Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24-hour Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
Set yourself apart from distractions.
Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.



3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: "Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members. Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- · loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. Matt. 22:37
- · knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. Eph. 3:17-19
- · now comes to a saving faith in Christ. II Tim. 3:14-15
- · allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. Phil. 2:13
- · earnestly seeks God. Ps. 63:1
- · loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.-Ps.122:1
- · deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. Ps. 51:1-4
- · submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. Jas. 4:7-10
- · knows and loves God's Word. Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- · is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- · Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- · Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- · Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- · Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- · Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- · God builds the House and has His way there.
- · Church members keep, guard and protect God's work.
- · Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- · The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- · Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- · Leaders put God's desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways." (NKJ)

Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6) Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society.



Colorado Prays Ministry PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We thank God for the 55+ participating churches and groups statewide that are covering every day of the year in non-stop prayer (except for the 5th Mondays)! We praise You, Holy Spirit, for helping to build this Colorado wall of prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20)!!!
- 2. We pray for favor with church and ministry leaders as we are now actively making calls to add 35+ churches in each of the 64 counties across all of Colorado (over 2200 churches statewide). We call in churches of every denomination, ethnicity and generation to engage in a Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch.
- 3. We ask, Lord, for an Advocate in each county who will help engage the pastors in their area.
- 4. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch so that there are no gaps in the Prayer Wall.
- 5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
- 6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need an administrator, a Wix web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
- 7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
- 8. We pray for favor and discernment as Colorado Prays rolls out Cover The County which hosts a regularly-scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado county while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer (eight counties are currently covered).

Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

- 1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
- 2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado—that God's love and peace now reign in our state.
- 3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
- 4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
- 5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
- 6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women now choose life for their babies.
- 7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
- 8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
- 9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
- 10. God's love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
- 11. The pattern of "taking offense" to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.



COVID-19 PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We thank You, Jesus, that the death rate from COVID-19 is so very low nationwide.
- 2. We ask, Lord God, that herd immunity kick in now considering the increasing number of people who have contracted COVID-19 and those who have been vaccinated.
- 3. We declare that fear, panic, chaos and distortion of truth regarding COVID-19 now cease in Colorado as we receive and exude the peace of God which surpasses all understanding because our God is not a god of disorder but of peace. (Phil 4:7, 1Cor 14:33)
- 4. We declare that people across Colorado now set their mind, will and emotions to focus on whatsoever is pure, whatsoever is lovely, whatsoever is of good report, whatsoever is of virtue and everything that can be praised to show the perfect love of Jesus which casts out all fear. (Phil 4:8, 1 John 4:18)
- 5. We declare that our God is able to make all grace abound to us so that in all things, at all times, we have all that we need (food, medication and supplies) and that there is now coming an economic resurgence as God meets all our needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. (2Cor 9:8, Phil 4:19)
- 6. We declare that the evil which has been intended to harm us will now be used by our God for His good will and purpose in our lives and in the life of THE CHURCH of Colorado. (Gen 50:20)
- 7. We declare spiritual protection, supernatural stamina and perfect health over every healthcare worker throughout Colorado...let the full armor of God surround each worker to fully repel the COVID-19 virus or any other communicable disease. (Acts 10:38, Mark 16:18, 1 John:1:9, Jas 5:16, 3)
- 8. We pray for divine revelation and wisdom for treatments and cures for the COVID-19 virus and other serious diseases. (2Kings 20:7, Is. 38:21, Jer. 8:22)

Topical Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

"Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)"



GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare our state motto: 'Nothing without Providence'; that the perfect will of the Lord to come forth for the state of Colorado.
- 2. We decree that man makes his plans, but the Lord establishes his steps over every person in every form of government at the state and local level.
- 3. We lift our Governor before You, Lord, and we ask for a "Damascus road experience" for him and for those around him.
- 4. We declare that Governor Polis will receive "truth in his inward parts" and that no occult deception will be able to control him in any way because, "Whom the son sets free is free indeed."
- 5. In the Name of Jesus, we put the enemy on notice that, starting today, the state of Colorado begins its turnaround to righteousness as the bowls of heaven have been filled and they now tip toward the people of Colorado.
- 6. We declare that the Blood of Jesus now establishes "a line in the sand" as we declare that COVID-19 is finished in Colorado and must leave our state now.

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. Father, we repent for not heeding your instructions to seek those things which are above where Christ is, sitting at Your right hand; to set our mind on things above, not on things on the earth. We ask for forgiveness, Father God. (Col 3:1-3; Heb 3:1)
- 2. Jesus, we stand in agreement with Your Word that You are our Prince of Peace, that You are our Peace. May we, Your Church throughout Colorado, walk in peace and let the peace of God rule in our hearts. (Isa 9:6; Eph 4:14; Col 3:15)
- 3. May we, Your Bride, come into alignment with Heaven that You are not the author of disorder, chaos, and confusion, but of peace. O, God of Hope, fill us will all joy and peace. (I Cor 14:33; Rom 15:33; II Thess 3:16)
- 4. Author of the Universe, forgive us of forgetting that our thoughts are not Your thoughts, nor are our ways Your ways. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are Your ways higher than our ways, and Your thoughts than our thoughts. May Your Bride in Colorado humbly receive Your rebuke. (Isa 55:8-9)
- 5. Righteous Judge, if the world cannot find love, joy, and peace in the Church (we, Your Purchased Ones), where are they going to find love, joy and peace? (Gal 5:22; Matt 5:9; Il Cor 13:11; Phil 4:9; Rom 14:19; Eph 6:23; James 3:18; John 14:27)
- 6. We call forth the answer to the prayer of Jesus in John 17 regarding the Church of Colorado, Lord; let them be one and we are one.



FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We pray that husbands and wives across Colorado now be united in their one flesh which breaks down any walls of separation or conflict. (Isa 22:5)
- 2. We pray for complete restoration of the finances of every Colorado family, securing their future prosperity.
- 3. We pray that the Lord will now renew dreams and visions for couples and their families across Colorado.
- 4. We declare Psalm 91 over every Colorado marriage covenant and over their homes.
- 5. We pray for spiritual and physical protection for husbands and wives, mothers and fathers and every child in every Colorado home, that no weapon formed against them shall prosper. (Isa 54:17)
- 6. We pray for protection against, and healing from, the ever-decreasing COVID-19 virus throughout Colorado.
- 7. We pray that the love of Jesus Christ now pervades every Colorado home to overshadow and eliminate abuse of any kind.
- 8. We pray that couples across Colorado now get a revelation of the need for, and are motivated to, pray together as one flesh for each other, for their family and for the needs of others.

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

- 1. We pray for a statewide flood of appreciation, honor, respect and gratitude for all first responders.
- 2. We pray Psalm 91 over our first responders, that God is their refuge and their fortress who saves them from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
- 3. We ask, Lord God, that every non-believing first responder in Colorado now has an encounter with the living God, leading them to receive Jesus as their Savior.
- 4. We declare that every Colorado first responder walks in the light of Jesus and is supernaturally protected and consistently functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings so that not one is taken off guard or injured in any way this year.
- 5. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every work day with no repercussions from leadership or any outside entity.
- 6. We declare that every prison and jail in Colorado now manifests God's presence with such intensity that each person inside is miraculously healed and has perfect clarity regarding their identity in Christ Jesus bringing their emotions and actions in alignment with God's will.
- 7. We declare that all corruption and unrighteous behavior among Colorado law enforcement now be exposed and brought to justice.
- 8. We declare that every Colorado first responder is endowed with great stamina and is protected emotionally from the stress of the job.



ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare that Colorado is now a safe harbor for God's Truth. That His truth is the foundation on which the people of God and his Church ground themselves in these days. I Tim 3:15, Ps 18:2, John 1:5
- 2. We proclaim that the story to be told from the Arts and Entertainment Mountain throughout Colorado now points to, and brings all glory to, God! His kingdom endures forever! In this hour may the story of salvation and deliverance echo through His church and may people find hope and peace in the plans of God made known to man in this region. Ps 145:13, 2Thess. 3:1
- 3. We declare that the Church across Colorado is now preparing for a great harvest of souls as our God calls faithful laborers to attention, giving them clarity of purpose and mission. Let them serve faithfully within God's Kingdom and deliver His unwavering message from the mountaintops. Luke 10:2, Matt. 6:10, Matt 9:38
- 4. We proclaim that hearers of the Word across Colorado now discern the times according to the Word of God; those with ears to hear, let them now hear with accuracy.
- 5. We declare that there is now greater understanding and clarity of God's Kingdom within the arts and entertainment sphere which provides an aerial view of His Kingdom far and wide.
- 6. We declare that more and more people working in arts and entertainment across Colorado now serve only the One True God with the promise that they will not bow to any false idols. Matt 16:3, Matt 11:15, 2 Thess 2, Deut 5:6-9

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We declare that our God's anger will not relent until He has carried out His most fervent plans for people in media across Colorado and this nation. (Jer 30:22-24 AMP) "And as before, you will be My people, and I will be your God. Behold, the storm of the Eternal's wrath will now break open, swirling down out of the sky like a whirlwind onto the heads of the wicked."
- 2. Lord God Almighty, we thank You that You reign and rule over the Media Mountain as the Most High God who is faithful and Your goodness is great.
- 3. We thank You, Lord God, that in Your wrath You remember mercy for the people of Colorado who have been deceived by the narrative of the media; set them free, Lord God.
- 4. We ask, Lord God, that You stretch out Your strong arm and mighty hand across our state to release the love of Jesus which completely displaces the influence of demonic powers and principalities and replaces the lies and deceptions with Your Truth (Jesus Christ).
- 5. Lord, let Your Kingdom come over the Colorado Media Mountain and Your Will be done over the people. Let Your great love be their portion.
- 6. We thank You for the harvest, Lord God. We ask that You loose Your mercy and kindness so the people of Colorado may encounter You and accept Your plan of salvation for them.
- 7. We praise You and thank You, Lord, for You are good and Your mercy endures forever.



FDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We ask, Lord, that every Colorado school be empowered and supported to fulfil its purpose to efficiently and effectively educate our children.
- 2. We declare that every Colorado student now has the support and resources needed to be successful with the teaching they receive, whether it be in person or online.
- 3. We ask for godly friendships for every school-aged child in Colorado.
- 4. We ask for a supernatural download of godly love and social skills, which eliminate bullying, loneliness, and hopelessness, for every Colorado child.
- 5. We pray for godly wisdom and guidance for parents seeking new ways to provide for their child's education.
- 6. We declare an infusion of hope and encouragement for college students who are uncertain about their education and their future due to COVID-19.

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

- 1. We decree to Colorado marketplace believers: "Give us this day our daily bread and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors." (Matt. 6:12)
- 2. We decree to Colorado marketplace believers: "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility, value others above yourselves." (Phill.2:3).
- 3. We decree that each Colorado Marketplace Minister will now do everything in love. (1Cor.16:14)
- 4. We decree that each Colorado Marketplace Minister now be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. (Rom.12:10)
- 5. We decree to Colorado marketplace believers:"...as it is written: 'What no eye has seen, what no ear has heard, and what no human mind has conceived' the things God has prepared for those who love him..." (1Cor.2:9).
