Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: "Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting." Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God's Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God's work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God's desires before their own.

6. INTERCEDE FOR THE 7+ MOUNTAIN PRAYER POINTS

Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways." (NKJ)

Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6) Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Mountains of society.

PRAYER POINTS

Colorado Prays Ministry PRAYER POINTS:

1. We thank God for the 55+ participating churches and groups statewide that are covering every day of the year in non-stop prayer (except for the 5th Mondays)! We praise You Holy Spirit for helping to build this Colorado wall of prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20)!!!
2. We pray for favor with church and ministry leaders as we seek to add 35+ churches in each of the 64 counties across all of Colorado (over 2200 churches statewide). We call in churches of every denomination, ethnicity and generation to engage in a Monthly 24hr Prayer Watch.
3. We ask Lord for an Advocate in each county who will help engage the pastors in their area.
4. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch so that there are no gaps in the Prayer Wall.
5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest AND for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need an Advocate in each city/county to recruit pastors, an administrator, a Wix web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
8. We pray for favor and discernment as Colorado Prays rolls out Cover The County which hosts a regularly scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado County while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer (8 counties are currently covered).

Culture-Wide Prayer Points

Please address the following over-arching issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado– that God's love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women now choose life for their babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy/deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God's love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of "taking offense" to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

COVID-19 PRAYER POINTS

1. We thank You Jesus that the death rate from COVID-19 is so very low nationwide – 2.66% (220K deaths out of 8.26M cases)
2. We declare that the people of Colorado now abide in the wisdom of Solomon and the truth of the Word of God that no adversary (COVID-19 or anything else) will be able to resist or contradict. (Luke 21:15)
3. We declare that fear, panic, chaos and distortion of truth regarding COVID-19 now cease in Colorado as we receive and exude the peace of God which surpasses all understanding because our God is not a god of disorder but of peace. (Phil 4:7, 1Cor 14:33)
4. We declare that people of Colorado now choose to get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice regarding different opinions of how to prevent the spread of COVID-19. (Eph 4:31)
5. We declare that people across Colorado now set their mind, will and emotions to focus on whatsoever is pure, whatsoever is lovely, whatsoever is of good report, whatsoever is of virtue and everything that can be praised to show the perfect love of Jesus which casts out all fear. (Phil 4:8, 1 John 4:18)
6. We declare that God's people across Colorado now listen carefully to the Lord and do what is right in His eyes, paying attention to His commands and keeping all His decrees so that He will not bring on them any disease, including COVID-19, because He is the Lord who heals them. (Exo 15:26)
7. We declare that people across Colorado now hear, see, know and receive the truth of Jesus Christ as their Savior which sets them free from their sin nature. (John 8:32, John 3:16)
8. We declare Psalm 91 over the people of Colorado, our family and our friends worldwide to see each one saved from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence of COVID-19.
9. We declare that our God is able to make all grace abound to us, so that in all things, at all times, we have all that we need (food, medication and supplies) and that there is now coming an economic resurgence as God meets all our needs according to the riches of His glory in Christ Jesus. (2Cor 9:8, Phil 4:19)
10. We declare that the evil which has been intended to harm us will now be used by our God for His good will and purpose in our lives and in the life of THE CHURCH of Colorado. (Gen 50:20)
11. We declare that Christ's peace now rules in our hearts and whatever we do, we will give thanks to God in all things. (Col 3:15-17)
12. We declare Psalm 103:1-5 over the people of Colorado: "Praise the Lord, my soul; all my inmost being, praise His Holy Name. Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all His benefits—who forgives all your sins and heals all your diseases, who redeems your life from the pit and crowns you with love and compassion, who satisfies your desires with good things so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's."
13. We declare spiritual protection, supernatural stamina and perfect health over every healthcare worker throughout Colorado...let the full armor of God surround each worker to fully repel the COVID-19 virus or any other communicable disease. (Acts 10:38, Mark 16:18, 1 John:1:9, Jas 5:16, 3 John 1:2)
14. We pray for divine revelation and wisdom for treatments and cures for the COVID-19 virus and other serious diseases. (2Kings 20:7, Is. 38:21, Jer. 8:22)

Spheres of Influence Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINTS

1. We declare that any and all attempts of voter fraud will now be exposed and brought to justice before the election takes place and immediately thereafter.
2. We declare that every Coloradan registered to vote, actually votes, whether by mail or at the ballot box resulting in double the normal turnout of voters.
3. We declare that the people of every Colorado community stand together AS ONE with local police against any violent rioters to peacefully diffuse emotions and ungodly intentions during the elections.
4. We declare that the people of Colorado are fully protected by our God against any planned violence in our state during the elections.
5. We declare that every Colorado voter casts their votes for candidates and issues that adhere to, and align with, biblical morals and principles.
6. We declare that every legitimate ballot is properly accounted for and accurately counted.

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. Jesus, we, Your Bride, repent for failing to be “salt and light” to the world; Salt preserves and prevents decay, yet we see decay in the world; Light expels darkness, yet we see darkness covering our world; Oh Jesus, we repent and ask for Your forgiveness. (Matt 5:13-16)
2. We call forth Your Ekklesia to stand watch, stand guard, and to stand firm. (Gen 2:15; Job 1:10; Isa 5:5; Eze 13:5; Eze 22:30; Ps 144: 14b; Is 52:8; Jer 6:17; Exe 33:2-7; Eze 3:17; Isa 62:6-7; Isa 21:8; I Cor 16:13; Eph 6:11-14)
3. We shout out a clarion call to Your Church: Wake up; Watch and pray. Rom 13:11; I Thess 5:5-6; Rev 3:2-3; Eph 5:14; Isa 52:1; Isa 60:1-2; Matt 25:5; Lk 21:36; Matt 26:41)
4. We declare that, we, Your people, will heed Paul’s admonition to “devote ourselves to prayer.” (Col 4:2)
5. Every day, we decree that our nation’s capital and every state capital is a “home of justice, and a mountain of holiness.” (Jer 31:23)

FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare Ps 56 over the people and families of Colorado....in God we trust and we will not fear!
2. We declare our God's protection for children while they are in school. Keep them physically safe and emotionally healthy and guard their minds from false gods and ungodly sexual teachings.
3. We ask for an outpouring of the blood of Jesus over marriages to release mercy and grace resulting in a reduction in domestic violence, anger, stress and anxiety.
4. We release love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness and self-control over families statewide.
5. We declare that children across Colorado now honor and respect authority over their lives.
6. We declare that marriages throughout Colorado draw on the strength of David to trust in God as they stand and pray in battle for their families.
7. We declare that children are now protected from abuse and families from all forms of violence in or around the home.

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that the Lord rebuke the spirit of fear among administrators, parents and students across Colorado regarding COVID-19, releasing them from emotional bondage.
2. We declare that every Colorado school is now a COVID-19-free zone filled with love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness and self-control.
3. We release physical healing for every Colorado student, family member, teacher or administrator who is battling with COVID-19 or any other illness.
4. We pray that all young people statewide now stay away from social media sites and online activities that incite bad choices or instill ungodly behavior towards themselves or others. Bullying must now stop in the name of Jesus Christ – especially as more students transition to online learning.
5. We pray for a release of emotional strength, love, hope and joy for anyone associated with Colorado schools who feels fear, anxiety, loneliness or disconnection.
6. We declare that every Colorado student has the support and resources needed to be successful with the teaching they receive whether it be in person or online.
7. We ask for a release of supernatural provision for parents who need childcare during online school sessions so they can go to work.
8. We declare protection, safety and diligence for children left alone during the day, that they will obey the directions from their parents and follow through on the classroom assignments.
9. We pray for provision, employment and unique and legal income opportunities for every Colorado family, so they have no lack of food, water or shelter.

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that righteousness now reigns in the marketplace across Colorado!
2. We declare that the Spirit of Truth now operates in and through marketplace people statewide.
3. We declare: "And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, now guards the hearts and minds of each Colorado Marketplace Minister." Phil 4:7
4. We declare Rom 12:9 over every marketplace person in Colorado: "Let love be without dissimulation (dishonesty or subterfuge). Abhor that which is evil; cleave to that which is good."
5. We declare Ps 143:8 over every Colorado marketplace minister: "Let the morning bring us word of Your unfailing love, for we have put our trust in You." Show each Marketplace Minister the way they should go, for to You, Lord God, we entrust our life.
6. We declare that the financial recovery of every person, and the economy of Colorado, is now supercharged to exponentially rebound from the pandemic shutdowns.

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. Father God, maker of heaven and earth, we declare that You are King over the Media Mountain and everything and everyone in it and ask that You "Do whatever Your Hand and Your purpose determined before to be done." (Ps. 24, Acts 4:23-28).
2. By the Power of the Holy Spirit, the Power of the Blood of Jesus' Cross, and the Power of the Word of God, we declare that the power and effects of the kingdom of darkness manifesting as lies, wickedness, deception and lawlessness are now dismantled and the captives are set free. (Col. 1:20, John 14:12-14)
3. In the wonderful Name of Jesus, our Lord and Liberating King, we believe that everything in heaven and earth is now being brought back to our God—back to its original intent as designed by God especially for everything and everyone in the media mountain as we boldly declare: Your Kingdom come, Your Will be done over Media Mountain enforcing the Lordship of Jesus Christ across our state and nation. (Col. 1:20 TPT, Matthew 6:10)
4. In the wonderful Name of Jesus, we declare "Let there be light over every person in the Media Mountain...light which breaks the power of ungodly principalities and influence over minds and hearts of the people working in media and those influenced by media." (2 Cor.4:4-6, Gen. 1:3)
5. We declare that the Media Mountain will now be used by the King of Glory to save, heal, and restore hurting people through signs, wonders and miracles... that the harvest will come, in all its fullness in this season. (Acts 4:23-28, 1 Cor. 1:9, Eph. 1:2,14)
6. We pray that corruption in political leaders will be further revealed and covered truthfully by the mainstream media and social media companies

HEALTHCARE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray for the immediate exposure and dismantling of drug dealers and their network throughout Colorado so that the opioid epidemic ends in our state.
2. We pray that all corruption and misuse of drug prescriptions by doctors is now exposed and brought to prosecution across Colorado.
3. We ask, Lord, that you awaken every person in Colorado to the need to take charge of their own health by being proactive with healthy eating, exercise and a healthy lifestyle.

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that, across Colorado, the Lord is the only one worthy of praise and that His people now arise to “bring the sacrifice of praise to the house of the Lord! “Hear O Israel! The Lord thy God is ONE God! Psalm 116:17, Deut. 6:4
2. We call forth the Song of the Redeemed in this hour! Let powerful praise erupt in THE CHURCH across Colorado and may the sound of Heaven fill our skies, silencing the lies of the evil one. Rev 15:3, Ps 107:2
3. We declare that the reign of the Prince of Peace now rules and governs all of Colorado and we command earth and heaven alike to acknowledge and respond to His leadership in this hour. - Is. 9:6, Is. 32
4. We declare that the battle and the victory over arts and entertainment in Colorado belong to the Lord! In the face of great assault, we put our hope and trust in the Victorious One! He is our shield and fortress in this hour- may the songs and words written and spoken by the arts and entertainment world ring true of our God’s faithfulness which endures forever! Prov. 21:28-31
5. We declare that today, THE CHURCH of Colorado arises to sing this song in one accord: “Now to Him who is able to keep you from stumbling and to present you blameless before the presence of His glory with great joy, to the only God, our Savior, through Jesus Christ our Lord, be glory, majesty, dominion, and authority, before all time and now and forever. Amen.” Jude 1:24-25

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. We pray for a return to a statewide sense of honor, respect and appreciation for all first responders.
2. We pray Psalm 91 over our first responders, that God is their refuge and their fortress who saves them from the fowler’s snare and from the deadly pestilence.
3. We declare miraculous healing for any person entering a Colorado prison, fire station, police station or sheriff’s office, that they are immediately set free from any form of virus, bacterial infection or disease of any kind.
4. We ask, Lord God, that every non-believing first responder in Colorado now have an encounter with the living God leading them to receive Jesus as their Savior.
5. We declare that every Colorado first responder is supernaturally protected and consistently functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings so that not one is taken off guard or injured in any way.
6. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God’s power, ministering in the name of Jesus every work day with no repercussions from leadership or any outside entity.
7. We declare that every prison and jail in Colorado now manifests God’s presence with such intensity that each person inside has perfect clarity regarding their identity in Christ Jesus which eliminates all illness, anger, bitterness, intolerance, violence and gender confusion.
8. We ask, Lord God, that the jails and prisons of Colorado continue to be effective and efficient in isolating and quarantining the sick so that there is minimal COVID-19 exposure for inmates, deputies, and corrections officers statewide.
9. We declare that all corruption and unrighteous behavior among Colorado law enforcement now be exposed and brought to justice.
10. We pray blessings over prayer warriors who intercede for prisons, jails and everyone associated with them. May the Lord of Heaven’s armies fight for us all.
