TOPIC: Honor God Personally

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth in Colorado as it is in Heaven. It also entails shifting the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak the blessings of God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for Holy Spirit's input regarding anything He might want you to add.

Honor God Personally

Having completed our focus on the Lord's Prayer, this month starts a new theme of speaking Blessing Declarations to rebuild Colorado in the spirit realm. This spiritual transformation starts at the personal level by honoring God as Lord over every area of our life. We honor Him by loving Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Matthew 22:37), by presenting our body as living sacrifice that is holy and pleasing to Him (Romans 12:1), and by seeking to glorify Him in everything we do (1 Corinthians 10:31). As a life surrendered to God, what we do to honor Him entails walking in holiness, obeying His Word, trusting His promises, stewarding faithfully what He has entrusted to us, and giving Him the first and best of our life (Proverbs 3:9). As we fear the Lord, love what He loves, turn from evil, and live in faithful obedience, our life becomes an offering of honor to Him. In this way, honoring God personally means that He receives first place in our heart, our choices, our relationships, our resources, our work, and our daily life. This Blessing Saturday focuses on how you choose to honor God personally.

Blessing Declarations Aug 8: Honor God Personally

1. As the beginning of honoring God personally, we now choose the blessing of the personal reformation spoken of in Romans 12:2 TPT “Stop imitating the ideals and opinions of the culture around you but be inwardly transformed by the Holy Spirit through a total reformation of how you think. This will empower you to discern God’s will as you live a beautiful life, satisfying and perfect in His eyes.”
2. We bless Coloradans with the passionate desire of Psalm 51:10, “Create in me a clean heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.”
3. We invite every Colorado Believer to seek purity and holiness within their life before God as it is written in 1 Peter 1:15-16, “...but as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct because it is written, “Be holy, for I am holy.””
4. We bless Your Colorado Ecclesia with a desire to live in accordance with your Word as the bible encourages in Mark 12:30, “Love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.”
5. We release the blessings of Matt 5:8 upon every Colorado Believer, “Blessed are the pure in heart, for they shall see God.”
6. We bless Colorado Believers who are seeking after God and His righteousness with all the treasures spoken of in Matt 6:33, “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”
7. We declare that every Colorado Believer is blessed with the ability to offer sacrificial worship as presented in Romans 12:1, “Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies as a living and holy sacrifice, acceptable to God, which is your spiritual service of worship.”
8. We bless ourselves and every Colorado Believer with the ability to trust the Lord, laying down our agenda and control as it is written in Proverbs 3:5 TPT, “Trust in the Lord completely, and do not rely on your own opinions. With all your heart rely on him to guide you, and he will lead you in every decision you make.”
9. We thank You Lord for blessing each of us with a deep love for God that continually motivates and guides us as written in Matthew 22:37 TPT, “Jesus answered him, ”Love the Lord your God with every passion of your heart, with all the energy of your being, and with every thought that is within you.”
10. We bless each of us to repent and turn from evil to preserve our soul as written in Proverbs 16:17 “The highway of the upright is to depart from evil; He who keeps his way preserves his soul.”
11. We bless every Colorado Believer to be holy yourself as written in 1 Peter 14-16 NASB, “As obedient children, do not be conformed to the former lusts which were yours in your ignorance, but like the Holy One who called you, be holy yourselves also in all your behavior; because it is written: “You shall be holy, for I am holy.”

12. We bless Coloradans to delight in the pursuit of their relationship with God through prayer as written in 1 Thessalonians 5: 16-18 TPT, “Let joy be your continual feast. Make your life a prayer. And in the midst of everything be always giving thanks, for this is God’s perfect plan for you in Christ Jesus.”
13. To honor God in a deeper way, we invite every Believer statewide to apply the command of 1 Kings 8:61, “Be fully devoted to the Lord our God. Walk in His ways. Keep his commands.”
14. We bless Colorado Believers to keep God as their one and only true master, forsaking other idols as it is written in Matthew 6:24, “No one can serve two masters. You cannot serve both God and money.”
15. We bless every Believer in Jesus to keep Him in the center of their life as commanded in Colossians 3:17, “Do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus. Give thanks to God the Father through him.”
16. We bless every Coloradan, who believes upon Lord Jesus, with God’s Word in Romans 12:12 that says we are to, “Be joyful in hope. Be patient in trouble. Be faithful in prayer.”
17. As it is written in 1 Peter 1:13-16 NASB2020, we bless every Colorado Believer to, “Thank [God] in everything [no matter what the circumstances may be, be thankful and give thanks], for this is the will of God for you [who are] in Christ Jesus [the Revealer and Mediator of that will].”
18. We decree that the blessings and protection of fear of the Lord presented in Proverbs 19:23 now encompass Colorado Believers as they each pursue a deeper relationship with God because “The fear of the Lord leads to life, and whoever has it rests satisfied; he will not be visited by harm.”

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
