#### TOPIC: **Forgive Us as We Forgive**

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth in Colorado as it is in Heaven. It also entails shifting the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

#### Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

#### Instructions:

When? 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

**Preparation:** Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

## Forgive Us as We Forgive

Through July of this year, we will be releasing Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6. This month, we will speak blessing declarations addressing verse 12 which tells us to "... forgive us our debts, as we have forgiven our debtors (NKJV). Forgiveness emphasizes extending mercy to others as God extends it to us, as well as, cleansing and releasing grudges. God tells us to forgive so that we can be forgiven by Him (Matthew 6:14-15). Forgiveness is not an option, it is a reflection of God's kindness and mercy shown to us. Forgiveness toward another who has trespassed against us is a heart-level action that releases bitterness and anger, whether there is physical reconciliation or not. Through Jesus Christ a divine example is given, it is complete and undeserved forgiveness that is offered all because of our Father's great and mighty love for us. Matthew 26:28, "For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins."

## Blessing Declarations May 9: *Forgive Us as We Forgive*

1. We release the blessings of Acts 3:19 TPT over the people of Colorado so that God's Presence will manifest statewide: "And now you must repent and turn back to God so that your sins will be removed, and so that times of refreshing will stream from the Lord's presence." Acts 3:19 TPT
2. We bless every Coloradan with God's Word as it is written in 1 John 1:9 TPT which says "But if we freely admit our sins when His Light uncovers them, He will be faithful to forgive us every time. God is just to forgive us our sins because of Christ, and He will continue to cleanse us from all unrighteousness."  
1 John 1:9 TPT
3. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the revelation of Psalm 103:12, "As far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us."
4. We declare the blessings of Isaiah 1:18 over the people of Colorado, "Though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow."
5. We bless every Coloradan with the revelation of God described in Micah 7:18-19 which says, "Who is a God like You, pardoning iniquity and passing over the transgression of the remnant of His heritage? He does not retain His anger forever, Because He delights in mercy. He will again have compassion on us and will subdue our iniquities. You will cast all our sins into the depths of the sea."
6. We bless the Ecclesia across Colorado with the heart knowledge and experience as written in Psalm 86:5, "You, Lord, are forgiving and good, abounding in love to all who call to you."
7. We declare that people across Colorado are now blessed by the mercies of God as written in Proverbs 28:13, "He who covers his sins will not prosper, but whoever confesses and forsakes them will have mercy."
8. We bless the people of God with His faithfulness and mercy as it is written in Deuteronomy. 4:31, "(for the LORD your God is a merciful God), He will not forsake you nor destroy you, nor forget the covenant of your fathers which He swore to them."
9. We decree Ephesians 1:7 over the Colorado Ecclesia, "In Him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace."
10. We bless the people of God in, and from, Colorado with the revelation written in Hebrews 12:1-2, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus, the founder and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy that was set before him endured the cross, despising the shame, and is seated at the right hand of the throne of God."
11. We decree Psalm 86:5 over every person across Colorado, "For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you."
12. We bless Coloradans statewide with the words written in Colossians 1: 13-14 NLT "For He has rescued us from the kingdom of darkness and transferred us into the Kingdom of His dear Son, who purchased our freedom and forgave our sins."

13. We encourage and bless Colorado Believers to align with, and act upon, the words written in 2 Chronicles 7:14-15 ESV, “If My people who are called by My Name humble themselves, and pray and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land. Now my eyes will be open and my ears attentive to the prayer that is made in this place.”
  14. We bless people statewide to now believe in Jesus as their Savior for “He is the one all the prophets testified about, saying that everyone who believes in Him will have their sins forgiven through his name.” Acts 10:43 NLT
  15. We thank You Jesus for blessing the people of Colorado with the opportunity to accept Jesus and be alive together with Him as it is written in Colossians 2:13 “ And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses.”
  16. We bless Coloradans as they chose to forgive others and learn the Fear of the Lord as written in Psalms 130:3-4 NLT “Lord, if you kept a record of our sins, who, O Lord, could ever survive? But you offer forgiveness, that we might learn to fear you.”
