Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Do not address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in this Digest to guide your prayers for Colorado, Colorado Prays and the Fields of Harvest statewide. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to declare God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for You; so light will shine on Your ways." (NKJ)

Core Prayer Points for Colorado:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. We declare, in faith, that every person in Colorado now comes to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. We declare that confusion, depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicide among kids, teens and adults now end in Colorado; that God's love and joy now reign in our state.
3. We declare that domestic violence now ends in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. We declare that drug abuse and addictions in Colorado are now overcome by the Blood of the Lamb.
5. We declare that drug cartels and demonic cults in Colorado are now uncovered, taken down and brought to justice.
6. We declare that abortion now ends in Colorado as ungodly laws are reversed, and women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. We declare that child trafficking, sex trafficking and all forms of human trafficking in, or through, Colorado are now uncovered and dismantled with every perpetrator brought to justice and every victim restored to health.
8. We declare that community violence and crime now cease in every Colorado county.
9. We declare that anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens are now overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
10. We declare that homelessness is resolved as churches in every city now meet the needs of those who are on the streets, addicted, or suffering from mental illness.
11. We declare that God's love now overshadows and overwhelms racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
12. We declare that the pattern of "taking offense" is now overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.
13. We declare that the hearts of the people of the Church in Colorado are now healed and set free from busyness allowing us to focus on bringing in the harvest for God's Kingdom.
14. We call forth churches across Colorado of every ethnic group and denomination to join together, as one, for the advancement of God's Kingdom.

1. We thank God that the Church Prayer Watch in Brighton is expanding....there are now 5 churches engaged every month! Fields of Harvest Prayer Points

The fields are ripe for harvest! The following prayer points address societal fields of harvest with biblically sound prayers. They are written each month by the leaders of the Fields of Harvest Prayer Teams. You can join any of these teams from our website at <https://www.coprays.org/foh-teams>. Feel free to use some, or all, of the prayer points or simply pray for the topic as the Holy Spirit leads you.

Colorado Prays for the MEDIA:

1. We decree that Colorado media now honors the true meaning of Christmas by celebrating the birth of our Savior Jesus Christ. We declare that media outlets across our state reject secular messaging and commercialism, choosing instead to proclaim with boldness the good news that "unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given" (Isaiah 9:6).
2. We declare that Colorado news anchors, reporters, and journalists now receive supernatural courage to report truth without fear. We pray they resist pressure to distort facts or push false narratives, and that their integrity becomes a testimony that draws others to Christ.
3. We declare that end-of-year media coverage in Colorado now reflects God's goodness and faithfulness rather than fear, division, or despair.
4. We humbly ask, Lord, that You release a fresh anointing upon Christian media ministries across Colorado this December. Grant them exponential growth in reach and influence, divine favor with platforms and distributors, and abundant financial provision to close out 2025 strong and launch into 2026 with momentum for Your glory.

Colorado Prays for the MARKETPLACE:

1. We decree 1 Corinthians 10:31 over every worker and business owner in Colorado: "Therefore, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God." We declare that every person in the Colorado marketplace now does their work unto the Lord, bringing Him glory in all they do.
2. We call forth every Colorado business leader and worker to cry out to the Lord as it is written in Jeremiah 33:3: "Call to Me, and I will answer you, and show you great and mighty things, which you do not know." We pray that the Holy Spirit now reveals divine strategies and breakthroughs to Colorado businesses.
3. We decree Psalm 5:12 over the righteous in the Colorado marketplace: "For You, O LORD, will bless the righteous; with favor You will surround him as with a shield." We declare that God's favor now surrounds and protects every believer working in Colorado.
4. We decree Revelation 3:8 over Colorado businesses and workers: "I have set before you an open door, and no one can shut it." We declare that God now opens doors of opportunity that no one can shut for every person who keeps His word and has not denied His name in the marketplace.
5. We decree James 1:5 over every person who works in Colorado: "If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him." We pray that every Colorado worker and leader now asks God for wisdom and receives it liberally for every decision they make.

Colorado Prays for the FAMILY:

1. We pray for the release of boldness over the Church of Colorado to fight for families. We declare that we will not be held back or held under in any way in bringing the Kingdom of Heaven to earth in our state.
2. We declare God's peace and calm now covers the Body of Christ and every Colorado school. We pray for divine protection over children, parents, and staff statewide, and for the Bride of Christ across our state.
3. We ask for forgiveness where the Church has been silent or absent in standing against abortion, and we pray for mercy for the unborn. In the name of Jesus, we call for the closure of all Planned Parenthood and late-term abortion clinics in Colorado.
4. We pray for renewed love for orphans in the hearts of Colorado believers. We ask, Lord, that Your Church now stands up for those who need us most and that families across our state open their hearts and homes to children in need.
5. We declare that every Colorado family now experiences the peace of God which surpasses all understanding, guarding their hearts and minds in Christ Jesus. Lord, allow the healing of hearts and soundness of mind to permeate every home.

Colorado Prays for ENERGY:

1. We pray for divine awakening among Colorado energy executives and decision-makers. We declare that hearts hardened by greed now melt before Jesus, and that those in power surrender to Christ and lead with righteousness.
2. We decree that Colorado energy companies now recognize and honor believing employees for their integrity and excellence. We pray that Christ-followers receive favor and promotion as the year closes.
3. We humble ourselves and ask, Lord, that You raise up prayer warriors in every Colorado energy workplace. We declare that believers be moved to gather to pray during breaks, share Scripture boldly, and spread the Gospel.
4. Today, we declare breakthrough innovation in Colorado's energy sector that advances prosperity and stewardship. We ask for God's divine wisdom to be released to engineers and policymakers who develop solutions that fuel our state while honoring Your creation.

Colorado Prays for GOVERNMENT:

1. We declare that a mighty groundswell of God's righteousness now arises in every Colorado government leader. We ask, Lord, for the release of Your justice for every ICE detainee in Colorado.
2. We pray, Lord God, that every leader, at every level of Colorado government, now has an encounter with the Living God which causes them to align with the Word of God in every decision they make.
3. We ask, Lord, that the Presence of the Holy Spirit now be obviously manifested and acknowledged in every government meeting statewide, especially during the Christmas Season.
4. We ask Lord that You now embolden the Ecclesia across Colorado to understand and embrace their role in the spirit realm to govern, rule and reign as God's ambassadors in their community.
5. We declare a shift in focus for the people of Colorado; with less focus on government issues and more focus on Kingdom issues.

Colorado Prays for LIFE:

1. We call upon ELOHIM, Creator, Mighty and Strong. We pray that God now reveals Himself through Christmas celebrations across Colorado and draws every abortion worker into repentance and new life in Christ. Through His power and might, we declare an end to abortion in our state.
2. We call upon ADONAI, our Lord and Master. As we stand for Truth and the sanctity of life, we now submit to God's authority, rely on Him alone, and seek His wisdom in all we do. We humble ourselves under His mighty hand (1 Peter 5:6-11).
3. We call upon EL ROI, the God who Sees. We pray, O God, that every Colorado woman who has suffered from abortion that You make them feel seen in their pain and distress, and let each one experience Your presence. You see every baby in the womb, and whatever is done to the least of these is done unto Jesus (Matthew 25:40). Empower us now to save more babies and end abortion.
4. We call upon YAHWEH RAPHA, the Lord who Heals. We pray for every person in Colorado wounded through abortion. Let each one now know Your forgiveness, healing, and freedom.
5. We declare that Your joy and peace now flood their hearts bringing complete restoration. We declare that the battle is the Lord's and the victory is ours in ending abortion in Colorado. Let Your justice roll down like waters and righteousness like an ever-flowing stream across our state (Amos 5:24).

Colorado Prays for FIRST RESPONDERS:

1. Lord, we pray that every Colorado First Responder and their family members draw closer to Jesus this Christmas season as they celebrate the birth of Christ not only as the Christ Child but as their Lord and Savior.
2. We ask, Lord, that You help every First Responder put their complete trust in You for safety and emotional needs.
3. We pray that First Responder families bless each other with love and understanding during the holidays balancing the need to serve others with quality time at home.
4. We ask, Lord, that You give Colorado First Responders sensitivity, wisdom and compassion during the holidays when people can experience stress, disparate family expectations, and depression.
5. We declare a hedge of protection around every First Responder and their family members throughout this Christmas season.

Colorado Prays for the CHURCH:

1. We declare that the Church of Colorado is now disciplined in body, soul and spirit which strengthens their walk with Christ and their effectiveness for His Kingdom.
2. We pray that Colorado believers flourish through excellent, wise work empowered by the grace of God.
3. We pray that Colorado believers now walk in crystal clarity and wholehearted devotion to advancing God's Kingdom, fulfilling the mission God has placed before them with passion and purpose.
4. We declare James 1:12 over every believer in, and from, Colorado, "Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life."
5. In this season of harvest, we ask, Lord God, that You now send forth Your Kingdom Laborers across Colorado emboldened with Your power and fruitfulness.

Colorado Prays for EDUCATION:

1. We decree a spirit of repentance over Colorado universities that have promoted godless ideologies. We pray that professors, administrators, and student leaders now encounter the truth of Jesus Christ and become voices for righteousness on their campuses.
2. We ask Lord God, that Your refreshing power now infuse exhausted educators as the semester ends across Colorado: to renew their calling, restore their passion, and fill them with divine strength to finish strong and return in 2026 with fresh vision.
3. We ask, Lord God, that Colorado college students returning home for Christmas have divine conversations with family members who will speak truth, challenge false teachings, and reignite their faith in Jesus.
4. Lord, we call forth student-led prayer movements in every Colorado high school, college and university which will cause young believers to boldly gather to pray, worship, and seek God, igniting transformational spiritual awakenings which transform schools and reach the lost with the Gospel.
5. We ask, Lord, for more youth pastors and campus ministers across Colorado to receive fresh new downloads of strategies to reach more students who are desperate for hope, causing more Colorado youth groups to explode with new believers hungry for discipleship.

Colorado Prays for ISRAEL:

1. We pray that God gives Israel's leaders supernatural wisdom as they negotiate Gaza's future. We declare that all negotiations now ensure Israel's safety, that the United States stands strong in support of Israel, and that Hamas is disarmed with just and peaceful governance established.
2. We declare strengthening over ministries that build relationships between Jews and Christians and expose anti-Semitism. Let these ministries now thrive and multiply across Colorado and beyond.
3. We declare divine strengthening over Messianic believers and communities in Israel. We ask, Lord, that You now empower their ministries to fellow Israelis and grant them greater acceptance and opportunity to share the love of Messiah Jesus.
4. We declare that the Church now has greater understanding of Israel's irrevocable calling in God's plan of redemption (Romans 11:29). As Paul said, "Has God cast away His people? Certainly not!" (Romans 11:1)
5. We decree an outpouring of the Holy Spirit throughout the Middle East upon Jews, Christians and Muslims. We declare Joel 2:28 over the region: "I will pour out My Spirit upon all flesh, and your sons and daughters will prophesy, and your old men will dream dreams and your young men will see visions."

Colorado Prays for ARTS & ENTERTAINMENT:

1. We declare that the 2027 Sundance Film Festival relocation to Boulder now brings God-honoring independent storytelling and righteous values to Colorado. We pray that unsung talent who glorify the Lord through film, now thrive and receive opportunities to exhibit their inspiring original work.
2. We decree that Colorado is now a spiritual magnet for creative minds producing Godly art. We call forth complete reversal of destructive, indoctrinating entertainment promoting demonic agendas. We pray that Colorado artists now worship God through their creative talents.
3. We declare that idol worship in Colorado arts is now null and void. Lord God, remove every idol from our parks, wilderness areas, and towns.
4. We declare that every demonic influence depicted across our state is now exposed and replaced with God-honoring art. We pray that sculptures and monuments honoring false gods are now removed and that Colorado creates new works that glorify Jesus alone.
5. We declare that inspiring, truthful art now invades every museum, gallery, and theater. We pray that the love of Jesus now transforms Colorado's creative culture.

Colorado Prays for FREEDOM FROM TRAFFICKING:

1. We decree divine protection over every Colorado child this holiday season. We pray that parents receive discernment to recognize danger and keep their children safe from predators and traffickers.
2. We declare breakthrough funding for anti-trafficking organizations across Colorado. We pray that donors give generously, that grants are approved, and that rescue operations and safe houses receive abundant resources to expand their life-saving work.
3. We pray for divine wisdom and strategy for every Colorado rescuer and advocate. We ask, Lord, that You reveal hidden victims, expose trafficking operations, and guide investigations with insight that leads to breakthrough rescues and successful prosecutions.
4. We declare by the authority of Christ that your power will prevail over any plot of the enemy against anti-human trafficking workers.
5. We pray for Colorado legislators to pass powerful anti-trafficking laws in 2026.
