

Your church's Prayer Watch with Colorado Prays starts at 6pm on the day you choose and ends at 6pm the next day. Once you have people signed up for their timeslots, your time commitment should be around 1 hour a month.

Position Overview

- Prayer Watch Coordinator (Coordinator) is appointed and affirmed by Senior Pastor.
- Coordinator recruits people in the congregation to fill the time slots for the Colorado Prays Prayer Watch.
- Coordinator manages ongoing communication with the pray-ers and Colorado Prays leadership.

Expectations

- 1. Organize the church's Prayer Watch to meet church's preference.
 - a. Can be completed by individuals in private (or family) prayer times at home.
 - b. Can be completed by prayer gatherings at church and/or private prayer at home
 - c. Can be completed 100% at the church
 - d. Can be completed through a 24Hr Teleconference Bridge

(Suggestions - Some churches encourage Sunday School classes, Life Groups, children and youth to take a portion of time and cover it as a team. Families may also want to cover a time period as a special time for a family altar.)

- 2. Church Prayer Points. If desired, coordinate with church leadership to draft prayer points specifically for your church. Include your church Prayer Points with the Monthly Prayer Digest.
- 3. Monthly Prayer Digest. Distribute the Colorado Prays Monthly Prayer Digest to the pray-ers along with your optional church-specific prayer guide. The Prayer Digest will be sent to you each month via email or you can download it from <u>www.coprays.org</u>
- 4. Stay in communication with Colorado Prays by:
 - a. Submitting Praise Reports from the pray-ers
 - b. Responding to email communications from Colorado Prays leadership
 - c. Attending periodic Coordinator gatherings by phone or in person.
- 5. Report. Keep church leadership apprised of the progress of the church's Prayer Watch. Document answers to prayer and praise reports. Submit these to the Colorado Prays Leadership team periodically via email or post them in your online group.

Recruit Church Pray-ers

Recruit church pray-ers to fill the church's 24 hour Prayer Watch with "faith filled" prayer. Provide a way for pray-ers to sign up for prayer time slots. There are two options:

- 1. Online Signup. Contact Amy Everette at 303-814-1379 <u>amy@onevoice4t.org</u> to set up your Prayer Watch in our online prayer campaign management tool. You can then use the system to track open timeslots and communicate with everyone in your Prayer Watch
- 2. Paper Signup. Use a paper-based system to let people sign up (see website for signup forms) and manually track open time slots. You can then use your church's email system to communicate with everyone in your Prayer Watch.

Encourage Pray-ers

- 1. Encourage pray-ers to pray first for themselves and their family, then for your church and finally, for the city (and state).
- 2. Follow-up and encourage the people who signed up for timeslots in the church's Prayer Watch for Colorado Prays. Use your online group or your church's email system.
- 3. Explore how the prayer time is going with pray-ers to monitor how God is moving within the church through the Prayer Watch. Use your online group or your church's email system.
- 4. Identify resources and/or training that may be helpful to enhance the church's culture of prayer. (Check website for resources)
- 5. Establish a method for sharing answers to prayer. Options include:
 - Use paper forms during church services
 - Use your online group at <u>www.onevoice4t.org</u> to post prayer requests and praise reports. Contact Amy Everette to set up an online group for your church.
- 6. Disseminate Praise Reports received from Colorado Prays leadership. Post them in your online group or use your church's email system.
