TOPIC: Justice - 1

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the <u>Kingdom Stewards Network (KSN)</u> which is a statewide prayer movement for community-wide spiritual transformation. KSN empowers believers statewide to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each one aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state at 9am. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am (other dates as needed)

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning

yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthrone Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with

You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen

for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Establish Your Mindset to see Justice across Colorado

Colorado and America need to see evidence of Justice—our officials must pursue issues through to a judgement, a prosecution, some real action and change

Although it appears obvious that Colorado is infiltrated by darkness and evil in our government, schools and marketplace, the Bible repeatedly reminds us that God's justice will be victorious because we are His Ecclesia who have His power and authority on earth as it is in heaven. You are encouraged to claim that perspective/mindset as you speak the Blessing Declarations into the atmosphere of Colorado. Please set your mind to be steadfast, unmovable and abounding in the work of the Lord. (1 Cor 15:57-58)

Blessing Declarations for SEPTEMBER 13: JUSTICE - 1

As a Kingdom Steward, you are charged to release God's Word out loud to see Justice arise in every Colorado community. In agreement with the Word of God and AS ONE in mind and spirit, we bless the people and land of Colorado, to stand firm as justice to comes forth through these Blessing Declarations bringing effectual change to our state. We believe that God's gavel of justice now comes down as we release His Word and call forth justice across Colorado.

- 1. We bless the people of Colorado with the truth of Proverbs 14:34 which declares that Righteousness (God devotion) exalts and makes a nation strong; but sin (God-avoidance) releases justice which condemns people and makes them weak.
- 2. We bless believers statewide with the boldness and confidence of Matthew 16: 18-19 to use the keys of the Kingdom of Heaven to execute God's justice on earth by binding what needs to be bound and loosing what needs to be loosed, so that the gates of Hades will not overcome Colorado.
- 3. We bless Colorado with an atmosphere so saturated with God's Glory that we now experience "justice roll down like waters, and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream" as written in Amos 5:24.
- 4. As written in Isaiah 26:2, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia to take back the Gates of Colorado in the natural and spiritual realms opening them "to all who are righteous; allowing the faithful to enter".
- 5. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to be in alignment with what God requires of us as written in Micah 6:8; "to do justice, to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God." and as written in Isaiah 1: 17 "Learn to do right; seek justice. Defend the oppressed. Take up the cause of the fatherless; plead the case of the widow."
- 6. As it is written in Deuteronomy 16:20, we encourage believers statewide to "Follow justice and justice alone, so that you may live and possess the land the Lord your God is giving you."
- 7. We declare Psalm 106:3 over the people of Colorado: "Blessed are those who act justly, who always do what is right."
- 8. We decree Isaiah 10: 1-2 over Colorado government at every level; ""Woe to those who make unjust laws... to deprive the poor of their rights."
- 9. As written in Ephesians 5:11, we bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the wisdom to "Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness but rather expose them."
- 10. We decree over the people of Colorado as written in Ecclesiastes 3:17 "God will bring into judgment both the righteous and the wicked."
- 11. We release the blessings of Isaiah 28:6 over Colorado as "the Lord Almighty (is now) a spirit of justice to the one who sits in judgment, a source of strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate.
- 12. We bless every Colorado believer to stand humble and resolute before our God as commanded in Hosea 12:6 (MSG) "What are you waiting for? Return to your God! Commit yourself in love, in justice! Wait for your God, and don't give up on Him—ever!"
- 13. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to walk out our Covenant with God in accordance with Jeremiah 22:3 (msg) "This is God's Message: Attend to matters of justice. Set things right between people. Rescue victims from their exploiters. Don't take advantage of the homeless, the orphans, the widows. Stop the murdering!"

- 14. We call the Colorado Ecclesia to the blessing of fasting as the Lord outlines in Isaiah 58: 6-9 (MSG) ""This is the kind of fast day I'm after: to break the chains of injustice, get rid of exploitation in the workplace, free the oppressed, cancel debts. What I'm interested in seeing you do is: sharing your food with the hungry, inviting the homeless poor into your homes, putting clothes on the shivering ill-clad, being available to your own families. Do this and the lights will turn on, and your lives will turn around at once. Your righteousness will pave your way. The God of glory will secure your passage. Then when you pray, God will answer. You'll call out for help and I'll say, 'Here I am.'
- 15. We bless all of Colorado with justice and salvation as God commanded in Isaiah 45:8, "You heavens above, rain down My righteousness; let the clouds shower it down. Let the earth open wide, let salvation spring up, let righteousness flourish with it; I, the Lord, have created it.
- 16. As our God's justice prevails in Colorado, we decree the manifestation of Isaiah 60:18 "Violence will disappear from your land; the desolation and destruction of war will end. Salvation will surround you like city walls, and praise will be on the lips of all who enter."
