Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

## PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

## 1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

## 2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. *He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.*

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

### 3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

### 4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

### 5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

### 6. PRAYER POINTS

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God’s will according to Job 22:28: “You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways.” (NKJ)

Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6) Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society.

## Colorado Prays **Ministry PRAYER POINTS:**

1. We thank God for the 55+ participating churches and groups statewide that are covering every day of the year in non-stop prayer (except for the 5<sup>th</sup> Mondays)! We praise You, Holy Spirit, for helping to build this Colorado wall of prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20)!!!
2. We pray for favor with church and ministry leaders as we are now actively making calls to add 35+ churches in each of the 64 counties across all of Colorado (over 2200 churches statewide). We call in churches of every denomination, ethnicity and generation to engage in a Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch.
3. We ask, Lord, for an Advocate in each county who will help engage the pastors in their area.
4. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch so that there are no gaps in the Prayer Wall.
5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need an administrator, a Wix web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
8. We pray for favor and discernment as Colorado Prays rolls out Cover The County which hosts a regularly-scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado county while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer (eight counties are currently covered).

## Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado– that God’s love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God’s love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women now choose life for their babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God’s love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of “taking offense” to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

## COVID-19 PRAYER POINTS:

1. We thank You, Jesus, that the death rate from COVID-19 is so very low nationwide – 2.66% (220K deaths out of 8.26M cases). Nearly 98% of people fully recover from COVID-19.
2. We ask, Lord God, that herd immunity kick in now considering the increasing number of people who have contracted COVID-19 and those who have been vaccinated.
3. We declare that fear, panic, chaos and distortion of truth regarding COVID-19 now cease in Colorado as we receive and exude the peace of God which surpasses all understanding because our God is not a god of disorder but of peace. (Phil 4:7, 1Cor 14:33)
4. We declare that people across Colorado now set their mind, will and emotions to focus on whatsoever is pure, whatsoever is lovely, whatsoever is of good report, whatsoever is of virtue and everything that can be praised to show the perfect love of Jesus which casts out all fear. (Phil 4:8, 1 John 4:18)
5. We declare that our God is able to make all grace abound to us so that in all things, at all times, we have all that we need (food, medication and supplies) and that there is now coming an economic resurgence as God meets all our needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. (2Cor 9:8, Phil 4:19)
6. We declare that the evil which has been intended to harm us will now be used by our God for His good will and purpose in our lives and in the life of THE CHURCH of Colorado. (Gen 50:20)
7. We declare spiritual protection, supernatural stamina and perfect health over every healthcare worker throughout Colorado...let the full armor of God surround each worker to fully repel the COVID-19 virus or any other communicable disease. (Acts 10:38, Mark 16:18, 1 John:1:9, Jas 5:16, 3)
8. We pray for divine revelation and wisdom for treatments and cures for the COVID-19 virus and other serious diseases. (2Kings 20:7, Is. 38:21, Jer. 8:22)

## Topical Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

## GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We decree Shalom - the Peace of the Lord -over our state legislature. Shalom means that nothing is missing, nothing lacking, total, complete, whole, authority over the chaos!
2. We decree that the Governor will have a Damascus Road experience. We pray for his salvation and his turning to Jesus! We decree if he does not respond to the Lord, that he will receive the mercy of the Lord.
3. We declare that our state is now FREE FROM COVID....in all its forms! We decree the Blood of Jesus covers all infirmities and heals all! By HIS stripes we are HEALED!
4. We declare that the Body of Christ in Colorado now wakes up, unites and become active and involved in the coming Awakening! Let them take their place as the government of God in our state....THE EKKLESIA RISING!~

## CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. Father, we repent for not heeding your instructions to seek those things which are above where Christ is, sitting at Your right hand; to set our mind on things above, not on things on the earth. We ask for forgiveness, Father God. (Col 3:1-3; Heb 3:1)
2. Jesus, we stand in agreement with Your Word that You are our Prince of Peace, that You are our Peace. May we, Your Church, walk in peace and let the peace of God rule in our hearts. (Isa 9:6; Eph 4:14; Col 3:15)
3. May we, Your Bride, come into alignment with Heaven that You are not the author of disorder, chaos, and confusion, but of Peace. O God of Hope, fill us with all joy and peace. (I Cor 14:33; Rom 15:33; II Thess 3:16)
4. Author of the Universe, forgive us of forgetting that our thoughts are not Your thoughts, nor are our ways Your ways. For as the heavens are higher than the earth, so are Your ways higher than our ways, and Your thoughts than our thoughts. May we humbly receive Your rebuke. (Isa 55:8-9)
5. Righteous Judge, if the world cannot find love, joy, and peace in the Church (we, Your Purchased Ones), where are they going to find love, joy and peace? (Gal 5:22; Matt 5:9; II Cor 13:11; Phil 4:9; Rom 14:19; Eph 6:23; James 3:18; John 14:27)

### FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray that husbands and wives across Colorado get a revelation of the need, and are motivated to pray together as one flesh for each other, for their family and for the needs of others.
2. We declare Psalm 91 over every Colorado marriage covenant and over their homes.
3. We pray for spiritual and physical protection for husbands and wives, mothers and fathers and every child in every Colorado home.
4. We pray for protection against, and healing from, the onslaught of the COVID 19 virus throughout Colorado.
5. We pray for complete restoration of the finances of every Colorado family, securing their future prosperity.
6. We pray that the love of Jesus Christ now pervades every Colorado home to overshadow and eliminate abuse of any kind.

### FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. We pray for a statewide flood of appreciation, honor, respect and gratitude for all first responders.
2. We pray Psalm 91 over our first responders, that God is their refuge and their fortress who saves them from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence.
3. We ask, Lord God, that every non-believing first responder in Colorado now has an encounter with the living God, leading them to receive Jesus as their Savior.
4. We declare that every Colorado first responder walks in the light of Jesus and is supernaturally protected and consistently functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings so that not one is taken off guard or injured in any way.
5. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every work day with no repercussions from leadership or any outside entity.
6. We declare that every prison and jail in Colorado now manifests God's presence with such intensity that each person inside is miraculously healed and has perfect clarity regarding their identity in Christ Jesus which eliminates all illness, anger, bitterness, intolerance, violence and gender confusion.
7. We declare that all corruption and unrighteous behavior among Colorado law enforcement now be exposed and brought to justice.
8. We declare that every Colorado first responder is endowed with great stamina and is protected emotionally from the stress of the job.

## ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

We declare Prov 16:9 as we believe for an awakening of Your plans, Lord God, in our hearts and minds!

1. Thank You for centering our purpose and will on Yours so we may walk securely with You in these unique days.
2. We declare Ps 84:11 to draw people back to You, Lord God, as our Sun and Shield in Colorado arts and entertainment. We ask for favor and honor for those who walk in righteousness and integrity. May the Arts and Entertainment Mountain in Colorado demonstrate the grace and glory of our Lord shining upon us as we return to him.
3. We declare a release of supernatural peace through the Colorado Arts and Entertainment Mountain. May all narratives, songs, visual and aural art forms carry the Lord's presence into the hearts of believers and in seekers, creating a response of hope, rest and trust.
4. We declare Dan 9:19 as we speak, "Lord, listen! Lord, forgive! Lord, hear and act! For your sake, my God, do not delay, because Your city and Your people bear your Name," across Colorado.
5. We command confusion and fear to leave the people of God across Colorado. May there be clarity of what HIStory is writing in this season. Let the scribes and historians write with "Ps 45:1 Kingdom perspective" and give them wisdom in this hour as they discern and describe the times through art and entertainment for generations to come.
6. Let every person in Colorado arts and entertainment perform their art with boldness and confidence of 2 Tim 1:7: For the Spirit God gave us does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline.

## MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that Jesus is Lord over the Colorado Media mountain; let His Kingdom come and His Will be done statewide.
2. We declare Ps 4:24 over Colorado media - that it will be used to proclaim that the Sovereign Lord made the heavens, the earth and the sea, and everything in them.
3. We declare that every form of media across Colorado now comes into alignment with our God's Truth.
4. We declare that Colorado media will be used to spread the gospel, that at the Name of Jesus, every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord.
5. We declare, "Let there be light," so that the Kingdom of light now destroys the kingdom of darkness over the media mountain by the power of the Holy Spirit's fire to melt like wax. (Genesis 1:3, Nahum 1:5-8, Heb. 11:3)
6. We declare that the media mountain will broadcast praise to our God and Savior, Who alone is wise. To Him be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forevermore. Amen. (Jude 25)

## EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. We ask, Lord, that every Colorado school be empowered and supported to fulfil its purpose to efficiently and effectively educate our children.
2. We declare that every Colorado student now has the support and resources needed to be successful with the teaching they receive, whether it be in person or online.
3. We ask for godly friendships for every school-aged child in Colorado.
4. We ask for a supernatural download of godly love and social skills for every Colorado child which eliminates bullying, loneliness, and hopelessness.
5. We pray for godly wisdom and guidance for parents seeking new ways to provide for their child's education.
6. We declare an infusion of hope and encouragement for college students who are uncertain about their education and their future due to COVID-19.

## MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We decree Col 3:12 over the marketplace, that Colorado business owners would clothe themselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
2. We decree Rom 12:16, that each Marketplace Minister will live in harmony with one another, will not be proud or haughty or wise in their own sight, but be willing to associate with the lowly.
3. We declare Rom 12:10, that each Market Place Minister will love one another with brotherly affection, honoring one another above themselves.
4. We declare Matt 11: 29-30, that Marketplace Ministers now take the yoke of Jesus upon themselves and learn from Him, for He is gentle and lowly in heart, and there they will find rest for their souls; for His yoke is easy, and His burden is light.
5. We declare Phil 4: 6-7 to all Marketplace Ministers, "Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus."
