TOPIC: Thy Kingdom Come

These Blessing Declarations have been prepared by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement empowering believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to shift the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

THY KINGDOM COME

Through July of this year, we will be releasing Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer. Last month, we focused on "Praise and Adoration" for "Our Father who art in Heaven". This month, we move on to the next phrase "Thy Kingdom Come." These words have become so familiar that believers usually speak them without a thought about their meaning.

The phrase "Thy Kingdom Come" in the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:10) refers to a request that Jesus would take His rightful place in our lives and our state. It is a petition asking God to establish His sovereign rule more fully in the heart of every Coloradan. When prayed earnestly, it expresses our willingness to submit and surrender our own agendas, inviting God the Father, Jesus Christ and Holy Spirit to rule in our lives: "For behold, the Kingdom of God is in your midst." (Luke 17:21) It encourages believers to actively participate in the Kingdom by living out its beliefs, foundational principles and values.

Seeking “Thy Kingdom come” is also a means of inviting God to reveal and make known aspects of His nature – to make manifest His Presence to draw people to Himself: to shine His light into the world so that others may respond to Him with awe and reverence as John the Baptist does in John 1:1–15.

God wants us to experience Him in a deeper way, beyond surface-level faith. You are encouraged to go deeper in your time with the Lord this month to seek God’s Kingdom and His righteousness in your life. Listen for Holy Spirit to speak to you as you proclaim “Thy Kingdom Come.” Be open to a deep walk with The Lord leading to a deep clean. Let God reveal Himself to you, move you to repentance and give you a clean slate. Let deep hope arise in your being causing you to believe deeply in what is promised as God’s Kingdom comes to earth as it is in Heaven.

Blessing Declarations for Feb 14: THY KINGDOM COME

We start by welcoming The King of Glory and His Kingdom to enter into the gates of Colorado.

1. We bless every Coloradan to see and welcome the Kingdom of God as we decree Psalm 24:7: “Lift up your heads, you gates (of Colorado); be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.”
2. We join with believers statewide, as one voice, to shout out our appeal to God based on Matthew 6:10: Lord God, bless us as we declare “Thy Kingdom come on earth as it is in heaven.”
3. Lord God, we welcome the manifestation of Your Kingdom here in Colorado...let us receive and be witnesses of Your Glory as we decree what is written in Daniel 7:18 “...the saints of the Most High shall receive the kingdom, and possess the kingdom forever, even forever and ever.”
4. As written in Revelation 11:15, we bless Colorado (the kingdom of this world) “to become the Kingdom of our Lord and of His Messiah, and He will reign for ever and ever”.
5. On behalf of the Colorado Ecclesia, we declare the truth of God’s rulership over our state as written in Psalm 47:7-8 “For God is the King of all the earth; Sing praises with understanding. God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne.”
6. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia to serve the one true God acknowledging His dominion as written in Daniel 7:14: “...to Him was given dominion, Glory and a kingdom, that all the peoples, nations and men of every language might serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion which will not pass away; and His kingdom is one which will not be destroyed.”
7. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with deep understanding that the Kingdom of God is not about a diet of laws and rules. It is a call to righteousness, peace and joy as written in Romans 14:17 “for the kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.”
8. We declare that Colorado believers are now blessed with the desire to align their intentions and actions with God’s Will as written in Matthew 6:33; “But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you.”
9. As written in Psalm 45:6, we join with the Colorado Ecclesia proclaiming God’s rulership over Colorado and His righteousness as our weapon of co-laboring with Him. “Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom.”

10. We bless believers statewide with the revelation presented in Colossians 1:13 AMP "For He has rescued us and has drawn us to Himself from the dominion of darkness and has transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son."
11. As written in Matthew 24:14, we bless believers statewide to boldly proclaim the Gospel of the Kingdom every day to everyone they encounter for "This gospel of the kingdom shall be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all the nations, and then the end will come."
12. We declare the blessings of Ephesians 1:22-23 NLT over the Colorado Ecclesia as we co-labor with Christ to build His Kingdom because "God has put all things under the authority of Christ and has made him head over all things for the benefit of the church. And the church is his body; it is made full and complete by Christ, who fills all things everywhere with himself."
13. In the midst of God's Kingdom on earth, as it is in heaven, we bless Coloradans with the call of John 3:5-7 NLT to be born again. "Jesus replied, "I assure you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God without being born of water and the Spirit. Humans can reproduce only human life, but the Holy Spirit gives birth to spiritual life. So don't be surprised when I say, 'You must be born again.'"
14. We join with all of heaven blessing Coloradans with the knowledge and understanding of the God's headship over all creation as written in 1 Chronicles 29: 11 "Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, The power and the glory, The victory and the majesty; For all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O LORD, And You are exalted as head over all."
15. We bless believers statewide to know and operate in the understanding of Zechariah 4:6 which tells us that the Kingdom of God advances not by human power but by the Spirit of God.
16. As depicted in Mark 4: 30-31, we bless the mustard seeds of the Kingdom of God throughout Colorado to now rapidly grow and expand God's Kingdom from one end of the state to the other.
