WHAT TO PRAY. The prayer points in this digest were revealed to each prayer leader during the monthly prayer time with their team. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in this Digest to guide your prayers for Colorado, Colorado Prays and the Fields of Harvest statewide. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points for Colorado:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed, and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as churches in every city now meet the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted, or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of the Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

Colorado Prays: Ministry Prayer Points:

1. We pray blessings on the 65+ pastors and their churches that each host a monthly Church Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays...let them each continue to complete their 24 hour Prayer Watch each month.
2. We now call forth 30+ Colorado churches in each of the 64 counties to engage in the Church Prayer Watch which will cover every county in non-stop, day and night prayer.
3. We pray for creative ways to engage young people in one or more of the Colorado Prays prayer initiatives or become a social media Prayer Influencer who encourages others to pray for our state.
4. We ask for blessings and favor for someone to join our leadership team to raise up and direct social media Prayer Influencers and someone to guide our fund-raising efforts.
5. We ask, Lord, for three strong leaders to take over the coordination and expansion of the Church Prayer Watch initiative, The Civic Prayer Teams and the Field of Harvest Prayer Teams.
6. We ask, Lord, for new partnerships, strategies and resources to spread the word to Colorado pastors and intercessors about the Church Prayer Watch Initiative, the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams, Kingdom Stewards Network and the Civic Prayer Teams.
7. We ask for protection and wisdom for every Colorado Prays Board member including Amy, Brad, Phil, Brittany, Mark, Kristen and Mike.
8. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Field of Harvest Prayer Team leaders who are laser-focused on each of the Fields of Harvest covered in this Prayer Digest. Protect each of them physically and spiritually Lord God.
9. Bless Kingdom Helpers (Ceasar and Raica) as they provide admin and website support to Colorado Prays. Bless them, Lord, with an abundance of new clients and great prosperity as they help advance the Kingdom of God in the Philippines and here in Colorado.

Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/foh-teams>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. We pray, Lord, for Your mighty hand to hold the fragile ceasefire between Israel and Lebanon, that it becomes true and lasting peace, and that Hezbollah's capacity to wage war against Israel is fully dismantled.
2. We declare, Lord, that your truth about Israel now rises above the noise in every news outlet and on every social media platform, and that you, Lord, will be made known through what is reported.
3. We praise You, Lord, for keeping Your Word by bringing the Jewish people back to the land of Your promise, just as You declared in Jeremiah 29:14, Ezekiel 34:13, Ezekiel 36:24, Isaiah 11:11, and Deuteronomy 30:5. You are a God who does what He says.
4. We thank You, Lord, for the beauty and fruitfulness of the Land of Israel, and declare that what You have planted there no enemy can uproot.
5. We declare blessings over every Christian and Messianic community in Israel, that they go where the Holy Spirit leads, reach the lost of every background, and bear lasting fruit unto salvation.

Colorado Prays for Freedom From Trafficking:

1. We decree that every child trafficking network operating in or through Colorado is now exposed, dismantled, and brought to justice as God's light uncovers every hidden work of darkness
(Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. Ephesians 5:11).
2. We declare divine protection over every child in Colorado, that no child is lured, exploited, or stolen from their God-given purpose, for the Lord commands His angels to guard them in all their ways
(For He will command His angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways. Psalm 91:11).
3. We ask, Lord, for wisdom, courage, and discernment for parents, schools, churches, and law enforcement to recognize, prevent, and stop trafficking before it starts.
(If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you James 1:5).
4. We pray freedom for every child trapped in exploitation, that every captive is now rescued, restored, and healed as justice prevails across our state.
(The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me... to proclaim freedom for the captives. Isaiah 61:1)
5. We thank You, Lord, that Colorado now becomes a place of safety where children are protected, traffickers face justice, and Your presence overcomes every work of the enemy.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. We declare that our God now aligns, orders, and establishes every aspect of Colorado government.
2. We declare that every ungodly power grab attempt in our government is now squelched so that victory goes to the Godly at every level of government.
3. We declare a great shaking of every believer planted in government to re-establish their firm foundation in Christ and re-align each one with their function and purpose in the Kingdom of God.
4. We declare that God's Righteousness now be established throughout the Colorado government and justice now comes forward regarding the integrity of our elections.
5. We thank You, Lord, that You are building the spiritual house known as Colorado - stone by stone, city by city, for Your glory and government with no place left for the enemy.

Colorado Prays for the ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT:

1. We declare that every Colorado artist who loves the Lord now steps fully into a season of abundance, that their creative work prospers and their God-given gifts are in high demand across our state and beyond.
2. Lord, we ask for a fresh outpouring of divine inspiration and revelation upon every craftsman and artist in Colorado — that new ideas, new expressions, and new creative breakthroughs now flow freely from Your Spirit.
3. We thank You, Lord, for the gift of celebration in our land and ask that every expression of art and entertainment that honors You this season would reach and stir the hearts of Colorado families.
4. We call forth Colorado's creative community to rise as fierce guardians of God's truth, standing boldly against every force that targets our children and families.
5. We decree that every Colorado believer with a creative gift now rises without hesitation, reclaiming arts and entertainment as holy ground for the glory of God.

Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. We pray that every Colorado believer in the marketplace carries a heart for souls, knowing God desires all people to be saved and come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Timothy 2:3–4).
2. We declare that every believer in Colorado's workplaces lets their light shine so brightly that the good works bring glory to our Father in heaven (Matthew 5:16).
3. We pray that every Colorado believer walks in wisdom toward those outside the faith, speaking words that are gracious and seasoned with salt in every workplace encounter (Colossians 4:5–6).
4. We declare that the fruit of righteousness now springs up across Colorado's marketplace and that wisdom that comes from God flows through every believer in every industry (Proverbs 11:30).
5. We call believers across Colorado to open their eyes to see that the harvest fields are already white for harvest and ask you Lord, for the Spirit-led urgency to share the gospel to those around them (John 4:35).

Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. Lord, we thank You for the hunger for revival rising among Colorado's young people, and we pray for more revival gatherings to be held in our state.
2. Lord, we pray that you raise up a new generation of pastors in Colorado who will have the burden to win their cities for Your Kingdom.
3. We declare that every attempt to silence faith-based voices in Colorado through legislation, lawsuits, or financial threat now fails, for no weapon formed against Your Church shall prosper. (Isaiah 54:17)
4. We pray for great favor for the expansion of the Ignite Colorado in Brighton initiative, that more churches now choose to host a Life on Purpose conference and/or invite their congregation to attend one to train and equip more believers to be day to day Kingdom Laborers everywhere they go.

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. We pray for the Pueblo workers and families who face an uncertain future as the coal energy plants' future is decided, and we ask that You make a way for that community, Lord.
2. We declare that Colorado's energy supply becomes stable this summer and that every gap in power capacity is covered by Your sovereign hand, turning what seems like a crisis into testimony of Your faithfulness.
3. Father, we ask that You guide the leaders and engineers at Xcimer Energy in Denver as they press toward commercial fusion power, and that every breakthrough in that facility ultimately serves the people of this state and glorifies Your holy name.
4. We pray that every agreement being made to build new transmission lines across the West is tested by godly wisdom.

Colorado Prays for MEDIA:

1. As Colorado's public broadcasters merge their businesses under financial pressure, we ask that their mission to report the news with truth now grows stronger, not weaker, through every merger.
2. We pray, Lord, that you give Colorado journalists the courage and boldness to fight back against the flood of deepfakes and AI lies that have been invading the airwaves and social media posts, especially during the election season.
3. Lord, we pray that truth-telling journalists, whose work keeps Colorado communities informed and held accountable, are protected from budget cuts and AI automation replacements.
4. We pray for truth-tellers to rise up in journalism across Colorado's Western Slope and that the new Western Colorado Journalism Foundation bears much fruit for God's Kingdom.

Colorado Prays for MUSLIMS:

1. We pray that any ungodly Muslim vote carries no viable power or influence in State politics.
2. We ask, Lord, that more Christians now pray and take a stand in local county commissioner and city council meetings regarding mosques and training centers being built, that teach and encourage Muslims to not integrate into American culture, ignoring US laws and customs while following Sharia law.
3. We ask that Godly intercessors now join as one, asking God to cover local mosques and training centers with the Glory of God.
4. We pray that more Believers have the boldness and confidence to lovingly share the Gospel of the Kingdom with Muslims statewide.

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. Lord, we ask You to send Your favor over every pro-life event and rally in Pueblo and Fort Collins, and open doors with churches, Pregnancy Resource Centers, and local pro-life organizations in every community where abortion is taking place.
2. We pray for Kristy Neely and the Colorado pro-life coalition; Lord, please hold them together, sharpen their shared direction, and keep every person involved hungry for what You are doing.
3. We ask that the new Family Research Council initiative stirs believers in churches across Colorado to pray and vote with purpose and conviction.
4. We ask for great favor for the teams that are collecting signatures to get a measure on the ballot to overturn Amendment 79 that abortion no longer be a constitutional right.

Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. Lord, we ask for Your healing and hope to come into the homes of Colorado families to improve youth mental health and decrease suicide cases in our State.
2. We cry out for the children in Colorado's foster care system and ask You, Lord, to raise up more families to open their hearts and homes especially to children with special needs.
3. We thank You, Lord, for every Colorado child reunited with their family and ask for more caseworkers, foster families, and community partners to keep that work moving forward.
4. We declare that fentanyl's grip on Colorado families is broken right now, and we ask, Lord, for a wall of protection around every child in a home where prescription drugs are present.

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. We ask, Lord, that every Colorado First Responder begins each shift by giving that day to You, trusting the Holy Spirit to lead them into every situation they will face.
2. We declare that the Holy Spirit now works through every first responder, turning their prayers into action, and their instincts into answers for the people who need them most.
3. We pray that You give each first responder clear thinking under pressure and wisdom that gets the job done, even when there is no obvious way forward.
4. We declare that every Colorado first responder goes forth in the strength of Christ, knowing He is enough for everything they will face every day. (Philippians 4:13).

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. Lord, we pray that the new cellphone-free school environment now becomes fertile ground for focus, restored attention, and deeper connection among Colorado students and teachers.
2. Father, we ask that every Colorado family now walking away from public schools in favor of homeschooling finds godly community, truth-filled education, and Your presence guiding every lesson.
3. We cry out for every rural Colorado classroom still operating without a fully qualified teacher, and ask you, Lord, to raise up faithful educators for every empty seat.
4. Lord, we ask that every Colorado scholarship reaching students in high-needs fields is matched with calling and purpose, so that careers built with state investment are also built on Kingdom foundations.
