2:3-4 *“For this is good and acceptable in the sight of God our Savior, who desires all men to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth.”*
3. We declare that more Colorado believers are now blessed as they come into alignment with God’s word and will as written in Ephesians 5:15-20 *“See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise, redeeming the time, because the days are evil. Therefore, do not be unwise, but understand what the will of the Lord is. And do not be drunk with wine, in which is dissipation; but be filled with the Spirit, speaking to one another in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord, giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,”*
4. We encourage every Believer, in and from Colorado, to learn submission and obedience as it’s written in Psalm 143:10 *“Teach me to do Your Will, for you are my God.”*
5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the admonition of Romans 12:1-2 *“I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.”*
6. We now invite the Ecclesia to follow in the footsteps of Jesus, to do the Father’s will as written in John 6:38-40 *“For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day. And this is the will of Him who sent Me, that everyone who sees the Son and believes in Him may have everlasting life; and I will raise him up at the last day.”*
7. We caution God’s people in Colorado to employ the wisdom of God’s word along with personal revelation to *“...test and approve what God’s will is — his good, pleasing and perfect will.”* Romans 12:2

8. As written in Matthew 7:21, we encourage Colorado Believers to be obedient to do the will of God because *“Not everyone who says to Me, ‘Lord, Lord,’ shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.”*
9. We declare that every Colorado believer now has ears to hear and eyes to see Jesus clearly; putting aside the lusts that detract us from God’s will as written in 1 John 2:16-17 *“For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever.”*
10. We declare unity in the spirit for those who do God’s will as it is written in Mark 3:35, *“For whoever does the will of God is My brother and My sister and mother.” Let this truth be a blessing to the Colorado Ecclesia.*
11. As it is written in Psalm 40:8, we bless every Coloradoan with an invitation to have a joyful heart that declares *“I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart.”*
12. We release a wave of spiritual encouragement to Believers statewide to live for the praise of God’s glory as we read in Ephesians 1:11 AMP. *“In Him we also were made [God’s] heritage (portion) and we obtained an inheritance; for we had been foreordained (chosen and appointed beforehand) in accordance with His Purpose, Who works out everything in agreement with the counsel and design of His [own] will, so that we who first hoped in Christ live for the praise of His Glory!”*
13. We encourage every Colorado Believer to *“Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him and He will make your paths straight.”* Proverbs 3:5-6
14. We call Believers statewide to do good as it is written in 1 Peter 2:15, *“For this is the will of God, that by doing good you should put to silence the ignorance of foolish people.”*
15. On behalf of the people of Colorado, we now *“Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.”* 1 Thessalonians. 5:18
