Overview. This Prayer Digest is designed for use during your prayer time in your church's monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays. The vision for Colorado Prays is to shift the spiritual climate across Colorado to see the godly, sustained transformation of every sphere of society. We do this by calling churches and ministries to a wall of day and night prayer where our God will fight for us (Neh 4:20). Each church or group hosts one Monthly 24-hour Prayer Watch to sustain 24x7 prayer saturation in every Colorado county. Thank you for participating in a Monthly Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays!

Feel free to re-use and forward each Monthly Prayer Digest as you are led.

Source & Tone. Please note that the prayer points for each sphere (or mountain) of society are drafted by different Prayer Trusts (prayer groups with authority in the mountain of society). As a result, the tone and style of prayer may vary from section to section in the Digest.

What to Pray. Regardless of the style differences, the prayer points are what the Lord revealed to each Prayer Trust during their monthly prayer time focused on their sphere/topic. Please pray in agreement as the Lord leads you. Do NOT feel obligated to cover every prayer point in this Digest. Don't address items with which you don't agree. Ask God what is on His heart for your prayer time and focus on the topics He highlights for you.

PREPARATION:

- Get your bible and a notebook/pen.
- Set yourself apart from distractions.
- Play soaking music if that helps you focus on the Lord.

1. ALIGN YOUR MIND WITH GOD'S WORD (Rom 12:2)

2. PRAISE/WORSHIP GOD

Tell God what He means to you and how much you love Him. You may want to sing a worship song. Declare the attributes of God. *He is Jehovah. He is infinite. He is omnipotent. He is good. He is love. He provides. He is peace. He is immutable. He is transcendent. He is just. He is holy. He is our healer. He is omnipresent. He is merciful. He is sovereign. He is our banner. He is wise. He is faithful. He is wrathful. He is full of grace. He is our comforter. He is the Almighty. He is Father. He is the head of the Church. He is our intercessor. He is Master/Lord. He is our strength.*

Personalize Ps 100 as you pray it out loud. Thank Him for how He has operated in your life and answered your prayers. Read Ps 145 out loud.

3. PURIFY YOURSELF / Repent and Reconcile as Needed

Unconfessed sin creates a barrier between you and God hindering the effectiveness of your prayers. (1Pet 3:12). Ask the Lord to show you anything you need to address in yourself that blocks your relationship with Him in any way. Read Psalm 139 out loud. Focus on the final two verses, 23-24: *“Search me, God, and know my heart. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.”* Pray these verses several times then sit quietly waiting for God to reveal anything you may need to work on, resolve, or seek forgiveness for. Reconcile with everyone as needed. Repent for anything the Lord shows you. Forgive anyone and anything that has hurt you in any way – give up being the judge over them (Luke 6:37), give them to Jesus for Him to be their judge and jury.

4. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR FAMILY

Pray for yourself and each family member.

Pray Psalm 119 out loud on behalf of you and your family.

Whether true today or not, pray the following, believing in faith for your children and family members.

Thank you Lord that my child/family member:

- loves God with all his/her heart, mind and soul. – Matt. 22:37
- knows how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ for him/ her. – Eph. 3:17-19
- now comes to a saving faith in Christ. – II Tim. 3:14-15
- allows God to work in his/her life to accomplish His purpose through him/ her. - Phil. 2:13
- earnestly seeks God. – Ps. 63:1
- loves to go to church as an act of love, gratitude and worship to God.–Ps.122:1
- deeply repents as his/her sins are revealed and corrected. – Ps. 51:1-4
- submits to God and resists the devil in all circumstances. – Jas. 4:7-10
- knows and loves God’s Word. – Ps. 119:9-11, 35
- conducts him/her self in the world, and especially in his/her relations with others, with integrity with holiness and sincerity – 2Cor 1:12
- is fully protected and guarded in all his/her ways – Ps 91:11.

5. INTERCEDE FOR YOUR CHURCH

Pray for your church family and leaders:

- Deeper love for one another (2 Cor 14:1a, Phil 1:9).
- Establish a culture of discipleship, equipping people into their gifts and calling.
- Deeper hunger for the Word of God.
- Protect leaders from temptation and complacency.
- Encourage a spirit of worship, confession and lament.
- Grow a culture of equipped gospel witnesses.
- Every church is now a house of prayer. (Col; 4:2)
- God builds the House and has His way there.
- Church members keep, guard and protect God’s work.
- Leaders are refreshed, renewed and restored.
- The Word of God anchors every sermon and bible study.
- Church members and leaders are protected from evil (Ps 91:11).
- Leaders put God’s desires before their own.

PRAYER POINTS

Use the Prayer Points in the remainder of this Digest as needed to guide your prayers for the 7+ Spheres of society. Pray in whatever way works for you. Consider your authority as an obedient son/daughter of God taking your position in Christ to decree God's will according to Job 22:28: "You will also declare a thing and it will be established for you; so light will shine on your ways." (NKJ) Pray for increased faith that God hears and answers your prayers. (Heb 11:6)

Colorado Prays Ministry PRAYER POINTS:

1. We praise You, Lord, that Colorado is now covered in day and night prayer at the state level with nearly 60 participating churches and groups – let the Wall of Prayer now expand so that every county is covered in a Neh. 4:20 wall of non-stop prayer.
2. We pray for new strategies and resources to communicate the vision of Colorado Prays to pastors statewide.
3. We pray that each participating church faithfully fulfills their monthly Prayer Watch.
4. We ask for a new Prayer Trust Leader for the First Responder sphere of influence in Colorado.
5. We pray for wisdom and revelation for the Prayer Trust Leaders who are laser-focused on each of the spheres covered in this Prayer Digest and for their physical/spiritual protection (including their families, businesses, ministries, and possessions).
6. We pray for continuing expansion of the Colorado Prays leadership team – that God brings leaders with a passion for the transformational power of prayer. We especially need a pastor to engage other pastors, an administrator, a WIX web developer and an intercessor/writer who will compile this Prayer Digest each month.
7. We pray for protection, wisdom and discernment for every intercessor on the Colorado Prays Prayer Wall (including myself).
8. We praise God that we now have 9 counties covered by Cover the County which hosts a regularly-scheduled prayer call every month for each Colorado county while building relationships with local county leaders to cover them in prayer. We pray that more leaders come forth in each of the 64 counties statewide.

Culture-Wide Prayer Points:

Please address the following over-arching statewide issues in prayer as the Lord leads you.

1. Every person in Colorado to come to the saving knowledge of Jesus Christ.
2. Depression, hopelessness, self-harm and suicides among kids, teens and adults to end in Colorado—that God's love and peace now reign in our state.
3. Domestic violence to end in Colorado as God's love conquers all.
4. Drug abuse and addictions in Colorado to be overcome by the blood of the Lamb.
5. Drug cartels & demonic cults in Colorado to be uncovered and brought to justice.
6. Abortion to end in Colorado as women and men now choose life for their unborn babies.
7. Sex trafficking to be uncovered in Colorado, dismantled and every perpetrator brought to justice.
8. Anarchy and deep division among Colorado citizens to be overwhelmed by the love of Jesus.
9. Homelessness to be resolved by a legacy of generosity in every Colorado city.
10. God's love to overshadow and overwhelm racial upheaval in every Colorado community.
11. The pattern of "taking offense" to be overruled by a wave of mercy and grace across Colorado.

Seven Mountain Prayer Points

The following Prayer Points cover each of the 7 Spheres or Mountains of society with biblically sound prayers. Feel free to use some, or all, of the Prayer Points or simply pray as the Spirit leads you.

“Heavenly Father, we thank You for Your faithfulness to Your Word, that it will not return to You void but will accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You sent it. And according to 1 John 5:14-15, this is our confidence: that if we ask anything according to Your Will, You hear us. And if we know that You hear us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of You. We submit our petitions in faith believing we receive. (Isa 55:11, 1John 5:14-15, Mark 11:24.)”

GOVERNMENT PRAYER POINT

1. We declare that the hidden things in Colorado government are now being fully revealed with no more delay, resulting in full accountability for all unjust actions!
2. We declare all corruption in our state and national government is being dealt with at this time with no more back room deals or under the table money changing hands!
3. We call forth the righteousness of the Lord in each and every person in and around Colorado government or let them be removed from their place of power and influence.
4. We declare: “Whom the Son sets free is free indeed!” and there will be no more bondage or tyranny over the people of Colorado or the people of the United States of America!
5. We declare that the stronghold of manipulation and control is now removed from the government of Colorado at the state, county and city levels.
6. We declare that socialism will not prevail in our state or our nation.
7. We declare that Colorado has the finishing anointing for the nation.

FAMILY PRAYER POINTS:

1. We pray that couples across Colorado now move into fullness of their Jer 29:11 destiny in God’s Kingdom.
2. We pray that Colorado couples now realize the supernatural strength and power in their One Flesh relationship.
3. We pray that Colorado couples now learn to pray against fear of all kinds and stand in unity.
4. We declare that people across Colorado now throw off the bondage of fear and anxiety that has caused stress and sickness as they live out Phil 4:6: “Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.”

MEDIA PRAYER POINTS:

1. We praise You, Lord, that You have called us to the ministry of reconciliation as co-laborers and partners in ministering to the ungodly to bring them to salvation in Jesus Christ.
2. We ask You, Lord of the Harvest, that You send forth laborers into Your Media Mountain Harvest. (Matthew 9:37-38)
3. We declare the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand and that the seed of the message of the Gospel is now preached around the world through every form of media, especially those coming from Colorado. (Matthew 9:37),
4. We pray that faith is stirred in the hearts of people in the Media Mountain to receive the message and be converted, in Jesus Name. (Luke 10:2)
5. We ask, Lord God, that You raise up ministers of reconciliation in the Media Mountain to bring forth the harvest statewide; that people may know that God was, in Christ, reconciling the Word to Himself, not imputing their trespass to them. We declare freedom and liberty as each person is now reconciled to Father God through His grace, mercy and love (John 4:35-38, 2 Cor. 5:18-20)
6. We ask You, Lord of the Harvest, to release Your angels to reap and gather many Colorado souls from practicing lawlessness and wickedness. (Matthew 13:41-43)
7. We declare, Lord, that You are absolutely good, and Your mercy endures forever. (Psalm 106)

EDUCATION PRAYER POINTS:

1. We proclaim that the good news of the Gospel and salvation through Jesus Christ is now being shared throughout the education system in Colorado. *Ex 9:16*
2. We pray for revival and spiritual awakening in every Colorado school from preschool through university. *Acts 26:18*
3. We pray for godly men and women to take up board seats in every Colorado school district in this next election and to take up school staff and teaching positions.
4. We pray that more families now raise up their children in the way they ought to go so that even when they are old, they will not turn from it. *Prov 22:6*
5. We pray that the needs of the poor in every Colorado school be met and not exploited. *Luke 6:20*
6. We pray that any proposed or existing legislation, which would be harmful to the students of Colorado, now be reversed or stopped. May the children of Colorado be protected from them.
7. We pray that children across Colorado would be free to hear about Jesus. *Matt 19:14*
8. We pray that God would protect Colorado children and school communities from all threats caused by Covid-19, anxiety, depression, addiction, gender confusion, etc. *Psalm 91*
9. We pray for Christian teachers across Colorado to be humble before God, putting off falsehood and speaking truthfully in every teaching they present to children. *Eph 4:25*
10. We pray that God now pushes back government from interfering in the education of Colorado students.

ARTS/ENTERTAINMENT PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare that the True Worshipers are arising across Colorado with a pure sound of Spirit and Truth worship! Let this worship be a clarion call to bring the Kingdom to earth in this region. We proclaim freedom to captives, liberty of sight to blind, and hearing to deaf ears as we magnify the true King of Kings, Jesus, on our lips daily, in our homes, and in our churches! John 4:24, Psa 73:28, Psa 63:3
2. We command the True Church of Colorado to AWAKE in this hour!! Awake, O sleeper! Arise from the dead and Christ will shine on you! May the Light pierce the dark and hidden places that have held back the advancing of your Kingdom, O Lord! We cast down every idol and exalt the One True King Jesus. Eph 5:11-16
3. We proclaim that the time is now for the Kingdom of God to advance across all of Colorado as the urgency in our hearts to bear witness in the proclamation of Jesus' redemption plan is increasing.
4. May the Church doors swing wide open to invite worshipers to gather around the centerpiece of Heaven and proclaim His worth in this hour. Matt 2:2, Isa 33:17
5. May the House of the Lord be filled with joy and thanksgiving during this holiday season as the Ecclesia declares, "Look what the Lord has done!" May testimonies of God's faithfulness, provision, healing, manifestation, and restoration be echoed through every life-giving Colorado church. Psa 126:3, Psa 66

CHURCH PRAYER POINTS:

1. Oh Jesus, we, Your Body, are learning that when we thank You for the many pleasures You provide, we affirm that You are God, from whom all blessings flow. (Ps 26:6-9; James 1:17; Ps 103:1-22)
2. Oh Lord, it is good to give thanks to You and to sing praises to Your name; to declare Your lovingkindness in the morning and Your faithfulness every night. (Ps 92:1-2)
3. We declare that we, The Church, choose to live a lifestyle of thankfulness; to make it a habit to thank You for people you have brought into our lives. We choose to remember all that our faithful Father has done for us; to live a lifestyle of thankfulness. (Eph 1:16; Col 1:3 | Thes 1:2, 3:9; Isa 63:7; Ps 119:62)
4. Thank You Lord that we are learning the joyous discipline of filling up the spare moments in our lives with praise and thanksgiving, which will enable us to live in the intimacy of Your presence. (Ps 95:2, 140:13; 100:4; 75:1)
5. We agree with Your Word that gratitude and thankfulness is the heart of worship. May we daily enter into thankful adoration before You, oh Lord, and let us never separate thanksgiving from worship. (Ps 50:14; 95:2; 100:4; Neh 12:27-43; Ps 69:30; 119:62)

FIRST RESPONDER POINTS:

1. We declare that the people of Colorado now flood our first responders with appreciation, honor, respect and gratitude.
2. We release Psalm 91 over every Colorado first responder, calling each of them into deep habitation in the secret place with the one True God and Savior, Jesus Christ, who provides peace and safety day after day.
3. We declare Eph 1:17-19 over each Colorado first responder, that they now abide in deep revelation, discernment and wisdom, minute by minute functioning in acute awareness of their surroundings at all times.
4. We ask, Lord, that You open spiritual eyes and ears so that every first responder hears, sees and instinctively knows what do in every situation they encounter.
5. We declare Gal 6:9 over Colorado first responders that they not give up or grow weary. Bring a refreshing to them, Lord God.
6. We declare that believing first responders now walk in the boldness of God's power, ministering in the name of Jesus every workday with impunity.
7. May every first responder cast their cares on You, Lord God. Let them release every form of pain and trauma to the foot of the cross.
8. We declare physical, mental, emotional and spiritual healing for every first responder in Colorado.
9. We ask for healing for first responders who have taken the vaccine and protection for every first responder against any variation of COVID.
10. We declare Is 41:10 over Colorado first responders: "Do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

MARKETPLACE PRAYER POINTS:

1. We declare John 3:16-17 over the Colorado marketplace: "For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through Him," in the Marketplace.
2. We speak to marketplace people across Colorado and say: "Overlook the mistakes of others because love prospers when a fault is forgiven but dwelling on it separates close friends," in the Marketplace. Prov.17:9.
3. We declare Matt 18:15 over Colorado marketplace people: "If thy brother trespasses against thee, rebuke him; and if he repents, you have won them over."
4. We declare over Colorado marketplace people: "Come now, let us settle the matter quickly (in the Marketplace)." "Even though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow, though they are red as crimson, they shall be like wool." Isa 1:18, Matt 5:25
5. We pray that Colorado marketplace people will not repay evil for evil or reviling for reviling, but on the contrary, they will bless, for to this they were called, that they may obtain a blessing. 1Peter 3:9.
