Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24-hour Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. *He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.*

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

6. PRAYER POINTS

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God’s will according to Job 22:28: *“You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways.”* (NKJ)

Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6) Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society.

Colorado Prays **Ministry PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We pray that Colorado Prays has reached a tipping point where more and more churches will engage in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays until every county is covered in a Neh. 4:20 wall of prayer.
2. We pray for new strategies and resources to communicate the vision of Colorado Prays to pastors statewide.
3. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch.
4. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
5. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need an administrator, a WIX web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
6. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
7. We praise God that we now have 10 counties covered by Cover The County which hosts a regularly-scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado county while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer (eight counties are currently covered). We pray that more leaders come forth in each of the 64 counties statewide.

Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado– that God’s love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God’s love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women now choose life for their babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God’s love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of “taking offense” to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

COVID-19 PRAYER POINTS:

1. We ask, Lord God, that herd immunity kick in now considering the increasing number of people who have contracted COVID-19 and those who have been vaccinated.
2. We declare that our God is able to make all grace abound to us so that in all things, at all times, we have all that we need (food, medication and supplies) and that there is now coming an economic resurgence as God meets all our needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. (2Cor 9:8, Phil 4:19)
3. We declare that the evil which has been intended to harm us – including any harm that could come from the vaccines - will now be used by our God for His good will and purpose in our lives and in the life of THE CHURCH of Colorado. (Gen 50:20)

Topical Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that the state of Colorado is in covenant with Israel and we bless the nation of Israel.
2. We speak peace over Israel and declare Ps 68 - Our God is a mighty God who saves Israel over and over.
3. We declare that no more unrighteous laws will pass our legislature. We say no to vaccine passports, no to vile sex education for children and no to all legislation that violates the freedoms given to us in the Constitution of the United States!
4. We declare that Colorado will be known as a place of life and light. In the Name of Jesus, we command all spirits of darkness in our government to be removed from every place it has encamped.
5. We declare that the righteousness of the Lord Jesus Christ now prevails over and inside our state government! No more unjust, ungodly actions are allowed in Jesus Name! We say enough is enough!
6. We issue a declaration of 'turnaround' to our Governor and his followers. We declare that no more corruption, no more hidden things are allowed; that everything that has been hidden is now revealed and brought to justice.

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare Your Church will rise up and worship in honest expression before You, oh Lord. (Ps 141:2; 143:6; Ezra 9:5; Neh 8:6; Ps 63:4; 28:2; 134:2; I Kings 8:22; I Tim 2:8)
2. Oh Lord, we pray we would offer ourselves as a living sacrifice in our worship to You. (Rom 12:1; Heb 12:28 NLT; I Cor 6:20)
3. We agree with Your Word, oh Lord, that calls us to surrender (Gen 22:2) the valuable (our pride, our ego, our fears, our timidity, our tradition) in our worship of You.
4. May we, Your Bride, put You, Majestic One, front and center in our worship. (Ps 99:5, 9; 145:1; 29:1-2; Rom 11:33-36; Heb 13:20-21)
5. Jesus, we humbly cry out that we would love You back in our worship. (Lk 10:27; Ps 100:3-4; Lk 1:46)

FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray that married couples now walk in the boldness and confidence of Christ Jesus as they acknowledge Zech 4:6: "Not by might nor by power, but by My Spirit," says the Lord of hosts."
2. We declare Isaiah 41:10 over every Colorado family: "Fear not, for I am with you; Be not dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you, Yes, I will help you, I will uphold you with My righteous right hand."
3. We pray that every Colorado marriage now becomes strong in supernatural unity (Gen 2:24 One Flesh Oneness) as husbands and wives operate in the wisdom of the marriage covenant. Let their covenant be as a Nehemiah 4:20 wall of protection around their family.
4. We pray that families statewide now have spiritual eyes to see and spiritual ears to hear the Truth which breaks all deception being promoted regarding gender issues, racial issues, constitutional rights and other political/cultural issues.
5. We pray for provision for every Colorado family, that they are more than able to quickly recover from any financial hardship from the past year.

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare Ps 128: 1-2 over the Colorado Marketplace. Blessed are all who fear the Lord, who walk in obedience to Him. You will eat the fruit of your labor; blessings and prosperity will be yours.
2. We speak to Marketplace leaders across Colorado and declare: Let your eyes look straight ahead: fix your gaze directly before you. Give careful thought to the paths for your feet and be steadfast in all your ways. Prov. 4:25-26.
3. We pray that Colorado believers in the Marketplace heed Deut 8: 17-18: Beware lest you say in your heart, my power and the might of my hand have gotten me this wealth. You shall remember the Lord your God, for it is He who gives you power to get wealth, that He may confirm His covenant that He swore to your fathers, as it is this day.
4. We pray that workers and leaders in the Marketplace do not compare themselves with others. We declare Gal 6:5 (Msg), that each of you must take responsibility for doing the creative best you can with your own life.
5. We pray for humility among Colorado Marketplace people: But we will not boast beyond limits, but will boast only with regard to the area of influence God assigned to us in the Marketplace, to reach even to You. 2cor. 10:13
6. We declare that people thrive financially as the Colorado economy now resurges.

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare revival in the Colorado Arts and Entertainment Mountain as we ask You, Lord, to ignite Your people with holy passion to lift Your name up high above all else.
2. We declare that now is the time for THE COLORADO CHURCH to emerge and take preeminence in every Colorado community, leading people in the way they should go.
3. We call for the songs of the people to arise from our congregations. May man's traditions of singing be replaced by spirit-led worship from every Colorado sanctuary. We proclaim freedom for believers to bring personal, heartfelt worship before You, Lord God. John 4:23, Psa 96:3
4. We declare that every pastor and leader in every Colorado church is now in alignment with your purposes to lead Your people in Kingdom advancement. We believe, Lord, that you are breaking through in new ways to awaken your Bride to answer the call of the Bridegroom and follow Him. Isaiah 60:1, john 16:13, psalm 95:1-6
5. We declare that a new song is arising in the hearts and mouths of every Colorado believer. As we lift our voices in fervency, in full conviction, in complete adoration, we trust that You are arising on the wings of our Praises. Let joy return to the Bride as she seeks Your face. Psalm 40:3, Psalm 98:1, Isaiah 42:10
6. We agree with Your Spirit, Lord, that you are aligning our upward vision with Your will, so that Your outward vision will be propelled across Colorado. Whom shall I send, and Who will go for us? We will lift our eyes and our hearts toward Zion, allow you to purge our lips and our ways, and be ready for You in this hour when You call to us, Lord God. Isaiah 6

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. We ask, Lord God, that You prompt Colorado parents to raise up their children biblically according to Proverbs 22:6: Train up a child in the way he should go, and when he is old, he will not depart from it.
2. We ask, Lord, that You now raise up education leaders in Colorado who are obedient to God in the school board seats, in school administration positions and as school staff.
3. We ask, Lord, that You forgive us for allowing wickedness in our Colorado schools. Cleanse every school, college and university of wicked leaders and wicked curriculum.
4. We ask, Lord, that You bring revival and spiritual awakening to every Colorado school, college and university.
5. We ask You, Lord God, to provide physical, spiritual, relational and mental protection for the students, teachers, staff and families in every Colorado schools.
6. We pray that every Colorado school is now a place of peace, kindness and love and which overcomes any forms of fear, anxiety or depression and ends youth suicide in Colorado.
7. We ask, Lord, that students who have fallen behind this past year are now given resources, support and perseverance to resolve any gaps in their education.
8. We pray that You protect the well-being of Colorado students at all education levels from legislation that is not rooted in God's wisdom and righteousness.
9. We pray that parents now be awakened to the reality of their children's education and get involved to support their children and change the education system.
10. We call forth more parents to actively intercede in prayer for their students and schools.

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. We praise You, Merciful God, that You have not dealt with the people in the Colorado Media Mountain according to their sins, nor punished according to their iniquities. We declare that Your loving-kindness and mercy now releases forgiveness to set the captives in the Media Mountain free. (Acts 4:24, Ps. 103:6, 10, Isa. 61:1-2)
2. We declare Matt 16:19 over the Colorado Media Mountain. We take the keys of the Kingdom of God and bind the Kingdom of the Light of Jesus to every media person and loose the stranglehold of the kingdom of darkness from their beings to set them free.
3. We declare that the Kingdom of God is upon the Media Mountain where Jesus is the victorious King who undoes the works of the devil. (1John 3:8 AMP)
4. In the wonderful Name of Jesus, we declare: Let there be Light to release the Spirit of wisdom and truth which will pierce all darkness over the Media Mountain. We declare freedom to every worker in every form of Colorado media! Be free from the spirit of deception and come into the marvelous Light. (Gen. 1:3, John 8:12, 2 Cor. 4:6, Matt.6:9-13, Rev. 12:10-11, Eph. 5:14)
5. Father, we ask for a release of the fear of the Lord through every form of media in Colorado, which turns hearts to you and brings discernment and righteousness to Coloradans. (Matthew 16:19, Rom. 14:17)
6. We declare peace and reconciliation with people in the media throughout Colorado because where sin abounds, grace abounds so much more. (Rom 5:20, 2 Cor 5:18-19, Matt 6:15)

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. We pray for a statewide flood of appreciation, honor, respect and gratitude for all first responders.
2. We pray Psalm 91 over every Colorado first responder, that God is their refuge and their fortress who saves them from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
3. We ask, Lord God, that every non-believing first responder in Colorado now experience an encounter with the living God, leading them to receive Jesus as their Savior.
4. We declare that every Colorado first responder walks in the light of Jesus and is supernaturally protected and consistently functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings so that not one is taken off guard or injured in any way this year.
5. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every work day with no repercussions from leadership or any outside entity.
6. We declare that every prison and jail in Colorado now manifests God's presence with such intensity that each person inside is miraculously healed and has perfect clarity regarding their identity in Christ Jesus bringing their emotions and actions in alignment with God's will.
7. We declare that all corruption and unrighteous behavior among Colorado law enforcement now be exposed and brought to justice.
8. We declare that every Colorado first responder is endowed with great stamina and is protected emotionally from the stress of the job.
