TOPIC: **Lead us Not Into Temptation**

These Blessing Declarations are submitted to you by the [Kingdom Stewards Network \(KSN\)](#) which is a statewide prayer movement that empowers believers to speak God's word over their territory (home, neighborhood, church, city, county, etc.). The vision is to stake God's claim for His Kingdom on earth in Colorado as it is in Heaven. It also entails shifting the spiritual atmosphere of every Colorado community so that each region aligns with their redemptive gifts and purposes and more people come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Blessing Saturdays

The mission of each Blessing Saturday is to engage believers in every community to individually (or with friends/family), to speak God's Word over our state. This is in accordance with what is written in Isaiah 55:11, "so is My word that goes out from My mouth: It will not return to me empty but will accomplish what I desire and achieve the purpose for which I sent it."

Instructions:

When? 2nd and 4th Saturdays at 9am

Where? At a location outside.

Preparation: Be sure to spend 10+ minutes praising God and worshipping Him and positioning yourself seated in Christ in heavenly places (Eph 2:6) before speaking the Declarations. Enthroned Jesus as King over yourself and your territory and invite Him to intercede with You today.

How? To be declared out loud with boldness and confidence, on your own or with others.

Pause: Don't rush through the Blessing Declarations. Pause after each one taking time to listen for the Lord's in put regarding anything He might want you to add.

Lead Us Not Into Temptation

We continue to release Blessing Declarations based on the Lord's Prayer in Matthew 6. This month, we will speak blessing declarations addressing the first part of verse 13 which asks **"And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil."** ESV "Lead us not into Temptation" is not a request asking for God not to tempt us, for God does not tempt us as James 1:13 says, "Let no one say when he is tempted, 'I am tempted by God'; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone, but each person is tempted when they are dragged away by their own evil desire and enticed." As we identifying our human vulnerabilities, we see the need for divine guidance in order to overcome the traps and temptations of the enemy. Lead us not into temptation, is asking God for His protections from situations or desires that could lead us away from His will and purposes.

Blessing Declarations June 13: **Lead us Not Into Temptation**

1. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the request of Matthew 6:13a "...lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil."
2. We bless Colorado Believers with Holy Spirit reminders to resist temptation by regularly putting on the Full Armor of God as instructed in Ephesians 6:16-18, "In all circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish all the flaming darts of the evil one; and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, praying at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, making supplication for all the saints."
3. As Coloradans are being faithful to pray during these times, we declare that we are building walls, boundaries, and perimeters of God's protection against temptation as spoken of in Zechariah 2:5, "I will be to her a wall of fire all around"
4. We bless Colorado Believers with great courage to now stand against temptation as recorded in Joshua 1:9, "Have I not commanded You? Be strong and courageous. Do not be frightened, and do not be dismayed, for the Lord your God is with you wherever you go."
5. We bless the people of Colorado with the Zeal of the Lord which removes temptation while bringing justice and righteousness into every sphere of society as written in Isaiah 9:7, "Of the increase of his government and of peace there will be no end, on the throne of David and over his kingdom, to establish it and to uphold it with justice and with righteousness from this time forth and forevermore. The zeal of the Lord of hosts will do this.
6. As written in Genesis 1: 3-4, we receive God's work which is bringing His Light and removing temptation across Colorado. As the scripture reads, "And God said, Let there be light, and there was light. And God saw that the light was good. And God separated the light from the darkness."
7. We declare that the Colorado Ecclesia is blessed to never have to be tempted by revenge as we are admonished in Roman's 12:19, "Beloved, never avenge yourselves, but leave it to the wrath of God, for it is written, 'Vengeance is mine, I will repay, say the Lord.'"
8. We bless the people of Colorado with the comforting protection given to us in Proverbs 2:8, "You guard the paths of justice and watch over the ways of your saints."
9. Lord Jesus, we bless Your Colorado Ecclesia with the experience of John 10:27, "The sheep that are My own hear and are listening to My voice; and I know them, and they follow Me." (AMPC)
10. Lord Jesus, we declare the truth and blessings of 1 Corinthians 10:13 over Your sons and daughters, "No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*."
11. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with the words of Hebrews 2:18 which describe how Christ Jesus was tempted as we are, and how He will be there to help us and lead us in His ways; "For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted."

12. We bless Believers statewide to stand firm against temptation just as Jesus did in Hebrews 4:15, “For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all *points* tempted as *we are*, yet without sin.”
 13. We encourage every Colorado Believer to fervently pray as written in Matthew 26:41, “Watch and pray, lest you enter into temptation. The spirit indeed *is* willing, but the flesh *is* weak.”
 14. We bless every follower of Jesus statewide to endure as it is written in James 1:12, “Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him.
 15. We bless every member of the Colorado Ecclesia with the request Jesus asked of His Father in John 17:15, “I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one.”
 16. Just as King David prayed to God, we declare Psalm 19:13 over His sons and daughters across Colorado. “Keep back Your servant also from presumptuous sins; Let them not have dominion over me. Then I shall be blameless, And I shall be innocent of great transgression.”
 17. We declare 2 Peter 2:9 over the people of Colorado: “The Lord knows how to rescue the godly from trials and to hold the unrighteous for punishment on the day of judgment.”
 18. We bless the Colorado Ecclesia with God’s Word which is a lamp and light unto them as written in Psalm 119:105, “Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path.” (NIV)
 19. We bless the people of God across our state to take heed to Proverbs 4:14-15, “Don’t do as the wicked do, and don’t follow the path of evildoers. Don’t even think about it; don’t go that way. Turn away and keep moving.” (NIV) Instead, seek first the Kingdom of God and His righteousness.
 20. We bless every Coloradan with the wisdom of 2 Timothy 2:22, “Run from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts.” (NIV)
